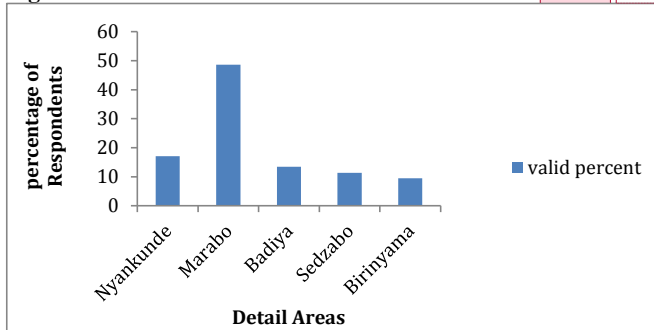

Figure 1. Title of the Chart in Title Case with Dates

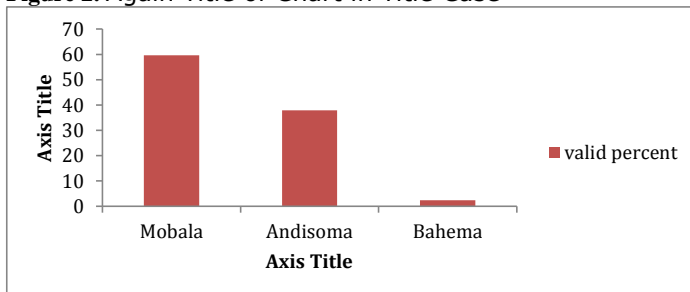
