Tournament At a Glance

Liberty (1-6) will open a five-game road swing at the Rae & Craig Blair Memorial Tournament, Monday and Tuesday at UTSA's Convocation Center in San Antonio, Texas.

The Lady Flames' inaugural meeting with 2016 NCAA Tournament participant Central Arkansas (6-2) will come in the tournament's opening game, Monday at 5 p.m. Eastern.

Liberty will then square off against host UTSA (3-6) in the tournament finale, Tuesday at 7:15 p.m. Eastern. The Lady Flames have never matched up with the Roadrunners, although UTSA Head Coach Lubomyr Lichonczak faced Liberty 22 times as Radford's head coach (1990-91 through 2000-01).

Coming off of its first victory of the 2016-17 season, Liberty will aim to snap a five-game road/neutral losing streak. The Lady Flames will also seek their first-ever victories in Texas, as Liberty is 0-4 all-time in the Lone Star State.

Freshman Keyen Green, who has notched back-to-back double-doubles, leads the Lady Flames in points (9.3 ppg), rebounds (8.7 rpg), steals (1.1 spg) and blocks (0.6 bpg).

Notes and Anecdotes

• Liberty and Central Arkansas have never squared off on the hardwood. The Sugar Bears are the second of four consecutive first-time opponents the Lady Flames are facing over the span of 19 days, also including West Liberty, UTSA and Dayton.

• Liberty will face a Southland Conference opponent for the first time since Nov. 23, 2007. That day, the Lady Flames posted a 92-52 victory over McNeese State during the National City Xavier Invitational in Cincinnati, Ohio. Liberty is 3-1 all-time against Southland foes, also including a 2-0 mark against Nicholls State and an 0-1 record versus Texas-Arlington.

• The Lady Flames have never faced a team from Arkansas in women's basketball.

• Central Arkansas is coming off of a memorable season. The 2015-16 Sugar Bears won the Southland Conference Tournament title to advance to their first-ever NCAA Tournament. They finished 28-4, setting a program record for victories.

• Picked to finish second in the Southland this season, Central Arkansas is off to a 6-2 start. The Sugar Bears rank among the nation's leaders in scoring defense, allowing only 50.5 ppg. They also commit only 12.6 turnovers per outing.

• Four Sugar Bears are scoring in double figures, paced by Maggie Proffitt and Taylor Baudoin at 12.9 ppg apiece.

• In her fifth season at Central Arkansas and her 28th year as a collegiate head coach, Sandra Rushing is nearing the 500-win milestone. She enters the Rae & Craig Blair Memorial Tournament needing just 13 victories to reach 500.

• Central Arkansas basketball is perhaps best known for producing Scottie Pippen. After playing men's basketball for the Bears from 1983-87, Pippen won six NBA titles and two gold medals before being inducted into the Basketball Hall of Fame in 2010.

Notes and Anecdotes

• Although Liberty and UTSA have never faced one another, Roadrunners Head Coach Lubomyr Lichonczak is quite familiar with the Lady Flames. He served as Radford's head coach for 11 seasons (1990-91 through 2000-01), leading the Highlanders to six straight Big South titles (1991-96) and going 13-9 versus Liberty.

• Lichonczak is 1-3 coaching against Carey Green, including the four Liberty-Radford matchups during the 1999-2000 and 2000-01 seasons.

• Lichonczak later served as an advance scout for the WNBA's San Antonio Silver Stars in 2010. Former Liberty standout Megan Frazee played for the Silver Stars that season.

• Liberty is 5-4 all-time versus Conference USA opponents, although the Lady Flames have lost each of their last two meetings with Conference USA foes (2013-14 and 2014-15 season-opening losses to Charlotte). Liberty is 0-3 all-time when facing a Conference USA team on its home court (Louisville on Dec. 30, 1996, Cincinnati on Nov. 14, 2003 and Charlotte on Nov. 8, 2013).

• One of the Lady Flames' biggest wins in program history was achieved against a Conference USA opponent. Liberty notched an 88-79 victory over DePaul on March 22, 2005, advancing to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship.

• Liberty freshman Ola Makurat, a native of Sierakowice, Poland, may be able to speak her native tongue on Tuesday. UTSA senior Kasia Kiejdrowska hails from Grudziadz, Poland, while assistant coach Ela Mukosiej is also a Poland native.

• Tuesday's contest will be the Roadrunners' eighth home game in their first 11 outings of the 2016-17 season. UTSA enters the Rae & Craig Blair Memorial Tournament with a 3-3 home mark. The Roadrunners dropped a 77-63 contest at Oregon on Nov. 20, marking the only time UTSA will leave its home state until Jan. 12.

On This Date

Liberty is 3-2 all-time on Dec. 19, including victories in each of its last two contests on the date. Ten years ago, the Lady Flames also faced a Southland Conference foe on Dec. 19, losing 58-54 to Texas-Arlington at the Caribbean Classic in Cancun, Mexico.

The Lady Flames' all-time Dec. 20 record stands at 4-6. Liberty's most recent game on the date resulted in a 74-60 loss to Subway Classic host Minnesota on Dec. 20, 2014.

Texas Two-Step

Liberty will be playing its fifth and sixth games in Texas in program history. The Lady Flames are 0-4 all-time in the Lone Star State, going 0-2 on a pair of Texas A&M-Baylor swings (Nov. 22 & 26, 2010 and Nov. 20 & 23, 2012).

Liberty is seeking its first win over a Texas-based opponent since a 70-61 triumph over Houston, Nov. 24, 2007 at the National City Xavier Invitational in Cincinnati, Ohio.

Ironically, the Lady Flames do not have any Texas natives on their roster this season, for the first time since the 2006-07 campaign.

Both Liberty basketball teams will be playing in Texas this week. The men's basketball squad is set to make visits to Lamar (Monday) and Houston (Wednesday).

Ian McCaw, who became Liberty's Athletic Director on Nov. 28, spent 13 years (2003-16) in the same position at Baylor in Waco, Texas.

Tournament Time

Six of Liberty's 11 non-conference games are part of tournaments, including the Navy Classic (Dec. 3-4, Annapolis, Md.), Rae & Craig Blair Memorial Tournament (Dec. 19-20, San Antonio, Texas) and Cavalier Classic (Dec. 28-29, Charlottesville, Va.). The Lady Flames went 0-2 at the Navy Classic earlier this month.

Liberty is playing three regular-season tournaments for the first time since 2008-09 (Preseason WNIT, GW Thanksgiving Classic and Hokie Hardwood Classic).

The Lady Flames' last 2-0 tournament performance came on Nov. 28 & 30, 2014, when Liberty defeated Penn State and Georgia State to win the GSU Thanksgiving Tournament title in Atlanta, Ga.

Road Warriors

The Lady Flames are in the midst of a stretch of eight road/neutral games in nine outings. Liberty is 1-3 during the span thus far, with the victory coming in its lone December home game, against West Liberty (Dec. 10).

The challenging stretch will see Liberty play games in five different states, including Indiana, Maryland, South Carolina, Texas and Virginia.

Last season, the Lady Flames were 10-9 in games played away from Lynchburg. It was the ninth straight year Liberty has posted a winning record in road/neutral contests.

Streaks Summarized

Liberty's 64-38 home victory over West Liberty on Dec. 10 halted the Lady Flames' longest winless streak to start a season under Head Coach Carey Green (0-6), as well as a couple of losing skids. Liberty had lost four straight home games and eight straight contests overall, prior to defeating the Hilltoppers.

At the Rae & Craig Blair Memorial Tournament, Liberty will seek its first 2016-17 victory away from Lynchburg. The Lady Flames are 0-3 away from the Vines Center this season and have lost five consecutive road/neutral tilts, dating back to last season.

A Look Back at Liberty's 64-38 Home Win Over West Liberty

- Keyen Green's second straight double-double (career-high 20 points, game-high 14 rebounds) propelled Liberty to its first victory of the 2016-17 season, 64-38 over West Liberty, Dec. 10 at the Vines Center.

- The visiting Hilltoppers led for most of the first quarter and trailed by only four (29-25) with 6:41 remaining in the third quarter. Green then scored 10 of her points during a 21-2 Liberty run which broke the game open for good.

- Liberty used its considerable size advantage to great effect, dominating West Liberty in rebounding (64-31) and points in the paint (38-12).

- For the fifth straight game, Liberty both won the rebounding battle and grabbed 20 or more offensive boards (23) in the process.

What Can Green Do For You?

Keyen Green headlines the Lady Flames' successful freshman class. The Big South Freshman of the Week on Dec. 5, Green leads the conference and ranks No. 3 among the nation's freshmen in rebounding at 8.7 rpg.

Green has recorded double-doubles in each of her last two outings, headlined by a Big South season-high 17 rebounds at Navy (Dec. 4) and a Liberty season-best 20 points versus West Liberty (Dec. 10).

Fantastic Freshmen

Liberty's seven freshmen have combined to score 61.5 percent of the team's points this season, led by Keyen Green's 9.3 ppg.

Unfamiliar Role

Liberty was picked fourth in the Big South preseason poll, as voted upon by the conference's head coaches. This is the first time since 1996-97 (seventh place) that the Lady Flames have been listed outside the top two in the preseason poll. The 1996-97 Lady Flames went on to capture the first Big South championship in program history.

Big Shoes to Fill

Five seniors graduated from last year's team, including Katelyn Adams, Sadalia Ellis, Jaymee Fisher-Davis, Catherine Kearney and Ashley Rininger. Adams, Kearney and Rininger each stand 6-4 or taller.

- The Lady Flames won 117 games in five years (Katelyn Adams, Catherine Kearney and Ashley Rininger's time on campus), including three Big South titles and three NCAA Tournament appearances.

- The Lady Flames' five seniors totaled 4,260 career points and 2,829 career rebounds.

Big Shoes to Fill, Part 2

- In total, Liberty lost 90.6 percent of its scoring from the 2015-16 season.

- Liberty's current roster had totaled 229 points (KK Barbour led with 65) and 201 rebounds (Barbour led with 61) for the Lady Flames, entering 2016-17.

One of a Kind

Audrey Rettstatt is the lone senior on the Lady Flames' 2016-17 roster. This is the second time in four seasons that Liberty has had only one senior. Jasmine Gardner was the team's lone senior in 2013-14.

International Flavor

This year's roster includes two foreign-born freshmen, including Iva Ilic (Croatia) and Ola Makurat (Poland). They are Liberty's first international players since Jelena Antic of Macedonia wrapped up her time with the Lady Flames in 2010-11.

Liberty has outrebounded each of its last five opponents, grabbing 20 or more offensive rebounds in all five contests. The Lady Flames currently lead the nation with 20.3 offensive boards per game this season.

The Container is Half Full

The Lady Flames are 105-1 under head coach Carey Green when making at least 50 percent of their field goals, including 5-0 last season. Liberty has won the last 32 times it has shot 50 percent or better, since an 83-77 loss to Kentucky in the first round of the 2010 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship (March 20, 2010).

The Container is Half Empty

Duke shot 52.2 percent (36-of-69) from the field against Liberty on Nov. 11, becoming one of only three opponents in the last 104 games to make at least half of its field goal attempts against the Lady Flames.
