To be considered for financial aid eligibility for the Winter Intensive 2010-10 Term, students must be regularly admitted students in an eligible academic program. The Winter Intensive 2010-10 Term includes classes starting 12/28/09 (after the Fall Term) and end before the Spring Term starts 1/18/10. If enrolled in a Winter Intensive, this form must be completed and submitted to the Liberty University Financial Aid Office.

After this date, the course/s will be dropped for non-payment.

Financial Check-in will not be available online for Winter Term but will be completed by administration upon verifying payment arrangements. After 12/16/09, Winter Term course/s will be dropped for any student that has not contacted a Financial Check-In Coordinator to complete the process.

Student Certification

- I must register for all of my Winter and Spring Term courses as soon as possible to ensure that financial aid is calculated correctly;
- Financial aid for which I am eligible will pay to my student account no sooner than January 14, 2010; I authorize all financial aid related to 2010-10 and 2010-20 to be disbursed for charges from those combined terms, including Title IV federal aid;
- I must be enrolled at least half-time to be eligible to receive student loans;
- Failing to attend or withdrawing from any class could lower or eliminate my financial aid eligibility;
- If I withdraw and lose eligibility, I must pay any resulting balance to the Student Accounts Office at Liberty University;
- Anyone signing or processing financial aid forms, seeking financial aid information or assistance at Liberty University, or seeking consumer information regarding Liberty University must read, understand, and comply with the requirements disclosed which are available 24 hours a day at <http://www.LIBERTY.edu/financialaid>;
- Submitting this form late in the Term or failing to meet other eligibility requirements may eliminate potential eligibility due to processing time and awarding and disbursement requirements.
