



OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE FACULTY POSITION

The Department of Osteopathic Principles and Practice is actively searching for qualified individuals.

Responsibilities: The successful candidate will be responsible for osteopathic manual medicine instruction of medical students as a member of systems-based teaching teams involving lecture and active teaching methods. In addition to lectures, teaching methods will include both case-based and team-based presentations. This position reports directly to the Chair of the Department of Osteopathic Principles and Practice, and the new faculty member will be expected to grow pro-fessionally through participation in service and scholarly/research and administrative responsibilities.

Facility: The main space is a 5,300-square-foot OMM lab that accommodates over 80 student-doctors per session with over 40 OMM tables. Natural light is provided by large exterior windows allowing the student-doctors a more comfortable learning environment for the “hands-on” OMM curriculum.

The lab includes industry-standard adjustable tables designed to accommodate individual student-doctor needs. High definition video monitors are featured throughout the lab, allowing student-doctors to view anatomic motions and manipulation demonstrations as well as HD recording/playback for future review.

Qualifications: DO terminal degree with current Board Certification and three years academic experience as a full-time faculty member at an osteopathic or allopathic school, or other doctoral-level allied health college, as well as extensive experience in research or scholarly activity at a nationally recognized facility or as a full-time faculty member in a Graduate Medical Education program. Faculty members are expected to contribute to a positive Christian environment in the course of mentoring our LUCOM students.

LUCOM is a faith-based institution with student-doctors guided by the principles of the Christian worldview to become knowledgeable and competent servants of their patients and society.
