**62 Total Hours**

**Cumulative GPA must be 2.0 or higher**

2. Must have an overall average of "C" in the major

**Christian/Community Service Assignments**

3. BWVW 101 & 102 must be completed by all freshmen and transfer students within the first and second semesters of a student's program. This is the Christian/Community Service (CSER) requirement for the first year at Liberty. After completing BWVW 101 & 102, students may choose a CSER from the 200, 300, 400, or 500 series.
