

Introducing Riverbend Integrative Trauma Treatment and RITT Fellows Programs

We are beginning an outpatient psychotherapy program in Fall 2019 developed to train new therapists and to serve children and families who are dealing with multi-generational and complex treatment issues. We believe in assessing and treating the underlying root trauma to help improve current mood, functioning and abilities for self-care.

We are looking for a diverse group of applicants for our **RITT Fellows** Program who will help us best connect with and serve these families. Applicants will have an MSW or MA in Counseling, be License Eligible and looking for amazing training. Candidates will be open-minded, conscientious, self-directed and motivated with a learners approach

We are offering a two-year training program. At the end of two years, you could have your LCSW/LPC, be an EMDR trained and likely Certified therapist, have extensive experience and training in psychotherapeutic modalities including EMDR, Somatic, Parts Work, Attachment, Substance Abuse and Family Systems Therapies. The essentials for successful work as a psychotherapist!

Fellows can expect to receive:

- weekly individual supervision
- trainings including: EMDR, Vagus (somatic, nervous system focused interventions), Dissociation/Parts Work, Child Therapy, Attachment, Couples and Family Therapy, Substance Abuse, Group work
- rewarding clinical work experience
- a supportive and pleasant work environment.

RITT will require a 2-year commitment to include: working about 25-client hours/week; full participation in and excitement about trainings and supervision. There will be a 3-month probation period. Fellows receive pay in the form of the trainings listed above (worth thousands of dollars) and \$25 for each billable client hour.
