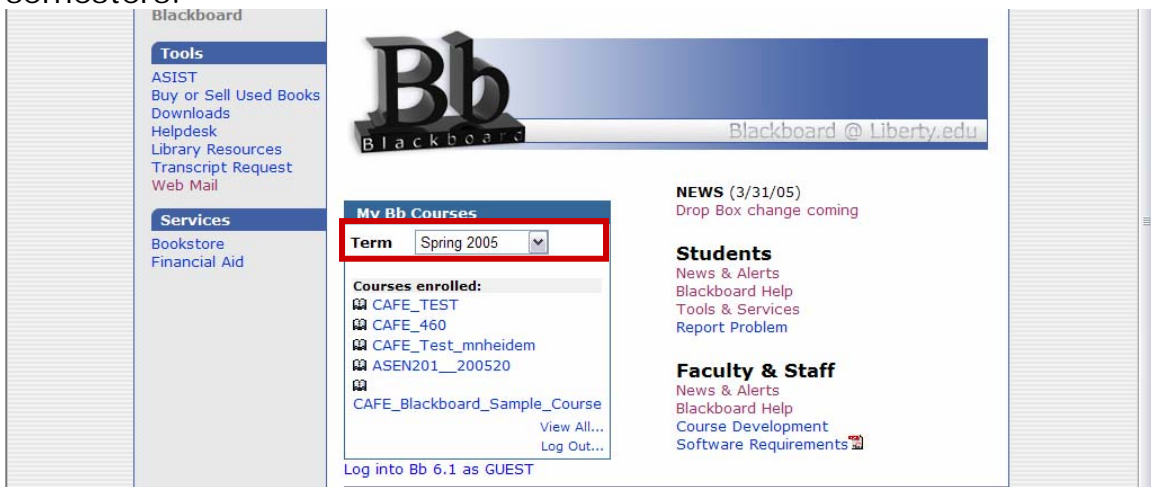
Login to the Current Students portal using your network username and password in the MyLiberty box on right side of the student portal.

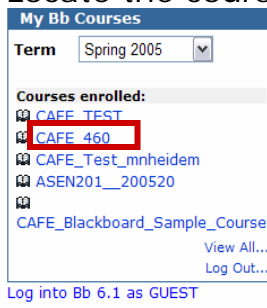
After a successful logon click the Blackboard link on the left.
