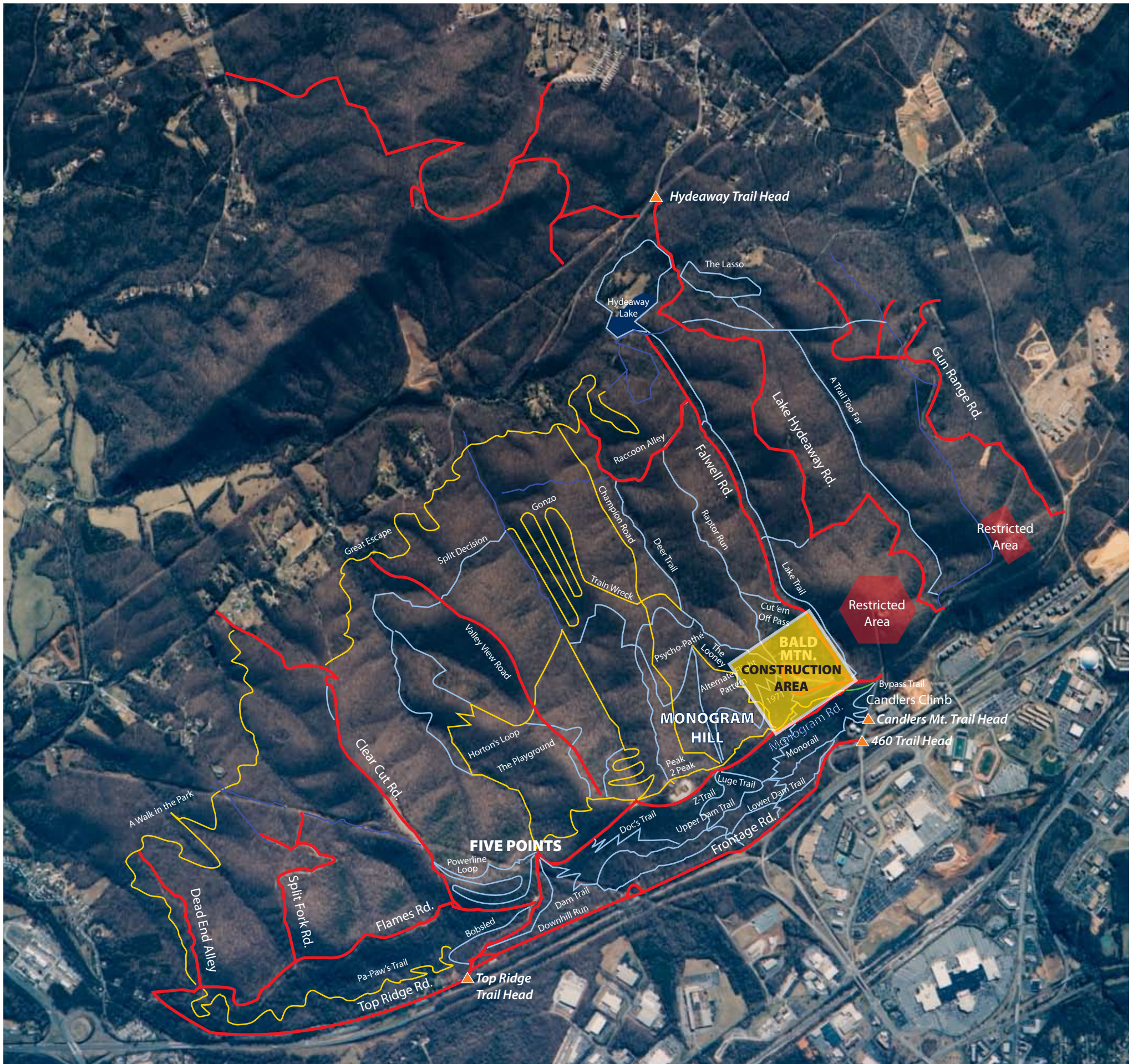


LIBERTY MOUNTAIN TRAIL SYSTEM
