

SCHILLING ANNEX CENTER:

Emergency Personnel:

Certified Athletic Trainers (ATC) and athletic training students on site for practices and competitions; additional sports medicine staff accessible from the Vines Center Athletic Training Room or the Williams Stadium Fieldhouse Athletic Training Room.

Emergency Communication:

ATCs carry cellular telephones. A fixed telephone line is located at the LaHaye Student Center Front Desk, (434) 592-3221.

Emergency Equipment:

Vacuum splints, crutches, AED, and blood borne pathogen supplies are available on site at all competitions. AED and blood borne pathogen supplies are available on site for all practices. Additional supplies are located in the Vines Center Athletic Training Room or the Williams Stadium Fieldhouse Athletic Training Room.

Roles of First Responders:

- 1) Immediate care of the injured or ill student- athlete
- 2) Activation of emergency medical system (EMS)
 - Cell phone: 911 (provide name, address, telephone number; number of individuals injured; condition of injured; first aid treatment; specific directions; other information as needed)
 - * If a cell phone is used; immediately notify LUPD at (434) 582-3911
 - Land line: 3911 - you will be connected to LUPD (provide the same information as above)
- 3) Emergency equipment retrieval
- 4) Direction of EMS to scene
 - * Open appropriate gates/ doors
 - * Designate individual to "flag down" EMS and direct crew to scene
- 5) Scene control: limit scene to first aid and providers and move bystanders away from area

Venue Directions: Take a right onto University Blvd from Candler's Mountain Road heading South. Take a right onto Evan's Blvd. Turn right into Evan's Parking lot towards the South Entrance to North Campus. Walk up the ramp towards the South Entrance to North Campus, there will be 2 glass double doors halfway up the ramp. Turn Right into the double glass doors.
