Game 1 Charlottesville, Va.

The Cavaliers held the Flames to just 22.5 percent shooting from the field and 22 points in both halves of the game en route to a 79-44 season-opening victory over Liberty at University Hall. The Flames shot 23.1 percent (6-of-26) in the opening period and trailed 44-22 at the break. The second half didn't prove to be much different than the first as Liberty finished the period connecting on just 6-of-27 attempts from the floor (22.2 percent). The closest the Flames got during the period was 25 points, 58-33, at the 10:57 mark on a lay-up by Eric Bigby. Larry Blair, who was held without a field goal until the 9:45 of the second half, led the Flames with 13 points as he was 2-of-13 from the field, but a perfect 8-of-8 from the free throw line. Russell Monroe followed with nine points and four rebounds, while Damien Hubbard added six points in his Flames' debut.

Game 2 Lynchburg, Va.

The Flames netted 12-unanswered points midway through the second half to put away a pesky Cincinnati Christian team as Liberty picked up its first victory of the season in an 88-54 win over the visiting Golden Eagles at the Vines Center. Liberty jumped out to a quick seven-point lead in the opening minutes as a jumper by Eric Bigby put the Flames up 15-7 at the 14:55 mark. The Flames continued to dominate over the remainder of the contest, holding the Golden Eagles to just four points over the last seven minutes of the game to seal the team's first victory of the season. Larry Blair paced the Flames with 23 points and a career-best 10 assists, while Damien Hubbard recorded his first double-double at Liberty with 14 points and a game-high 10 rebounds. Russell Monroe turned in a career night with career highs in points (15), rebounds (8) and blocked shots (3), while Jeremy Eck came off the bench to score 10 points to help the Flames shot 5

Game 6 Lynchburg, Va.

Larry Blair scored his 1,000th career point early on and then got a good start on his next 1,000 points with a season-best 30 points, but the effort wasn't enough as Buffalo used a key stretch in the second half to fend off Liberty and pick up a 66-53 victory over the Flames at the Vines Center. The contest remained close over the first several minutes of the game as Blair knocked down a jumper at the 13:59 mark to propel the junior over the 1,000 career point mark and pull the Flames within one point, 10-9. However, Buffalo scored seven-straight points and opened up an eight-point lead, 17-9, on a jumper by Roderick Middleton at the 11:15 mark. The Flames attempted to string together one final run late in the game as a pair of free throws by Evan Risher capped off a 6-0 run to cut the lead back to five points, 58-53, with 2:44 left on the game clock, but the Bulls held the Flames scoreless over the remainder of the contest and scored eight unanswered to seal the 13-point victory.

Game 16 Rock Hill, S.C.

The Eagles used a balanced scoring attack and a key second half run to post their fifth-straight Big South victory in a 67-47 win over Liberty. Game 21 Lynchburg, Va.

For the second-straight game, the Flames had a contest decided in the final seconds and this time Liberty came out on top as Evan Risher's jumper in the lane with 1.7 seconds left gave Liberty the lead for good in a 71-67 win. Lead changes and ties occurred over the first eight minutes of the second half as Larry Blair converted on one of two free throw attempts to give Liberty a 43-42 edge with 14:07 left, while VMI responded with a Williams' jumper and a pair of Travis Holmes free throws to take a three-point lead, 46-43, at the 12:25. However, back-to-back baskets by Eric Bigby and Blair gave Liberty a lead it would not relinquish until the final three-plus minutes of the contest. The Flames pushed their lead to as much as six points over the nine-minute stretch. Liberty maintained the lead until Preston Beverly grabbed an offensive rebound and stuck it back for two with 3:26 left to play to tie the game at 62-62. Two minutes later, the game was tied again at 64-64 until Risher knocked down a three-pointer in the corner, giving Liberty a three-point lead with 1:18 left to play. VMI quickly answered back as Chavis Holmes nailed a trey from the top of the key to tie the game at 67-67 with 53 seconds left. On the ensuing possession, Blair missed a three-pointer as time was expiring on the shot clock, but the guard got his own rebound to give the Flames another possession. After a timeout, Risher took the inbounds pass and waited until the clock was winding down and unlike the rest of the night that saw him finish with a career-high eight assists, the guard kept the ball and knocked down a jumper in the lane with 1.7 seconds left. VMI tried a full-court pass, but it sailed out the other end of the court, giving Liberty the ball back where Blair was fouled and hit a pair of free throws to seal the contest.

Game 22 Lynchburg, Va.

UNC Asheville let a 16-point second half lead slip away as the Flames held the Bulldogs to just two field goals over the final eight minutes of regulation, but UNC Asheville was able to use the free throw line in the extra period to pick up an 83-81 Big South win over Liberty. A pair of free throws by Anthony Smith knotted the game for the seventh time at 23-23 with 5:57 left to play in the opening half. Larry Blair's fourth three-pointer of the evening tied the game with nine seconds, sending the contest into overtime. A three-pointer by Damien Hubbard gave the Flames their first lead since the first half at the 4:16 mark of the overtime, but Omar Collington was able to drive the length of the floor to knot the game at 70-70 just seconds later. Jumpers by Blair and the Bulldogs' Joey Harrell tied the game at 72-72 with 2:29 left to play in the extra period, but the Bulldogs, who were a dismal 5-of-15 from the free throw line in the first two periods of play, finally found their shooting touch from the line as UNC Asheville converted on 9-of-10 free throw attempts in overtime to eventually seal the victory. Liberty was able to get as close as two points on three separate occasions over the last two-plus minutes, including after a pair of Blair free throws with 13 seconds left, but UNC Asheville remained steady from the stripe to walk away with the victory.

Game 23 Lynchburg, Va.

The Flames were held to a conference season-low 29.4 percent shooting from the field, while the Buccaneers were able to overcome a slow first half of their own en route to a 61-45 victory over Liberty. The largest lead of the first 17 minutes of the opening half came three minutes in as a three-pointer by Larry Blair gave Liberty a 5-0 lead at the 16:47 mark. However, Liberty's leading scorer, who entered the game averaging 22.5 points per game, was held to just one more point over the rest of the first half. Anthony Smith converted on 1-of-2 free throw attempts at the 5:53 mark to tie the game at 14-14, while Russell Monroe pulled down an offensive rebound and stuck it back for two to give the Flames a two-point edge, 16-14. But Charleston Southern held the Flames to just one more field goal over the final five minutes of the period, while a jumper by Chris Moore with 1:11 left play gave the visitors a 23-18 lead at the break. After trailing most of the second half, Liberty made one last run at the Buccaneers as a jumper by Blair at the 3:46 mark capped a 10-1 run for the Flames, but Charleston Southern's defense clamped down again and held Liberty without a field goal over the remainder of the game to for the road victory.

Game 24 Lynchburg, Va.

After a dismal performance that saw Liberty shoot 29.4 percent from the field and score 45 points in a home game, Liberty put together its third-best shooting performance of the year as the Flames shot 52.9 percent from the field en route to a 75-66 victory over Longwood. The game remained close over the first several minutes of the first half until Evan Risher took a feed from Damien Hubbard for a fast-break lay-up to put Liberty up by five, 12-7, at the 14:05 mark. However, Longwood scored 11 out of the next 14 points to take a one-point lead, 16-15, as Maurice Sumter pulled down a rebound and took the ball the length of the court for a jumper with 10:40 left to play. The Flames answered back on the next possession as Eric Bigby allowed Liberty to regain the lead with a two-point basket on the ensuing possession, but that would be the last time that Liberty would lead over the rest of the period as the Lancers put together a 13-4 run to take an eight-point lead, 29-21, on a lay-up by Kirk Williams with 5:57 left to play in the opening half. The two teams exchanged leads back and forth six times over six minutes in the second half until Blair knocked down a jumper and followed Risher with a trey from the corner to give Liberty a five-point lead. Liberty's defense clamped down and held the Lancers without a field goal over the final three minutes of the period and just two free throws for the home win.

Game 25 Birmingham, Ala.

The Panthers showed why they were the Big South's leading three-point shooting team as Birmingham-Southern used eight three-pointers to key a 68-56 conference victory over Liberty. The Flames jumped out to a quick lead early in the contest as Liberty scored four out of the first five points of the game, taking a 5-1 lead on an Evan Risher jumper at the 17:04 mark. But Birmingham-Southern quickly got back into the game as the Panthers started to find their range from behind the arc with back-to-back three pointers by James Collins with the second one coming at 15:05 to cut the Flames' lead to 8-7. A pair of free throws by Bucky McMillan 50 seconds later gave the Panthers their first lead of the game, while another trey by Thomas Vigilanco at the 12:19 mark pushed the home team's advantage to five points, 14-9. The Flames made one last push late to get back into the contest with a 15-6 run, cutting the Panthers' lead back to eight points, 62-54, on a pair of free throws by Risher at the 1:48 mark of the second half. But Ed Horton sank two free throws and converted on two lay-ups over the remainder of the contest to seal the victory for the homestanding Panthers.

Game 26 Radford, Va.

The Highlanders outscored the Flames 21-8 over the last five minutes of the game to open up a close battle between their arch rival as Radford picked up a 69-54 Big South victory over Liberty. Radford scored the first nine points of the contest as a pair of free throws by Whit Holcomb-Faye gave the Highlanders a 9-0 lead with 15:05 left to play in the first. The Flames finally got on the scoreboard as Larry Blair sank a jumper from the lane just 17 seconds later. And Blair's shot jumper started the Flames' offense as Liberty scored 10-straight points to take a 10-9 lead on a jumper by Anthony Smith at the 10:32 mark. For most of the remaining half, the game was a back-and-forth battle with Radford holding the largest lead at four points, 18-14, after a three-pointer by Holcomb-Faye with 5:19 left before the intermission. Game 27 Lynchburg, Va.

Larry Blair saved one of his best performances of the season for the league's best team and his 37 points were good enough to lift Liberty to a 78-71 upset victory over Winthrop. The contest was truly a back-and-forth struggle as the game saw 15 lead changes and 16 times when the score was tied, while neither team led by more than six until late in the contest. The two teams traded baskets over the first seven minutes of the game as Blair knotted the game at 15-15 with 13:05 left to play by hitting one of two free throw attempts. Five minutes later, Torrell Martin took a pass from Oti Daniels to give Winthrop at two-point edge, 20-18, at the 8:47 mark. A pair of free throws 90 seconds later by Daniels once again gave Winthrop a two-point lead, but Liberty reeled off six-straight points to take a four-point lead, 26-22, on a jumper by Anthony Smith with 5:17 left to play before the break. However, the Eagles countered back with a 7-0 run to take a three-point lead, 29-26, on a fast-break lay-up by Martin after a James Shuler steal at the 2:05 mark. Liberty was able to trim the lead back to as close as one point, but a three-pointer by Craig Bradshaw with 34 seconds left in the opening period allowed Winthrop to take a five-point edge, 36-31, into the locker room. The Eagles continued to maintain their five-point edge over the first five minutes of the second half as an old fashion three-point play by Martin gave Winthrop a 46-41 lead with 15:00 left. But the Flames put together a 12-3 run over the next four-plus minutes of play, taking a four-point lead, 53-49, on a fast-break lay-up by Blair after a Smith steal with 10:21 left. But Blair wasn't going to let the victory slip away as the junior drove the lane on the ensuing possession, making the basket and drawing the foul. He made the free throw to put Liberty back up by five with 45 seconds left, while 22 seconds later, Blair blocked a shot by Chris Gaynor which would have pulled the Eagles within three points, sealing the win for the Flames.

Game 28 Lynchburg, Va.

The Chanticleers shot an opponent Vines Center record 63.6 percent from the field and used a 35-8 run to start the second half en route to a 78-61 win over Liberty. The Flames jumped out to a quick 6-1 lead as a jumper by Larry Blair gave Liberty a five-point lead at the 17:36 mark. Liberty continued to control the pace of play over the next three minutes as a three-pointer by Blair pushed the Flames' lead to seven points, 13-6, with 13:26 mark. Coastal Carolina scored the next five points of the game to pull within two and was able to take its first lead of the game over the next eight minutes with a 7-0 run, capped off by a three-pointer by Jack Leasure at the 1:34 mark. The two teams traded baskets over the next 60 seconds, while Blair knotted down a three-pointer with just three seconds left on the clock, trimming the Chanticleers' halftime lead to two points, 37-35. The Chanticleers completed an impressive second half opening run by scoring eight-straight points, taking a 29-point edge, 72-43, on a lay-up by Colin Stevens with 7:05 left in the game. Liberty managed to close the game on a 17-2 run over the final three minutes to shave the margin of victory.

Game 29 Lynchburg, Va.

For the second-straight game, Liberty ran into a hot shooting team as High Point connected on 50.8 percent of its field goal attempts in a 78-49 Big South victory over the Flames at the Millis Center. Damien Hubbard knocked down the first basket of the night with a jumper in the lane at the 19:14 mark. However, the Panthers scored 14 out of the next 15 points in the contest, taking a 14-3 lead on a Akeem Scott lay-up with 15:14 left to play in the first half. High Point never trailed in the second half as they cruised easily to victory. High Point finished the contest shooting 50.8 percent from the field as they knocked down 30-of-59 attempts from the field, while holding Liberty to just 36.0 percent shooting from the floor (18-of-50). Blair paced the way for the Flames with 31 points on 10-of-17 shooting from the field and 8-of-11 from the free throw line, while Hubbard followed with 10 and five rebounds.

Game 30 Rock Hill, S.C.

Winthrop placed seven players in double figures as it opened defense of its Big South Championship with a 93-52 victory over No. 8 seed Liberty in the quarterfinals of the Advanced Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship. Winthrop opened an early 15 point lead as junior center Craig Bradshaw led an Eagle attack with a 17-2 run in the first eight minutes of play. Bradshaw's eight points in the run were all inside the paint, where the Eagles held a 46-6 advantage. All-Big South First Team selection Larry Blair led Liberty with 25 points on 8 of 25 shooting. The Eagles protected the ball well only committing a season-low five turnovers, tying a tournament record for fewest in a game, while forcing 17 by the Flames which led to 23 points. Winthrop connected on 35-out-of-63 field goals (55.6 percent), while holding the visiting Flames to 38 percent.
