2008 (Jr.): Recognized as the first honorable mention AVCA Division I All-American in program history ... AVCA All-East Region performer ... Lady Flames' first VaSID State Player of the Year ... first Liberty player to be tabbed a back-to-back first-team VaSID All-State performer ... Big South Player of the Year (first setter to win the award since 1995) ... finished third in the voting for Big South Women's Student-Athlete of the Year (covering all conference sports) ... first player in conference history to repeat as Big South Championship MVP ... first-team All-Big South honoree for the second year in a row ... Big South Player of the Week on Oct. 27 ... two-time CVU.com Top Performer (Nov. 18 & 25) ... led the Lady Flames and finished second in the Big South in both assists (1,144) and service aces (45) ... now owns the top three single-season ace totals in Liberty history, under the rally-scoring format ... became the first Lady Flame ever to reach 3,500 assists and 1,000 digs during her career ... set for a Liberty team which paced the Big South in attack percentage (.228), kills (1,653) and assists (1,533) ... led the Lady Flames with 13 double-doubles, including six in her last eight outings of the season ... recorded a season-best 60 assists against High Point (10/14) ... made a solid, all-around contribution in the Big South Championship match versus Coastal Carolina (11/23), hitting .353 with seven kills, 46 assists and a team-high 21 digs ... played outside hitter for the first time in her career on Nov. 7 & 8, and led the team in kills during both contests ... had a career-high 19 kills and a season-high 22 digs at UNC Asheville (11/7) ... serves as vice president of Liberty's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (S.A.A.C.).

2007 (So.): First-team VaSID All-State honoree ... first-team All-Big South pick ... voted Big South Championship MVP ... named honorable mention Stellar Spiker by CVU.com ... same organization tabbed her National Player of the Week on Oct. 30 ... three-time Big South Player of the Week (9/17, 10/22, 10/29) ... MVP of the Liberty Invitational presented by Pepsi (8/24-25) ... also named to the all-tournament team at the VCU 3rd Degree Sportswear Invitational (8/31-9/1), Wright State Raider Challenge (9/7-8) and Villanova Classic (9/14-15) ... led the Big South with 1,625 assists, the third-highest figure in program history ... ranked No. 34 nationally with 12.70 assists per game ... played all 128 games at setter for a team which led the Big South and set a new Liberty NCAA Division I single-season record by hitting .232 ... also led the team and sat second in the conference with 49 service aces ... ranked third on the team with a career-best 82 blocks ... tied for third among conference performers with 17 double-doubles, including a pair of triple-doubles ... boosted career total to six triple-doubles ... pair of triple-doubles consisted of 10 kills, 44 assists and a season-best 25 digs versus Binghamton (9/15) and 10 kills, a career-high 66 assists and 20 digs at Presbyterian (11/2) ... her 66 assists equaled the most by a Big South setter in 2007 and marked one of her two 60-assist contests on the season ... also recorded 61 assists at Radford (9/22) ... tallied a Liberty

season-high five aces during home victory over UNC Asheville (10/14) ... hit .545 with career-high seven blocks versus North Carolina Central (11/6) ... Big South Presidential Honor Roll selection.

2006 (Fr.): Started at setter upon arrival at Liberty ... first player in program history to be named VaSID State Rookie of the Year ... also a second-team VaSID All-State pick ... became first Lady Flame since 2001 to be named Big South Freshman of the Year ... Big South All-Conference second-team honoree ... included on Big South All-Freshman team ... honored as Big South Player of the Week on Nov. 13 and Big South Freshman of the Week on Oct. 9 and Oct. 30 ... named to the all-tournament teams at the Virginia Tech Hokie Invitational (9/8-9) and the Army of One Classic (9/15-16) ... led the conference with 0.49 aces per game ... her 52 aces were the most by a Liberty player since the 1997 season ... paced the conference with four triple-doubles ... tied for fourth nationally in triple-doubles ... led Liberty in assists (1,074) and aces, while ranking second in attack percentage (.219), digs (376) and blocks (68) ... tallied nine service aces against Navy (9/15), the most by a Lady Flame since rally scoring was instituted in 2001 ... posted her first career triple-double (12 kills, season-best 53 assists and 17 digs) in five-game win over Charleston Southern (10/8) ... notched a triple-double (10 kills, 45 assists and 14 digs) against Birmingham-Southern (10/28) ... ended the regular season with back-to-back triple-doubles ... went for 11 kills, 48 assists, 20 digs and season-high six blocks versus East Tennessee State (11/7) ... contributed career-high 14 kills, 47 assists and 20 digs to victory at Radford (11/11) ... went over the 20-dig mark six times, including a career-best 26-dig effort at UNC Greensboro (10/10) ... earned spot on Big South Presidential Honor Roll.

Prep: Earned four letters in volleyball, three at Westview High School and one at La Quinta High School ... was a third-team all-metro pick in 2001 ... voted league player of the year and first-team all-league at La Quinta High School in 2002 ... led La Quinta to league championship as a sophomore ... led Westview to second place in the league standings in both 2003 and 2004 ... as a junior, was a first-team all-league honoree ... included on second-team all-state ledger as a junior ... garnered first-team all-state recognition as a senior ... was a first-team all-league selection and the league's player of the year as a senior ... active with Portland Volleyball Club-18 black team the last two years of her prep career ... earned "Renaissance Girl" scholarship at 2006 Volleyball Festival.

If you could add a match to this year's schedule, which team would you want to play?

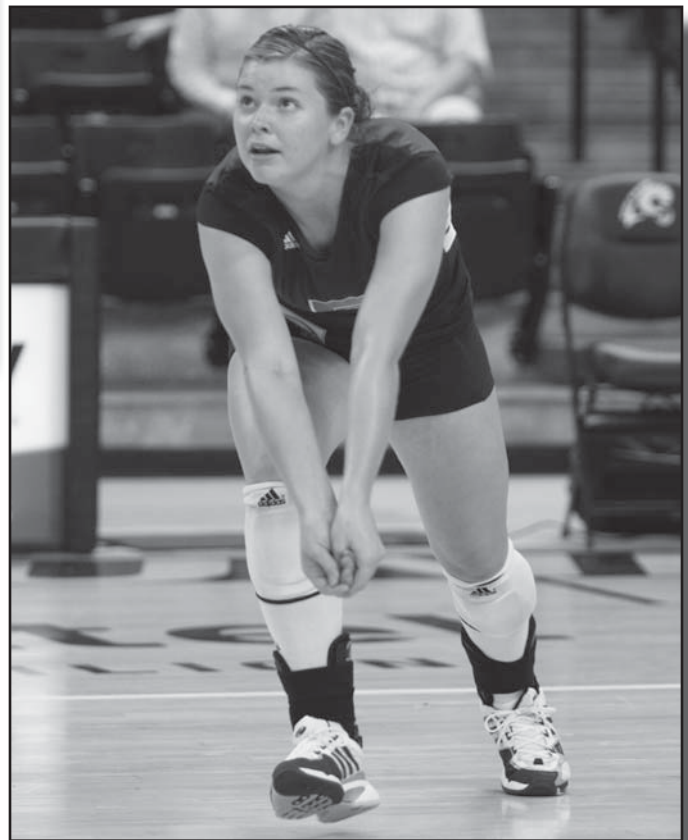
I would love to play Portland State. Growing up in Portland, Ore., I know a lot of those girls and would love to introduce them to Liberty Volleyball.

2008 (Jr.): Honorable mention AVCA All-East Region honoree ... first-team VaSID All-State selection ... second-team All-Big South performer for the second year in a row ... Big South Player of the Week on Oct. 13 ... made the all-tournament team at all four of the Lady Flames' season-opening tournaments (VCU Third Degree Sportswear Invitational, Patriot Invitational, Varney's Kansas State Invitational and Golden Dome Invitational) ... led the Big South and set a school rally-scoring record with her .353 attack percentage ... only the second player (also Erin McKeown in 2002 and 2003) in program history to pace the Big South in attack percentage ... hit .300 or higher in 25 of her 34 matches ... also ranked second on the team in both kills (322) and blocks (86) ... helped Liberty record a come-from-behind 3-2 win at Gardner-Webb (11/1), posting a season-best 14 kills and a career-high 11 blocks ... her block total tied McKeown's Liberty rally-scoring record and equaled the highest output by a Big South player in 2008 ... hit .750 (nine kills in 12 attempts) against Saint Francis (Pa.) on Sept. 5, helping the Lady Flames hit a team-record .483 for the match ... closed out the year by hitting .400 or higher in four consecutive matches, including .467 versus Coastal Carolina in the Big South Championship match (11/23) and .412 against Nebraska in the NCAA Division I Tournament (12/5) ... Big South All-Academic team ... Big South Presidential Honor Roll.

2007 (So.): Second-team VaSID All-State honoree ... also a second-team All-Big South selection in her first season with the Lady Flames, after transferring from Auburn ... started all 36 matches at middle blocker, where she became a consistent offensive weapon ... led the Lady Flames and ranked third in the Big South with a .328 attack percentage ... second on the squad and 10th in the conference with 106 blocks ... recorded the second-most service aces (34) and the third-most kills (391) among the Lady Flames ... finished with a season-best 10 blocks against Villanova (9/14) ... tabbed Big South Player of the Week on Sept. 24, after making a successful debut in conference play (career-high 19 kills and .515 attack percentage at Radford on 9/23) ... performance came in the midst of a stretch which saw her hit .300 or higher in 18 of 19 matches ... tied then-program rally-scoring record by hitting .684 in a win at UNC Asheville (11/3), recording 14 kills in 19 swings, with only one attack error ... made the Big South Presidential Honor Roll.
