

How to Record, Upload, & Embed Kaltura Videos in Canvas

Introduction

This training document will demonstrate the recommended method for embedding Kaltura videos within Canvas.

Please note: You can only embed the Kaltura videos you own. If you recorded or uploaded a video into your account in Kaltura, then you own that video and have the ability to embed it into your course in Canvas.

How to Embed a Kaltura Video


Step 1: The recommended method to add a video is to use the **Embed Kaltura Media** options. To begin, click the **Embed Kaltura Media** icon. Then proceed to **Step 5**.




Step 2: If you do not see the **Embed Kaltura Media** options, click on the **Apps** icon.



Step 3: Click Embed Kaltura Media.




Step 4: If you do not see the Embed Kaltura Media option from the drop down menu, click View All, then click Embed Kaltura Media from the list.




Canvas: How to Embed a Kaltura Video


Step 5: The **Embed Kaltura Media** window will open. You can select an existing video from the list and then click **Embed**.



Step 6: To upload or record a new video, click the +Add New button and select Media Upload or Express Capture



Step 7: The video file is now embedded and will load into the Canvas rich content editor.



Step 8: After embedding the video, **Save** or **Publish** the item you are working on.
