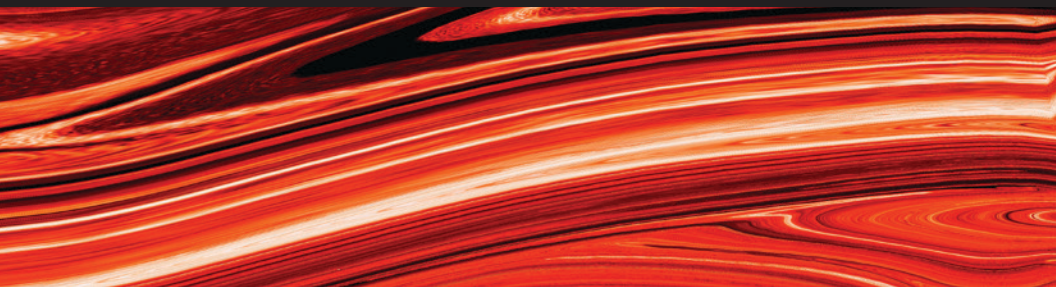
FROM THE FACULTY

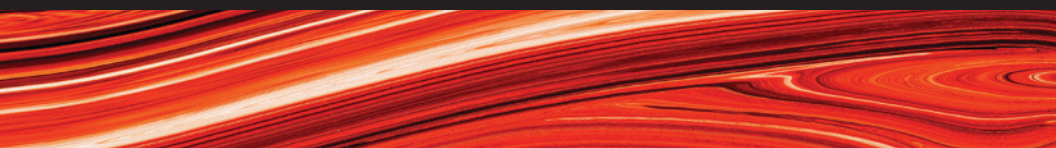
