Graduation Requirements

Complete 60 semester hours
 A minimum of 45 hours must be completed through Liberty University, not to include credits from a prior degree earned through Liberty
 A maximum of 15 hours of transfer credit, including credit from a degree on the same academic level previously earned through Liberty, may be applied to the degree*
 3.0 GPA
 No grades of C or D may be applied to the degree
 Degree must be completed within 7 years
 Three courses required in residency ¹
 Passing score on Comprehensive Exam
 Successful defense of Dissertation
 Submit Graduation Application at the beginning of the final semester

*Applicants who have previously completed an Educational Specialist (Ed.S.) or equivalent degree from an institution accredited by an agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education will be considered for advanced standing (up to 24 hours) in the Ed.D. program. Students who have earned an Ed.S. degree through Liberty are permitted to apply up to 27 hours (as applicable) from that degree toward the Ed.D.

LICENSURE OPTIONS FOR EDD IN EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP

Must complete additional courses below and all coursework for EdD except Dissertation courses²

School administration additional courses required:

EDUC 641¹, 648, 672, 699-A01; equivalent course from master's accepted for EDUC 672

Additional intensive for school administration: EDUC 747¹, must have initial license and 3 years experience

Initial Licensure additional courses required: EDUC 721 and 771 *and courses listed below*

Elementary: EDUC 530, 531, 554, 556, 623¹, 632¹, student teaching, content competencies, VCLA, RVE, Praxis II

Special education: EDUC 524, 525, 530, 554, 622¹, 623¹, student teaching, and VCLA, RVE, Praxis II

Secondary: EDUC 535, 539, 556, 623¹, 673¹ student teaching, content competencies, and VCLA, Praxis II

Add-on Licensure additional courses required and FES (Field Experience Summary - 45 hours):

Early childhood (for 3- and 4-year-olds): EDUC 501, 653, 670, must have elementary license

Gifted: EDUC 526, 620, 621, 627, must have initial license

Advanced Licensure additional courses required: EDUC 721 and 771 *and courses listed below*

School counseling: EDUC 512¹, 611, 622¹, 660, 661¹, 699-A02 and 15 hours of COUN equivalent to M.Ed. courses.

Reading or Math specialist: EDUC 622¹, 641¹, 650, 652, 699-A03, must have initial license and 3 years experience

Also for Math: EDUC 530, Praxis II *or Reading:* EDUC 554, 556, RVE
