Today's Game

Liberty (0-2) will close out its season-opening three-game homestand by playing host to Appalachian State (1-1) for the first time since 1988-89, the Lady Flames' first NCAA Division I season. The contest is slated for Thursday at 7 p.m. inside the Vines Center.

The "Starting Five" - Liberty's Top Storylines

- 1) Liberty will attempt to pick up its first win of the season against Appalachian State for the second straight year. The Lady Flames posted a 74-68 season-opening victory in Boone on Nov. 13, 2015, but only two current Liberty players (KK Barbour and Audrey Rettstatt) appeared in that game.
- 2) Liberty has defeated a Sun Belt opponent in each of the last two seasons, including a 73-71 triumph at Georgia State on Nov. 30, 2014 and last year's victory at Appalachian State.
- 3) The Lady Flames will look to snap their three-game home losing streak, the team's longest run of losses at home since the 1995-96 season.
- 4) After Thursday, Liberty will only have one more home game in 2016. Eight of the Lady Flames' next nine contests following the Appalachian State matchup will be played away from Lynchburg.
- 5) Freshmen have played a key role for Liberty during the season's first two games. Three freshmen (Keyen Green, Ola Makurat and Lela Sellers) have started both contests. Meanwhile, freshmen paced the Lady Flames in scoring (Kierra Johnson-Graham) and rebounding (Green) against James Madison on Tuesday.

Notes and Anecdotes

- Thursday's game will be Appalachian State's first visit to the Vines Center. The Mountaineers' only previous game at Liberty (Feb. 4, 1989) was played at Liberty Gym.

- Appalachian State is 1-1 to start the season, including a 72-67 victory over Gardner-Webb on Saturday in Chicago. The Mountaineers are slated to face four Big South opponents this season. Following its early matchups with Gardner-Webb and Liberty, Appalachian State will host Radford on Dec. 4 and UNC Asheville on Dec. 21.

- Liberty is looking to defeat a Sun Belt opponent for the third straight season. The Lady Flames recorded a 73-71 victory at Georgia State on Nov. 30, 2014 and opened the 2015-16 season with a 74-68 triumph at Appalachian State.

- Only two current Lady Flames (KK Barbour and Audrey Rettstatt) appeared in last year's season opener at Appalachian State. Ashley Rininger paced the Lady Flames with 23 points and 11 rebounds, while Joi Jones scored a team-high 18 points for the Mountaineers.

- Coming off of a 10-20 season, Appalachian State was picked to finish eighth in the Sun Belt this year.

- The Mountaineers are opening the season with five straight road games and will not play their home opener until Nov. 27.

On This Date

Liberty is 4-2 all-time on Nov. 17, including victories in each of its last three contests on the date. The Lady Flames posted a 59-40 win over Buffalo at the Michigan State Spartan Chevrolet Classic on Nov. 17, 2001 and recorded home victories over UNCG (60-42 on Nov. 17, 2009) and Sacred Heart (68-63 on Nov. 17, 2012).

Tar Heel State Tussle

Liberty is facing a team from North Carolina for the second time during the season's opening week, following its 98-38 loss to Duke on Friday. The Lady Flames, who have 10 games scheduled against Tar Heel State opponents this season, were 8-5 against North Carolina-based foes in 2015-16.

Three current Lady Flames have North Carolina ties, including Kaila Ballard (native of Gatesville). Additionally, Stephanie Patton graduated from Hayesville High School in Hayesville, N.C., and Jordan Woods spent her first year of college at Davidson in Davidson, N.C.

Uncommon Occurrence

Dating back to last season, Liberty has lost three straight home games. This is the Lady Flames' longest home losing skid since Liberty dropped four straight at the Vines Center spanning Jan. 20-Feb. 3, 1996.

Three of a Kind

Three true freshmen (Keyen Green, Ola Makurat and Lela Sellers) started during Friday's season opener against Duke. It marked the first time since 1996-97 that three Liberty freshmen (Jennifer Jess, Elena Kisseleva and Sarah Wilkerson) earned the starting nod together in their collegiate debuts.

Unfamiliar Role

Liberty was picked fourth in the Big South preseason poll, as voted upon by the conference's head coaches. This is the first time since 1996-97 (seventh place) that the Lady Flames have been listed outside the top two in the preseason poll.

The 1996-97 Lady Flames went on to capture the first Big South championship in program history.

This is also the first time since 2009-10 that Liberty is not represented on the Big South preseason all-conference team.

A Look Back at the Lady Flames' 62-48 Loss to James Madison

- James Madison put three players into double figures and shot 75 percent in the fourth quarter, closing out a 62-48 triumph over Liberty, Tuesday at the Vines Center.
- Freshman Kierra Johnson-Graham gave the Lady Flames a second-half spark, finishing with a team-high 11 points in just 11 minutes off the bench.
- Liberty fell to 0-2 after struggling from both the field (28.8 percent, 15-of-52) and the free throw line (50 percent, 13-of-26) for the second straight game.
- James Madison improved to 2-1 with its second straight win, despite Precious Hall (17 points, 6-of-22 FG) being held well below her 31.5 ppg scoring average.
- The Dukes became just the second in-state opponent to defeat Liberty in its last 17 Commonwealth clashes despite being limited to a season-low 62 points.
- Audrey Rettstatt scored all eight of her points after halftime for the Lady Flames, while Keyen Green grabbed a team-high eight boards.
- Aided by Johnson-Graham, the Liberty bench outscored James Madison's reserves, 27-5, and accounted for all five of the Lady Flames' triples for the game.

Big Shoes to Fill

Five seniors graduated from last year's team, including Katelyn Adams, Sadalia Ellis, Jaymee Fisher-Davis, Catherine Kearney and Ashley Rininger. Adams, Kearney and Rininger each stand 6-4 or taller.

- The Lady Flames won 117 games in five years (Katelyn Adams, Catherine Kearney and Ashley Rininger's time on campus), including three Big South titles and three NCAA Tournament appearances.
- The Lady Flames' five seniors totaled 4,260 career points and 2,829 career rebounds.

Big Shoes to Fill, Part 2

- In total, Liberty lost 90.6 percent of its scoring from the 2015-16 season.
- Liberty's current roster had totaled 229 points (KK Barbour led with 65) and 201 rebounds (Barbour led with 61) for the Lady Flames, entering 2016-17.
- Current Lady Flames had started five career games entering the 2016-17 season, including three starts by Audrey Rettstatt and two by Sheana Vega.
- Rettstatt is the only player on this year's team who had ever scored in double figures, while Barbour was the only Lady Flame with a double-digit rebounding game to her credit.

New Kids on the Block

Eight Lady Flames are set to make their debut in a Liberty uniform this season, including one junior (Nene Johnson) and seven freshmen (Kaila Ballard, Keyen Green, Iva Ilic, Kierra Johnson-Graham, Ola Makurat, Lela Sellers and Kaitlyn Stovall).

One of a Kind

Audrey Rettstatt is the lone senior on the Lady Flames' 2016-17 roster. This is the second time in four seasons that Liberty has had only one senior. Jasmine Gardner was the team's lone senior in 2013-14.

International Flavor

This year's roster includes two foreign-born freshmen, including Iva Ilic (Croatia) and Ola Makurat (Poland). They are Liberty's first international players since Jelena Antic of Macedonia wrapped up her time with the Lady Flames in 2010-11.
