NCAA Bylaw: 13.8 Un-official (non-paid) Visits

According to Bylaw 13.8, prospective student-athletes may visit Liberty University at their own expense as many times as they would like. There is no restriction on when a prospective student-athlete may take an unofficial visit. It is important to keep in mind that coaches must be mindful of dead periods. During an unofficial visit, Liberty University is not permitted to pay any expenses or provide any entertainment except the maximum of three (3) complimentary admissions to home athletics contests. The Athletics Department may arrange for academic interviews and provide transportation to tour institutional facilities within a 30-mile radius of campus.

Procedure:

1. After each unofficial visit the coach will fill out the Unofficial Visit Approval Form in Jumpforward with all of the required information, so there is a record of adherence to NCAA rules and regulations regarding unofficial visits.
