A maximum of 33 hours of transfer credit, including credit from a degree on the same academic level previously earned through Liberty, may be applied to the degree<sup>1</sup>

Degree must be completed within 10 years

All Online students admitted on Academic Probation are required to enroll in and pass GRST 500 in their first semester
