Today's Game

Liberty (0-3) will take to the road for the first time in 2016-17 on Friday, when the Lady Flames travel to Valparaiso (2-2). The first-ever hardwood meeting between the Lady Flames and Crusaders is slated for 6 p.m. Eastern at the Athletics-Recreation Center.

The "Starting Five" - Liberty's Top Storylines

- 1) Valparaiso Head Coach Tracey Dorow is the sister of Liberty Assistant Coach Andy Bloodworth. One of Dorow's assistants is former Liberty standout Megan (Frazee) Leuzinger. Meanwhile, Liberty Director of Operations Sarah Boruta formerly served in the same capacity under Dorow at Ferris State.
- 2) Liberty's first road game of the season opens a challenging stretch which will see the Lady Flames play eight of their next nine contests away from Lynchburg. Liberty has posted a winning record in road/neutral games for nine straight seasons, including a 10-9 mark in 2015-16.
- 3) Liberty will be facing a member of the Horizon League (formerly Midwestern Collegiate Conference) for just the fourth time. The Lady Flames are seeking their first victory over a Horizon League foe.
- 4) The Lady Flames will aim to avoid just their second 0-4 start to a season in Carey Green's 18 years as head coach. Liberty previously opened the 2013-14 campaign at 0-4.
- 5) Liberty has received strong production from its bench during the season's first three games. Sophomore post player Molly Reagan leads the way, scoring a team-high 7.3 ppg on 75 percent (9-of-12) from the field thus far.

- Liberty and Valparaiso will be meeting for the first time on Friday, but the two coaching staffs are quite familiar with one another.
- Tracey Dorow, in her fifth season as Valparaiso's head coach, is the sister of Liberty Assistant Coach Andy Bloodworth.
- One of Dorow's assistants is Megan (Frazee) Leuzinger, a standout performer during her playing career at Liberty (2005-06 through 2008-09).
- Before coming to Valparaiso, Dorow spent 14 seasons as the head coach at Ferris State. Liberty Director of Operations Sarah Boruta served in that same capacity under Dorow for three seasons (2005-06 through 2007-08).
- Coming off of a 10-21 season, Valparaiso was picked to finish ninth in the Horizon League in 2016-17.
- The Crusaders are 2-2 to start the year, led by 6-1 junior forward Dani Franklin. After averaging 10.1 ppg last season, Franklin is posting 20.5 ppg in 2016-17. She scored a career-high 34 points during a season-opening loss at Stetson on Nov. 12.
- Friday's game will be Liberty's fourth all-time meeting with a member of the Horizon League (formerly the Midwestern Collegiate Conference). The Lady Flames are 0-3 all-time against conference members, with losses to Evansville, Milwaukee and Notre Dame. Liberty's most recent Horizon League clash was a 65-56 loss to Milwaukee on Nov. 30, 2003 at the Seminole Classic in Tallahassee, Fla.
- Liberty's last game in Indiana took place on March 18, 2012. That day, the Lady Flames dropped a 74-43 decision to Notre Dame in the opening round of the 2012 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship.

On This Date

Liberty is 10-4 all-time on Nov. 25. However, the Lady Flames have lost two of their last three Nov. 25 contests. Most recently, Liberty fell by a 73-62 score at Elon on Nov. 25, 2014.

The Lady Flames notched a 78-67 home victory over West Virginia on Nov. 25, 2000. Seven years later, Liberty's 61-56 win at Xavier gave the Lady Flames the championship of the National City Xavier Invitational in Cincinnati, Ohio.

Road Warriors

After playing three straight home games to open the 2016-17 season, Liberty will see very little of the Vines Center during the coming weeks. Friday's game at Valparaiso will tip off a stretch of eight road/neutral contests in the next nine outings for the Lady Flames.

The challenging stretch will see Liberty play games in five different states, including Indiana, Maryland, South Carolina, Texas and Virginia.

Last season, the Lady Flames were 10-9 in games played away from Lynchburg. It was the ninth straight year Liberty has posted a winning record in road/neutral contests.

Slow Start

Liberty is 0-3 to begin the 2016-17 season and has lost five straight games dating back to last season.

The Lady Flames' worst start to a season under Carey Green is 0-4 in 2013-14.

The worst start in program history was 0-7, which occurred in both 1977-78 and 1993-94.

Bench Bunch

The Lady Flames have gotten good production from their reserves early in the 2016-17 season. The bench players have outscored the starters in each of the last two games, including a season-high 31 points against Appalachian State on Nov. 17.

For the year, three of Liberty's top four scorers come off the bench, including Molly Reagan (7.3 ppg), Iva Ilic (6.0 ppg) and Kierra Johnson-Graham (5.7 ppg).

Three of a Kind

Three true freshmen (Keyen Green, Ola Makurat and Lela Sellers) started during the Nov. 11 season opener against Duke. It marked the first time since 1996-97 that three Liberty freshmen (Jennifer Jess, Elena Kisseleva and Sarah Wilkerson) earned the starting nod together in their collegiate debuts.

Green, Makurat and Sellers have started each of the first three games to start the 2016-17 season. Along with classmates Iva Ilic and Kierra Johnson-Graham, they comprise five of Liberty's top seven scorers through the early stages of the season.

Unfamiliar Role

Liberty was picked fourth in the Big South preseason poll, as voted upon by the conference's head coaches. This is the first time since 1996-97 (seventh place) that the Lady Flames have been listed outside the top two in the preseason poll.

The 1996-97 Lady Flames went on to capture the first Big South championship in program history.

This is also the first time since 2009-10 that Liberty is not represented on the Big South preseason all-conference team.

A Look Back at the Lady Flames' 66-57 Loss to Appalachian State

- Liberty led by 14 points early in the second half before Appalachian State roared back for a 66-57 victory, Nov. 17 at the Vines Center.

- The Lady Flames owned a 37-23 advantage 49 seconds after halftime. However, the visiting Mountaineers forced 12 Liberty turnovers the rest of the way, spurring a 43-20 game-ending surge.

- Liberty's bench scored 31 points, paced by the duo of Iva Ilic (10 points) and Molly Reagan (nine points, six rebounds, three blocks). However, the Lady Flames dropped to 0-3 with their fourth straight home loss, dating back to last season.

- Joi Jones tallied 10 of her game-high 18 points in the fourth quarter, leading Appalachian State to a 2-1 start to the season.

- The Mountaineers' big advantages came at the free throw line (23-of-37, as compared with Liberty's 7-of-14) and in points off turnovers (21-6).

- The Lady Flames outrebounded their guests by a 49-38 count, including 21 offensive boards. Kierra Johnson-Graham paced all players with a season-high eight boards.

Big Shoes to Fill

Five seniors graduated from last year's team, including Katelyn Adams, Sadalia Ellis, Jaymee Fisher-Davis, Catherine Kearney and Ashley Rininger. Adams, Kearney and Rininger each stand 6-4 or taller.

- The Lady Flames won 117 games in five years (Katelyn Adams, Catherine Kearney and Ashley Rininger's time on campus), including three Big South titles and three NCAA Tournament appearances.

- The Lady Flames' five seniors totaled 4,260 career points and 2,829 career rebounds.

Big Shoes to Fill, Part 2

- In total, Liberty lost 90.6 percent of its scoring from the 2015-16 season.

- Liberty's current roster had totaled 229 points (KK Barbour led with 65) and 201 rebounds (Barbour led with 61) for the Lady Flames, entering 2016-17.

- Current Lady Flames had started five career games entering the 2016-17 season, including three starts by Audrey Rettstatt and two by Sheana Vega.

- Rettstatt is the only player on this year's team who had ever scored in double figures entering the season, while Barbour was the only Lady Flame with a double-digit rebounding game to her credit.

New Kids on the Block

Eight Lady Flames are set to make their debut in a Liberty uniform this season, including one junior (Nene Johnson) and seven freshmen (Kaila Ballard, Keyen Green, Iva Ilic, Kierra Johnson-Graham, Ola Makurat, Lela Sellers and Kaitlyn Stovall).

One of a Kind

Audrey Rettstatt is the lone senior on the Lady Flames' 2016-17 roster. This is the second time in four seasons that Liberty has had only one senior. Jasmine Gardner was the team's lone senior in 2013-14.

International Flavor

This year's roster includes two foreign-born freshmen, including Iva Ilic (Croatia) and Ola Makurat (Poland). They are Liberty's first international players since Jelena Antic of Macedonia wrapped up her time with the Lady Flames in 2010-11.
