Storylines

A nine-match road swing concludes for the Liberty volleyball team on Tuesday, when the Lady Flames travel to the nation's capital to meet Georgetown of the BIG EAST at 7 p.m. The Lady Flames have gone 5-3 over their last eight matches, all away from the Vines Center, while Georgetown will play its first home match of the season on Tuesday.

Both Liberty and Georgetown will look to end winless streaks on Tuesday. The Hoyas started the campaign at 6-1, but have dropped each of their last five contests. The Lady Flames got off to an 8-1 start, before losing three in a row.

Liberty at a Glance

The Lady Flames (8-4) competed in the Marriott Cavalier Classic this past weekend, taking on Virginia Tech and Virginia of the ACC on Saturday. Liberty fell to the Hokies, 3-1, before sustaining a 3-2 setback against the host Cavaliers.

Liberty posted 10.5 blocks versus Virginia Tech and 13 against Virginia, with Kendle Rollins totaling eight blocks against UVA. Loren Thomas hit .611 against Virginia Tech, while Caroline Douglas had 14 kills in both matches.

Blocking the Competition

Liberty led the Big South in 2011 while averaging 2.44 blocks per set, and the team is making a strong case to defend its blocking title this season.

The Lady Flames have recorded 10 or more blocks in three out of the last four matches, including 10.5 against Virginia Tech and 13 versus Virginia on Saturday.

Loren Thomas paces the Lady Flames with 1.04 blocks per set, and on Saturday became the third player in program history with 400 career blocks.

Kendle Rollins recorded a career-high eight blocks against Virginia, while Ansley Gebben had five blocks versus Virginia Tech.

.500 Club

On Saturday against Virginia Tech, Loren Thomas hit .611 (14-3-18), the highest attack percentage by a Lady Flame with 12 or more kills in a match this season.

A total of four current Lady Flames have at least one .500 match in their careers.

Caroline Douglas opened her career by hitting .548 (19-2-31) on Aug. 24 against UNCG, and hit .538 (16-2-26) the next day versus Elon.

Last year, Kendle Rollins recorded a .727 attack percentage in a sweep of The Citadel, Sept. 17, 2011 while Melissa Racz hit .500, Nov. 5, 2011 as Liberty swept High Point.

Last Line of Defense

Sophomore Gabrielle Shipe has led or tied for the team lead in digs in all 12 matches. She tied her career high with 22 digs in Saturday's matchup with the Virginia Cavaliers, marking her 10th 10-dig match and third 20-dig contest this season.

Liberty has gotten strong contributions from several players in the back row this season, as Lillie Happel and Becca Haraf have five 10-dig matches apiece and Jade Craycraft and Ansley Gebben have three 10-dig matches each.

Acing the Test

Liberty served up 10 aces in its most recent match, a 3-2 setback at Virginia, its third 10-ace match this season. The Lady Flames pace the Big South Conference with 1.71 aces per set. Additionally, three Liberty players rank in the conference's top 10 in aces.

Kendle Rollins and Lillie Happel both have registered five aces in a match this season, while Becca Haraf served up a career-high four aces at Virginia on Saturday.

Balance Up Front

So far this season, three Lady Flames average two or more kills per set. Caroline Douglas leads the team with 2.94 kills per set, followed by Ansley Gebben at 2.43 and Loren Thomas at 2.10.

Last year, Lillie Happel led the way with 3.38 kills per set, while Thomas, at 2.30, was the only other Lady Flame to average two or more kills per set. In 2010, four Lady Flames had a 2.0 or higher kills average.

Leading the Pack

At present, the Lady Flames sit atop the Big South statistical charts in both hitting percentage (.239) and aces per set (1.71). Liberty's aces per set rank 10th in the first NCAA Division I statistical listing.

Additionally, redshirt freshman Caroline Douglas is first in the conference with a .342 attack percentage. Douglas is the only conference freshman to rank in the top 10 in hitting percentage.

Liberty vs. Georgetown

All-Time Series: Georgetown leads, 2-1

Current Series Streak: Liberty W1

Last Meeting: Liberty 3, Georgetown 1 (Nov. 23, 2007 – at VCU) (regular-season finale)

Georgetown (6-6) raced out to a 6-1 record after seven matches, including a sweep of the D.C. Classic and a 3-0 win over Virginia. The Hoyas have lost five in a row, most recently losing to Presbyterian College of the Big South on Saturday. Alex Johnson leads Georgetown with 4.26 kills per set, followed by Dani White at 3.03 kills per set. Haley Lowrance averages 11.48 assists per set, good for second in the BIG EAST.

Georgetown is 2-1 all-time against the Lady Flames, sweeping the first two meetings in 1989 and 1990. Liberty won the most recent meeting on Nov. 23, 2007, downing the Hoyas 3-1 in the regular season-ending VCU Thanksgiving Tournament.

Arlisa Williams, Georgetown's seventh-year head coach, holds a 76-109 career record, but has gone an even 63-63 since the start of the 2008 season. Williams' Hoyas lost their only meeting against Liberty, Nov. 23, 2007 in Richmond, Va.

Liberty is 9-16 all-time against 2012 members of the BIG EAST, facing 11 of its 14 volleyball programs. Shane Pinder's teams are 2-6 vs. BIG EAST competition. Liberty's most recent win over a BIG EAST team came against Rutgers, Sept. 6, 2008 in Fairfax, Va.

The Last Meeting

Liberty set a program NCAA Division I record for victories, earning a 3-1 victory over Georgetown in the regular-season finale, Nov. 23, 2007 at the VCU Thanksgiving Tournament. With the win, the Big South champion Lady Flames advanced their record to 27-8 before facing No. 7 California in the NCAA Tournament one week later.

The Lady Flames hit .276 for the match and collected 102 digs, compared to 68 for the Hoyas. Three Lady Flames had double-doubles, in Kallie Corbin (58 assists, 24 digs), Jessica Nelson (19 kills, 26 digs) and Nicki Scripko (15 kills, 12 digs). Kortney Robinson led Georgetown with 14 kills.

Capital Opportunity

For the second year in a row, and 16th time in program history, Liberty will play a match in Washington, D.C.

Last year, on Caroline Douglas' birthday, Aug. 31, the Lady Flames faced No. 16 Oregon at American University's Bender Arena. The Ducks defeated Liberty, 3-0, although the Lady Flames held a 7-2 edge in blocks thanks in part to Loren Thomas' five blocks.

Liberty's last win in Washington, D.C., was a 3-1 victory over Morgan State on Sept. 7, 2002 at the George Washington Invitational. Current Liberty assistant coaches Jennifer Vaden (13 kills, 21 digs) and Rebecca Rudnick (eight kills, four blocks) both had strong outings against Morgan State that day.

Off and Running

The Lady Flames opened this season at 8-2, tying their best 10-match start since joining the Big South Conference in 1991. In 2008, Liberty won its first eight matches in a row, and was 8-2 after 10 matches on the way to a 25-9 record and a Big South championship.

In 1996, Liberty was 8-2 after 10 contests, finishing with a 24-10 overall record.

Liberty's recently-completed eight-match winning streak was its longest since an eight-match streak in October of 2010, as the 2010 squad went 25-9.

Great Expectations

The Lady Flames have been predicted to win the 2012 Big South volleyball championship, while Loren Thomas was the Preseason Player of the Year and Lillie Happel also appeared on the preseason all-conference list. Thomas is the first Lady Flame since Kallie Corbin in 2009 to be named Big South Preseason Volleyball Player of the Year.

Liberty has been voted the Big South preseason favorite for the eighth time, and second year in a row.

Champions

Liberty swept Radford on Nov. 20 to claim its sixth Big South Conference championship and first since 2008. Loren Thomas was named Big South Tournament MVP and was joined on the all-tournament team by senior Kelly Haseman and sophomore Lillie Happel.

The Lady Flames went on to face four-time defending national champion Penn State in the NCAA Volleyball Championship first round, falling in three sets.

A Lot Returning, More Arriving

Liberty returns six starters from last year's 20-win, conference-champion team. Kelly Haseman, the program's career digs leader, was the lone graduating starter from 2011.

Three all-conference players (Loren Thomas, Lillie Happel and Jade Craycraft) are back, and are joined by a deep roster.

This year's roster features 18 players, 11 of whom are freshmen or sophomores. This year's true freshman class of seven is the largest for Liberty volleyball since the 1993 team had seven freshmen.

Drive for 5

The Liberty volleyball team has posted five straight 20-win seasons, earned five conference regular-season titles and made five consecutive appearances in the conference final (2007-2011). Hawaii is the only NCAA Division I volleyball program, besides Liberty, about which each of the following three statements is true.

Liberty is:

- one of five volleyball programs in NCAA Division I to have won or shared their conference or division regular-season championship in each of the last five years.
- one of 10 volleyball programs in NCAA Division I to appear in its conference championship match in each of the last five seasons.
- one of 29 teams in NCAA Division I with five or more 20-win seasons in a row.
