Overall thoughts on the game...

"I want to give God the glory. We obviously had the weather and all those things that took place. I don't think it really distracted our guys. They were just the better football team. They executed better than we did. We didn't make plays when we had to make them. From an offensive perspective, we just never got anything going. Most of it was us, but some of it was them. But overall, they were the better football. We just have to get better at the things we need to get better at, and that's blocking, tackling, catching the ball, executing and doing all the things we need to do. We've still got a lot of good football left, and I'm excited to see how our team will respond as we move forward here in the next two games on the road."

On not taking advantage of two opportunities to score, one in each half...

"Those two opportunities that we didn't score put a little damper on some things. We still have to respond. Our defense has to respond when they have opportunities to get off the field, but they were on the field a lot. We didn't sustain enough drives."

On the running game...

"Overall, we ran the ball pretty good most of the time. There's a few times where we didn't have success, but I think overall we had some things in the first two or three quarters where we ran the ball pretty good. Our throwing game was not on par as far as what it should be."

Overall thoughts on the game and on his team...

"The entire week, there were a lot of reasons they could have been distracted, whether it was weather or all the different media that, to be honest with you, we haven't had. They had to fight through a lot this week. I think we have a very mature football team, and they understood that we were going to have to have a great week of preparation. Liberty is a very good football team. They were well-coached, and we knew it was going to be a great challenge coming on the road and to play extremely well to win."

On running back Loren Easley's career night on the ground...

"He ran the ball hard. He did this past week, too. I thought he played really well against Arkansas. I've said from the beginning, I feel really good about that group (of running backs). Those backs, they ran hard. Up front, you can't stress enough how great those guys did."

Overall feeling about his team through four games...

"I feel as good as I could after four games. I feel like we've faced some adversity. I understand what's coming our way this next week. I'm going to enjoy this one and kind of reset tomorrow. Our conference, it's a tough road and a tough stretch. We've got to bounce back and reset and make sure we have a great week of preparation to open up conference play the right way."
