GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS for B.S. in Digital Media: Transmedia Writing

120 Total Hours

1. 36 hours of upper level (300/400 courses)
2. 30 semester hours completed at Liberty
3. 50% of the major and the minor must be completed at Liberty

Cumulative GPA must be 2.0 or higher

4. Must have a "C" or above in upper-level courses in the major
5. Must have an overall average of "C" in the major

Christian/Community Service Assignments

6. BWVW 101 & 102 must be completed by all freshmen and transfer students within the first and second semesters of a student's program. This is the Christian/Community Service (CSER) requirement for the first year at Liberty. After completing BWVW 101 & 102, students may choose a CSER from the 200, 300, 400, or 500 series.

Course Option

7. It is strongly recommended that the Digital Media student choose SCOM 110 and SCOM 226 instead of COMS 101 as part of the Communication requirement.

Graduation Application

8. Submission of Graduation Application must be completed within the last semester of a student's anticipated graduation date.
