

General Information

To maintain F-1 status, international students must register for a full-time course load. Full-time at the doctoral level requires six (6) residential hours per semester. Students are expected to be enrolled at the beginning of each semester. However, due to the late registration period of many doctoral intensive courses, F-1 doctoral students are required to submit this form before January 1st and July 1st to inform their International Student Advisor of their enrollment plans. After submitting this form, students may change which courses they will take without completing a new form, but they must still meet the residential requirement.

FALL Semester Enrollment Options - July 1st – December 31st (pick two)

- 3 credit semester-long residential course
- 3 credit summer intensive course (July – August)
- 3 credit fall intensive course (September – December)

SPRING Semester Enrollment Options - January 1st – June 30th (pick two)

- 3 credit semester-long residential course
- 3 credit spring intensive course (January – April)
- 3 credit summer intensive course (May – June)

Please note that students may take an unlimited number of online courses each semester. However, online courses will NOT count towards the six hours of residential enrollment required by US Citizenship and Immigration services to maintain F-1 status.
