<sup>1</sup>DMIN 989 must be taken a minimum of two times. Any student who is not ready for enrollment in DMIN 990 after completing the second enrollment in DMIN 989 may be required, as determined by the student's thesis project chair, to repeat DMIN 989 until deemed ready for enrollment in DMIN 990.

<sup>3</sup>Once the student enters the Thesis Project phase, he/she must maintain continuous enrollment (Fall, Spring and Summer semesters) until all degree requirements are completed.
