

Pre-Med Honor Society Application

Included in the application process, is a one page essay that should explain to the officers a few of the reasons that the individual wants to pursue a career in medicine. This essay is designed to be similar to the essay that is required on most medical school applications and is accompanied by a deadline just like the medical school application. Please turn in a typed, one page essay that explains your answer to the previous question that is stapled to the application. The application should also include 3 signatures from Liberty professors that the individual either has in the present semester or had in previous semesters. This application is only for sophomores and above and the individual should meet all of the GPA requirements (3.3 science and 3.5 overall). The following must also be signed by the applicant to allow the officers to discuss with professors the student's academic/dedication to academic and non-academic goals.
