Brandon's House is a dedicated non-profit organization providing specialized counseling services to teenagers and their families—entirely free of charge. Our mission began over three decades ago when our founder, Susan Parr, identified a critical gap in the community: a teenager in need of trauma-informed care was denied services due to insurance limitations. In response, Brandon's House was established as a safe haven where young people can be heard, supported, and healed regardless of their financial circumstances.

Clinical Leadership & Oversight

Our clinical program is led by Brittani Hoyer, LMFT, a veteran of the mental health field since 2005. With over 15 years of therapeutic experience and status as an AAMFT Approved Supervisor, Brittani brings a wealth of diverse expertise to our team. Her professional background spans the full continuum of care, including:

- Inpatient Psychiatric Care (Adult & Pediatric)
- Intensive Outpatient (IOP) and Partial Hospitalization (PHP) Programs
- Community Mental Health and Private Practice
- Non-Profit Clinical Direction

Under her leadership since 2022, Brandon's House has expanded its academic partnerships from a single graduate program to eight, fostering a robust multidisciplinary learning environment.

The Internship Experience

Graduate interns at Brandon's House receive comprehensive, hands-on clinical training designed to bridge the gap between theory and practice. Under direct supervision, students will develop core competencies in:

- **Direct Client Care:** Engaging with a diverse population of adolescents and families.
- **Clinical Documentation:** Mastering initial assessments, diagnostic impressions, and individualized treatment planning.
- **Crisis Management:** Developing the skills necessary to navigate high-acuity situations.
- **Professional Development:** Participating in session video reviews and collaborative clinical supervision.

We take pride in our sustainable culture; many of our interns choose to transition into professional roles at Brandon's House upon graduation, maintaining continuity of care for their clients.
