This chart provides visualization of how these elements should appear in your paper (including smaller 10-point font for notes, in which the first line is indented ½”, and regular 12-point font for bibliographic entries, in which line(s) 2+ are indented ½” (called a “hanging indent”). Liberty University recommends that students use the template provided in our [Turabian Quick Guide](#), which is programmed with the proper font/spacing/indentions

Note that ALL resource types follow the same rules as to the number of authors. Those are only depicted under the “Books” sections below, but journal articles and other resources with multiple authors will follow the same rules shown there based on the number of authors.
