- A. Test Description: The GREK 301 ICE exam consists of the equivalent of 70 true-false, matching, translation, and fill-in questions covering third semester Greek grammar, vocabulary, translation, forms, and parsing.
- B. Describe the knowledge and skills required to pass the test.
 - a. The student needs to be able to conjugate all Greek verbs, moods, and voices; decline nouns and participles, answer questions about grammatical issues, translate Greek vocabulary and sentences, and parse various Greek verbs.
- C. List the topics covered in the test.
 - a. The test covers Greek verbs, voices, moods, participles, infinitives, nouns, pronouns, various independent and dependent clauses, sentences, parsing, and translation.
- D. What is the format of the test?
 - a. True-false, Matching, Fill-in, Translation, Short Answer.
- E. How many questions are on the test?
