In addition to the specialties listed above, electives include Academic Elective, Endocrinology and Diabetes Care, Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, Neurology, ONMM Outpatient, Pediatrics and Young Adult Medicine, Physical Medicine and Rehab, Psychiatry and Adult Behavioral Health, Sports Medicine, Emergency Medicine, with more being added as the program matures.

Our didactic seminars are held from 1pm-5pm each Thursday afternoon. This protected time covers a multitude of topics. There is weekly review of anatomy/radiology, physiology and pathophysiology associated with the region or diagnosis that is being discussed, workup and treatment of commonly seen musculoskeletal/neuro/ortho/rheum complaints, board prep - either written questions, mock oral exam, or mock practical exam, and OMM techniques. There is monthly discussion around osteopathic philosophy, wellness, systems-based practice, and scholarly work. Journal club is held monthly to increase the skill of finding, dissecting, and implementing up-to-date information for best patient outcomes in the specialty of ONMM. In association with LUCOM, there is an annual Research Day residents can participate in. Faculty and residents share the responsibility of preparing and presenting information as well as guiding discussion.
