**GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS for B.M. in Music - Instrumental Concentration; Non-Keyboard Emphasis**

**124 Total Hours**

- 34 hours of upper level (300/400 courses)
- 30 semester hours completed at Liberty
- 50% of the major and the minor must be completed at Liberty

**Cumulative GPA must be 2.0 or higher**

- Must have a "C" or above in upper-level courses in the major
- Must have an overall average of "C" in the major

**Christian/Community Service Assignments**

- GNED 101 & 102 must be completed by all freshmen and transfer students within the first and second semesters of a student's program. This is the Christian/Community Service (CSER) requirement for the first year at Liberty. After completing GNED 101 & 102, students may choose a CSER from the 200, 300, 400, or 500 series.

**Graduation Application**
