RULES EDUCATION ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

1. IF YOU ACCEPT AN EXTRA BENEFIT YOU ARE INELIGIBLE

- a. Any special arrangement or receipt of item/service of value that is provided to you or your family because you are student-athlete.
- b. EXAMPLES: Money, free meals, reduced rent or free lodging, tickets to sporting events and/ or concert, free vehicle or the use of a vehicle, etc

2. USE CAUTION WHEN DEALING WITH AGENT

- a. IF you agree orally or in writing to be represented by and agent prior to exhausting your eligibility you will be permanently ineligible.
- b. If you or your family accepts extra benefits from an agent or allow and agent to represent your athletic interest you will be ineligible.

3. IF YOU SELL YOUR COMPLIMENTARY TICKETS YOU WILL BE INELIGIBLE

- a. You may not receive payment for your complimentary tickets
- b. You may not exchange your complimentary tickets for other items of value (e.g. reduced rate service at local businesses, free furniture, free car accessories)

4. IF YOU ARE EMPLOYED DURING THE SUMMER OR THE ACADEMIC YEAR, YOU MUST REGISTAR YOUR JOB WITH THE COMPLIANCE OFFICE

- a. You may be legitimately employed as long as you are PAID THE GOING RATE for the work you are performing.
- b. You may ONLY BE PAID FOR WORK YOU ACTUALLY PERFORM
- c. Your employer may not use your name or picture to advertise or promote their business
- d. IF YOU DO NOT ABIDE BY THESE REGULATIONS YOU WILL BE INELIGIBLE

5. IF YOU GAMEBLE ON ANY COLLEGIATE OR PROFESSIONAL SPORTING EVENT YOU ARE INEGLIBLE

- a. NCAA regulations are very strict. You may not place bets for cash or any item of value (e.g. meals, t-shirts, etc) on any sporting event.
- b. No March Madness pools, no participating in a fantasy league that involves a prize to the winner, and no placing bets with a bookie, etc.

6. DO NOT ACCEPT ANYTHING OF VALUE FROM A BOOSTER

- a. A booster is a season ticket holder, anyone who has provided money to support our programs, or anyone who has provided you or your family a benefit previously
- b. Be careful to scrutinize your relationships
- c. Your true friends are your coaches, your teammates, LU administrators, your family and your friends you had prior to coming to LU and those you meet strictly through campus and not through your LU athletics association

BOTTOM LINE: ALWAYS ASK YOUR COACHES OR CALL THE COMPLIANCE OFFICE BEFORE YOU DO ANYTHING THAT MIGHT AFFECT YOUR ELIGIBILITY
