- 2.) Students who have learned Spanish without formal academic credit in a college or university may complete the following requirements:
 - Achieved a minimum score of 600 on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) (250 on the computer-based exam or 100 on the Internet-based exam), if English is not the native language. TOEFL Testing Information website: http://www.ets.org/toefl/
 *Native speakers of English are exempt from this test. Note: The VDOE may require TOEFL Exam, if English is not the native language.
 - Achieved a qualifying score ("advanced low") on the ACTFL OPI (Oral Proficiency Interview) and WPT (Writing Proficiency Test)

 - Earned a minimum of **3 semester hours of "methods of teaching foreign languages"** at the elementary and secondary levels from an accredited college or university in the United States.
