

CPCE Web-Based Examination: OnVUE

OnVUE examination administration, with online proctoring, allows applicants to take the CPCE in a secure online environment from their homes or offices. With just a simple check-in process, involving ID verification, face-matching technology, and a live greeter, the students can test without leaving the comfort of home. OnVUE is a permanent testing option offered by the CCE as an alternative for students to take their CPCE from the safety of their home, particularly when COVID-19 is on the rise. This helps students who feel unsafe testing in person and allows relief for testing center capacities. Students test from their home or office on a personal computer using the OnVUE software, which students can test out on their computer beforehand to make sure it works. **Students must have a secluded space in which to test, a reliable internet connection, and a computer with a webcam. The exam on this platform is very sensitive and requires a reliable internet connection. If the proctor cannot see the student at any point during the testing time, they will shut down the exam.**

Cost: \$150

Time: Students will have 225 minutes to take the examination using the OnVUE delivery method. An additional five (5) minute NDA and ten (10) minute tutorial are provided for each student at the beginning of the examination administration. Total seat time for the examination is 240 minutes.

Accommodations: Time accommodations are now possible with this platform. However, any students needing accommodations other than additional time accommodations will need to schedule an exam at a Pearson testing center.

Issues during exam: If a student experiences an issue when testing the CPCE OnVUE method, they will need to contact the CCE CPCE coordinator, Carri Curtis, with their case number and case details; the CCE will speak with Pearson on the student's behalf. During the OnVUE investigation, CCE will reauthorize the student for the CPCE-CBT (offsite testing), so they may test at a Pearson Vue testing center, and the student will be responsible for the exam fee.
