

GREK 302

- A. Test Description: The GREK 302 ICE exam consists of the equivalent of 100 true-false, matching, translation, fill-in, and short-answer questions covering Greek grammar, syntax, and parsing.
- B. Describe the knowledge and skills required to pass the test.
 - a. The student needs to have a thorough knowledge of basic Greek grammar and syntax, and be able to identify various uses of Greek cases, verbs, moods, voices, tenses, infinitives, participles, pronouns, and clauses; answers questions about grammatical and syntactical issues, translate various passages from the Greek New Testament; identify the syntax of various words in these passages; and parse various Greek words.
- C. List the topics covered in the test.
 - a. The test covers the functions of Greek cases, verbs, moods, voices, tenses, infinitives, participles, pronouns, clauses, various independent and dependent clauses, parsing, and translation of the Greek New Testament. Included is the entire syntactical repertoire of *Greek Grammar Beyond the Basics* by Daniel B. Wallace (Zondervan).
- D. What is the format of the test?
 - a. True-false, Matching, Fill-in, Translation, Short Answer.
- E. How many questions are on the test?
 - a. 100
