Today's Game

Liberty will tip off its 42nd season of women's basketball Friday at 6 p.m. when it welcomes Duke to the Vines Center for the first time. The new-look Lady Flames will be seeking their first-ever win over the Blue Devils, their first season-opening win at home since Nov. 13, 2009 and their first victory over an ACC foe since a Dec. 30, 2008 triumph at Virginia Tech.

The "Starting Five" - Liberty's Top Storylines

- 1) Liberty is picked fourth in the Big South (its lowest preseason projection since 1996-97) after losing 90.6 percent of its scoring from last season. The 2015-16 Lady Flames went 20-13, finishing as the Big South regular-season and tournament runner-up and making their second Postseason WNIT appearance.
- 2) More than half of Liberty's players (8 of 15) have not yet made their debut in a Lady Flames uniform, including seven freshmen.
- 3) Liberty is 0-4 all-time against Duke, including a 79-41 setback at Cameron Indoor Stadium last season (Dec. 17, 2015). Only five Lady Flames who appeared in that game are still on the roster. On the flip side, Duke is 22-0 all-time versus Big South opponents.
- 4) Friday's game will mark the third time in four seasons Liberty is playing host to an ACC opponent at the Vines Center, following Virginia on Nov. 19, 2013 (L, 61-60) and NC State on Nov. 20, 2015 (L, 61-53). This is the first time the Lady Flames have ever opened their season with an ACC foe.
- 5) Audrey Rettstatt, the Lady Flames' only senior, will make her return to the court following an ACL injury on Dec. 2, 2015 which cut her junior season short.

Notes and Anecdotes

- Duke's first-ever visit to the Vines Center will mark the fourth straight season the Blue Devils are opening on the road.

- Duke went 20-12 last season, but saw its streak of 21 straight NCAA Tournament appearances come to an end.

- Led by Rebecca Greenwell's 26 points, No. 13/11 Duke posted a 79-41 victory over Liberty at Cameron Indoor Stadium on Dec. 17, 2015. Only five of the 14 Lady Flames who played in that game are still on the roster and Jordan Woods (3 points) is the only current player who scored against Duke last season.

- Both Liberty and Duke are picked lower than usual in their respective preseason conference polls. The Lady Flames' No. 4 listing is their lowest since a No. 7 ranking entering the 1996-97 season. Meanwhile, the Blue Devils are picked to finish No. 6 in the ACC this season. Duke has not appeared that low in the poll since heading into the 1993-94 season at No. 6.

- Duke lost last year's leading scorer and rebounder Azura Stevens (18.9 ppg, 9.6 rpg), as she transferred to UConn after the season. However, the Blue Devils will gain the services of All-American guard Lexie Brown this season, following her transfer from Maryland. Big things are also expected from freshman Leonna Odom, a 6-2 forward from Lompoc, Calif.

- Duke, which is 22-0 all-time against Big South opponents, will face a pair of Big South foes during the opening week of the 2016-17 season. After opening its year at Liberty on Friday, the Blue Devils will host Longwood on Tuesday (Nov. 15).

On This Date

Liberty is 2-0 all-time on Nov. 11, including wins over Norfolk State (2006, 91-53) and UNCG (2011, 61-46). This is the earliest the Lady Flames are tipping off a season since the 2013-14 campaign, when Liberty opened with a 66-56 setback at Charlotte on Nov. 8, 2013.

Against the ACC

Liberty is seeking its first win over an ACC opponent since Dec. 30, 2008. That day, the Lady Flames notched a 45-43 victory at Virginia Tech in the championship game of the Hokie Hardwood Classic.

The Lady Flames are opening their season against an ACC foe for the first time in program history.

Friday's game will mark the third time in four seasons Liberty is playing host to an ACC opponent at the Vines Center, following Virginia on Nov. 19, 2013 (L, 61-60) and NC State on Nov. 20, 2015 (L, 61-53).

Tar Heel State Tussle

Liberty is opening its season against a team from North Carolina for the fourth straight season, following back-to-back season openers versus Charlotte in 2013-14 and 2014-15 and the Lady Flames' 2015-16 lid-lifter at Appalachian State.

The Lady Flames, who went 8-5 against North Carolina-based foes in 2015-16, have 10 games scheduled against Tar Heel State opponents in 2016-17.

Three current Lady Flames have North Carolina ties, including Kaila Ballard (native of Gatesville). Additionally, Stephanie Patton graduated from Hayesville High School in Hayesville, N.C., and Jordan Woods spent her first year of college at Davidson in Davidson, N.C.

Unfamiliar Role

Liberty was picked fourth in the Big South preseason poll, as voted upon by the conference's head coaches. This is the first time since 1996-97 (seventh place) that the Lady Flames have been listed outside the top two in the preseason poll.

The 1996-97 Lady Flames went on to capture the first Big South championship in program history.

This is also the first time since 2009-10 that Liberty is not represented on the Big South preseason all-conference team. That season, Devon Brown and Avery Warley were first team All-Big South performers at the end of the year.

A Look Back at the 2016-17 Lady Flames

- The Liberty women's basketball team wrapped up another successful season with its second Postseason WNIT appearance, marking its 18th postseason tournament appearance in 20 years.

- The Lady Flames finished the 2015-16 campaign with a 20-13 overall record and a 15-5 Big South mark, finishing as the Big South regular-season and tournament runner-up.

- Liberty posted a winning record for the 20th season in a row and recorded its ninth consecutive 20-win season.

Five seniors graduated from last year's team, including Katelyn Adams, Sadalia Ellis, Jaymee Fisher-Davis, Catherine Kearney and Ashley Rininger. Adams, Kearney and Rininger each stand 6-4 or taller.

- The Lady Flames won 117 games in five years (Katelyn Adams, Catherine Kearney and Ashley Rininger's time on campus), including three Big South titles and three NCAA Tournament appearances.

- The Lady Flames' five seniors totaled 4,260 career points and 2,829 career rebounds.

Big Shoes to Fill, Part 2

- In total, Liberty lost 90.6 percent of its scoring from the 2015-16 season.

- Liberty's current roster has totaled 229 points (KK Barbour is the leader with 65) and 201 rebounds (Barbour is the leader with 61) for the Lady Flames.

- Current Lady Flames have started five career games, including three starts by Audrey Rettstatt and two by Sheana Vega.
