Camp Information

This camp is open to any middle school or high school-aged girls. Athletic trainers will be on staff at all times to provide preventative and remedial care. All participants will be required to attend all sessions and to comply with the rules and regulations governing the camp. Alcohol, smoking and drugs are not permitted. Mouthguards and shinguards are required for all players. Goalkeepers must provide their own equipment.

Cost

The cost of the Pathfinder Field Hockey camp is \$445 and includes two nights lodging, 7 meals (lunch on Friday through to lunch on Sunday) and a pinnie. The cost for an extended-day camper/commuter is \$395 and includes all meals along with a pinnie. For groups of 10 or more the cost is \$410. A portion of the proceeds will go toward Pathfinder Hockey (details on the back).

*** A non-refundable deposit of \$100 is required with each application and will be applied to the total fee.**

Transportation

Each camper is responsible for her own transportation to and from the camp. Lynchburg Regional Airport is serviced by US Air. The nearest bus service is Greyhound (1-800- 231- 2222).

**CAMP DIRECTOR
JODI MURPHY**

Jodi Murphy just completed her second season as Head Field Hockey Coach at Liberty University. In Liberty's first season in the NorPac conference, Murphy led the Lady Flames to a 16-6 record, winning the regular-season NorPac East Conference Title. Members of the Liberty Field Hockey team were awarded NorPac Rookie of the Year, Offensive Player of the Year & Coach of the Year at the recent Conference Awards Banquet. The Flames were ranked nationally within the top 25 in a number of team categories including: team scoring average, goals against average, shutouts per game and winning percentage. Individually the Flames were honored in the top 20 for goals per game & points per game with the team's Freshman Goalkeeper recording first in the nation for goals against average.
