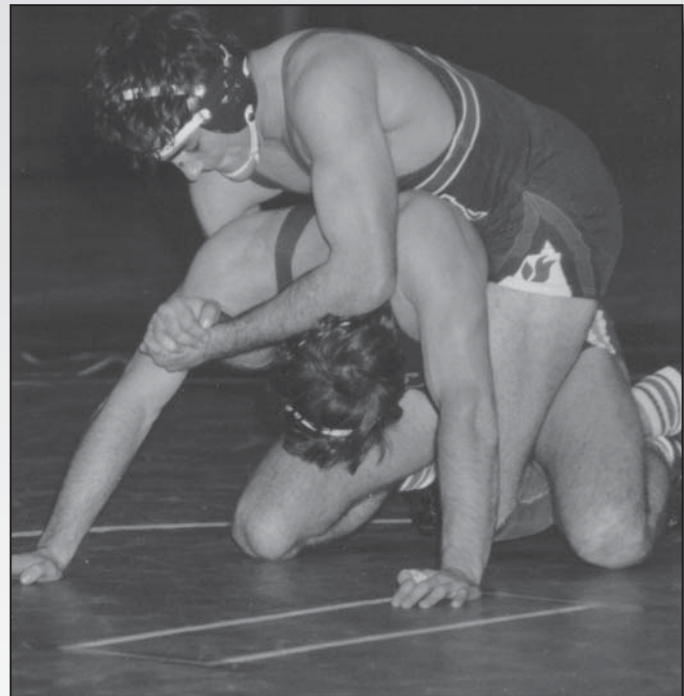

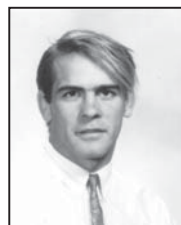

Warren Stewart became Liberty's first-ever NCAA national champion, upsetting No. 4 seed Dane Maue of Colorado School of Mines, 7-0, to capture the 1988 NCAA Division II national title at 142 pounds.

Perry Ainscough is one of four Liberty wrestlers in program history to finish in the Top 12 at the NCAA Division I national championship, claiming victory in three matches at 118 pounds in 1986.
