CLEAR BAG POLICY

In an effort to enhance safety and expedite entrance into Williams Stadium, Liberty University adheres to a clear bag policy. Only clear tote bags that do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12" and one-gallon plastic freezer bags will be allowed into Williams Stadium. In addition, small handheld clutch purses no larger than 4.5" x 6.5" will be permitted. All guests will be required to go through security checks prior to entering the Commencement venue.

ALLOWABLE ITEMS

All bags will be searched.

- Chairback stadium seats/seat cushions
- Diaper bags

- Strollers/wheelchairs

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Aerosols

- Drones and other unmanned aircraft systems

- Laser pointers

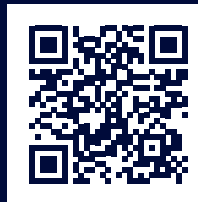
