### Storylines

Liberty returns to the road for a Big South weekend series, at Gardner-Webb on Friday and at UNC Asheville on Saturday. Saturday's match at UNC Asheville, originally scheduled for a 2 p.m. start, will begin at 6 p.m. Liberty (11-4, 1-0 Big South) and Gardner-Webb (6-12, 1-0) are two of three teams (High Point) still unbeaten in Big South play.

The Lady Flames ended the 2011 regular season with a trip to Gardner-Webb and UNC Asheville, falling to the Runnin' Bulldogs before downing UNC Asheville, 3-2, Nov. 12 to wrap up their fifth straight Big South regular-season title.

### Liberty at a Glance

The Lady Flames never trailed on Tuesday, sweeping James Madison (26-24, 25-21, 25-23) to extend their winning streak to three matches. Caroline Douglas sent down 10 of her match-high 17 kills during set one. Ansley Gebben helped Liberty close out the match, collecting 10 of her career-high 23 digs in the final set.

Liberty improved its conference-leading hitting percentage to .250, while maintaining the Big South lead with 1.75 aces per set.

Live stats and video streaming will be available for both of Liberty's matches this weekend. Live video will be provided, for a small charge, through the Big South Network. Gardner-Webb and UNC Asheville's respective athletics media relations departments will provide live stats on Friday and Saturday.

### Wire to Wire

On Tuesday, the Lady Flames downed James Madison, 3-0. Although the match was decided by a total of eight points (26-24, 25-21, 25-23), Liberty never trailed at any point during the match. The last time the Lady Flames went through a whole match without trailing was Sept. 9, 2011, a 3-0 (25-21, 25-12, 25-10) win over Rider.

### Fast Start

Caroline Douglas recorded 10 of her match high-tying 17 kills during set one against James Madison. The last time a Lady Flame had 10 kills during a single set was Lillie Happel, with 10 kills of her career-high 25 kills coming in set three versus Seton Hall, Sept. 2, 2011.

### Close to the Finish

Ansley Gebben recorded nine kills and a career-high 23 digs on Tuesday against James Madison. Her 23 digs were the most by a Lady Flame this season, and most for a Liberty player in a three-set match since Kelly Haseman collected 25 digs versus Delaware on Nov. 27, 2009.

Gebben collected 10 digs in set three against JMU, the most digs in a single set for a Lady Flame since Haseman had 10 digs during set two at Penn State, Dec. 2, 2011.

### Blocking the Competition

Liberty held a 7-1 advantage in blocks over James Madison, with Kendle Rollins assisting on six out of the Lady Flames' seven blocks. Rollins is averaging 1.60 blocks per set over Liberty's last four matches, and now leads them team with 57 blocks on the season. Loren Thomas, last year's conference blocks leader, has 56 blocks this year.

The Lady Flames have won the blocking battle during each of their last 10 matches, and 12 times overall this season. Liberty is 9-3 when outblocking an opponent in 2012.

### Acing the Test

Entering this week, Liberty ranked No. 8 nationally in aces per set, on the NCAA Division I statistical rankings. The team currently leads the Big South with 1.75 aces per set, paced by Becca Haraf's 20 aces and 15 each from Jade Craycraft, Kendle Rollins and Gabrielle Shipe. A total of six Lady Flames have reached double figures in aces so far this season.

### Double-Double

Junior setter Jade Craycraft totaled 34 assists and 10 digs during Liberty's 3-0 win over James Madison, Tuesday. It marked her third double-double this season, and 17th career double-double.

Craycraft leads the Lady Flames with three double-doubles this season, followed by Lillie Happel with two. The last Liberty setter to lead Liberty in double-doubles was Kallie Corbin, who recorded seven double-doubles in 2008.

### Leading the Pack

At present, the Lady Flames sit atop the Big South statistical charts in both hitting percentage (.250) and aces per set (1.77).

Loren Thomas (.336) leads the conference in attack percentage. Redshirt freshman Caroline Douglas paces the Big South in kills per set (3.25) and is fourth in attack percentage (.308). Douglas is the only Big South freshman to rank in the top 10 in either category.

Gardner-Webb (6-12, 1-0 Big South) opened up conference play with a 3-1 win over UNC Asheville last Friday, and downed USC Upstate, 3-1, in its most recent match on Tuesday. Tyler Cockrell leads the Runnin' Bulldogs in kills per set (2.48), blocks per set (0.84) and attack percentage (.277). Heather Feldman paces Gardner-Webb with 9.20 assists per set, while Anna Pashkova leads the team with 3.85 digs per set.

Second-year head coach Leo Sayles holds a 16-32 record at Gardner-Webb after going 153-111 during seven years at Bryan College.

Liberty leads the all-time series over the Runnin' Bulldogs, 12-1, winning the first 11 meetings. During each of Gardner-Webb's first four seasons in the Big South, Liberty defeated Gardner-Webb in the Big South tournament's opening round.

The Lady Flames went 2-1 versus Gardner-Webb last year, starting with a 3-2 win on Oct. 1 at the Vines Center. The Runnin' Bulldogs swept Liberty, Nov. 11, 2011 at Paul Porter Arena for their first win all-time over Liberty. Liberty won the teams' most recent meeting, 3-1, on Nov. 17, 2011 in the conference quarterfinals.

UNC Asheville brings a 4-13 record, 0-1 in conference play, into the weekend, which begins for the Bulldogs with a Friday match against Radford. 2011 Big South All-Tournament team member Holly Shelton ranks fifth in the Big South, with 2.85 kills per set. Returning all-conference performer Anna Moore is eighth with 2.46 kills per set. Moore paces the Bulldogs with 0.97 blocks per set, while Alex Stewart has averages a team-leading 3.18 digs per set and Katie Davis dishes out 8.38 assists per set.

Second-year head coach Frederico Santos is 17-27 at UNC Asheville following three seasons during which he led Barry to a 46-31 record.

Liberty leads UNC Asheville, 31-19, in the all-time series, including 12-8 under Pinder. The Lady Flames went 3-0 against the Bulldogs last year, and have won five straight matches in the series since a 3-1 UNC Asheville win, Nov. 6, 2009 in Lynchburg.

Liberty downed UNC Asheville, 3-2, Nov. 12 in last year's regular-season finale to clinch the Big South regular-season title. One week later, Liberty swept the Bulldogs behind a .430 team hitting percentage in the Big South Volleyball Championship semifinals.

**Dig In**

In each of Liberty's last two matches, the Lady Flames faced a team ranked in the top 35 in the nation in digs per set. During both contests, Liberty posted more digs than its opponent.

On Friday, Radford entered its match against Liberty rated No. 33 in the nation in digs, but the Lady Flames outdug the Highlanders, 53-46. Tuesday, the Lady Flames held a 68-65 advantage in digs over James Madison, who was No. 21 on the national digs list.

**Great Expectations**

The Lady Flames have been predicted to win the 2012 Big South volleyball championship, while Loren Thomas was the Preseason Player of the Year and Lillie Happel also appeared on the preseason all-conference list. Thomas is the first Lady Flame since Kallie Corbin in 2009 to be named Big South Preseason Volleyball Player of the Year.

Liberty has been voted the Big South preseason favorite for the eighth time, and second year in a row.

**Only 3 Left**

With just one weekend of conference play in the books in 2012, only three teams remain undefeated in the Big South, at 1-0. Liberty, Gardner-Webb and High Point each won their lone Big South match last week, while four teams went 1-1 and three went 0-1. After the first weekend of conference play last year, five out of 10 Big South teams sported no conference losses.

**Halfway Home**

The Lady Flames are 11-4 after 15 matches played, with 14 regular-season matches remaining. The team is off to its best start since the 2008 Liberty volleyball team opened 11-4 on the way to a 25-9 record and its fifth Big South tournament title.

Liberty's best start through 15 matches during its NCAA Division I era came in 1996, when the Lady Flames opened 13-2 before finishing at 24-10.

Last season, Liberty closed well to the finish, with 11 wins in its last 14 regular-season matches.

**Drive for 5**

The Liberty volleyball team has posted five straight 20-win seasons, earned five conference regular-season titles and made five consecutive appearances in the conference final (2007-2011). Hawaii is the only NCAA Division I volleyball program, besides Liberty, about which each of the following three statements is true.

**Liberty is:**

- one of five volleyball programs in NCAA Division I to have won or shared their conference or division regular-season championship in each of the last five years.
