Regan Denham enters her third year at the helm of the Liberty University Women's Lacrosse program this spring. In 2011, Denham's team made a six-win improvement from its inaugural season and also chalked up a postseason victory, defeating Howard in the National Lacrosse Conference Tournament, 16-13. Also in the 2011 season, five of Denham's student-athletes earned notable awards. Two freshmen tabbed NLC All-Conference honors, two upperclassmen were named to the NLC All-Academic team, and freshmen Karis Walborn earned NLC All-Tournament Team as well as VaSID All-State second team. Prior to coming to Lynchburg, Denham served as head coach at Springfield College and Missouri Baptist, and acted as an assistant and an interim head coach at Averett and Drew University, respectively.
