Currently on a season-long four-game winning streak, the Liberty Flames travel to High Point, N.C., for a Big South Conference match with the High Point Panthers, Wednesday.

Kickoff at Vert Stadium is scheduled for 7 p.m. The contest is Liberty's last road match of the 2017 regular season.

SERIES HISTORY

Liberty and High Point have met 30 times on the soccer pitch with the Flames holding a 14-11-5 edge in the all-time series.

Last year, Liberty and High Point tied 1-1 at Osborne Stadium on Oct. 26.

NOTABLES

- The Flames enter Wednesday's contest off a six-day break. Liberty pushed its winning streak to four games with a 1-0 win over Marshall in its last match on Oct. 17. Pepe Segarra provided the game-winner, scoring his second goal of the year with 42 seconds remaining.

- Liberty has outscored its opponents, 28-10. The Flames enter Wednesday's contest 11th nationally in scoring offense with a 2.15 goals per game average. Liberty ranks 22nd in total goals.

- Liberty leads the Big South with a 0.75 goals-against average. The Flames rank 19th nationally in the category.

- Tresor Mbuyu begins the week 16th nationally with a 1.77 points per game average and 20th in the nation with nine goals.

- Goalkeeper James Knoebel leads the Big South in goals-against average (0.78) and save percentage (.815).

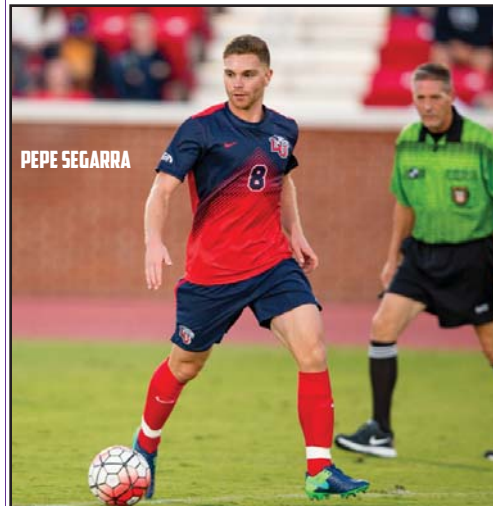
LIBERTY EXTENDS WINNING STREAK

A goal by Pepe Segarra in the final minute of regulation powered the Liberty Flames past the Marshall Thundering Herd, 1-0, Oct. 17 at Osborne Stadium

After being held in check by the Herd, the Flames broke through in the final minute.

Gaining possession in the midfield, the ball was pushed forward to forward Matt Zaczyk at the top right corner of the 18-yard box, who immediately dumped it down to forward Tresor Mbuyu at the near post. Mbuyu then sent a pass in front of the net where Segarra scored with 42 seconds left to give Liberty the 1-0 win and extend its season-long winning streak to four.

The shutout was the Flames' Big South leading sixth of the season.



OFFENSIVE NUMBERS STANDOUT

Entering the week, Liberty has outscored its opponents, 28-10.

The Flames will enter Wednesday's contest 11th nationally in scoring offense with a 2.15 goals per game average. Liberty ranks 22nd in total goals.

CLEAN SHEET LEADERS

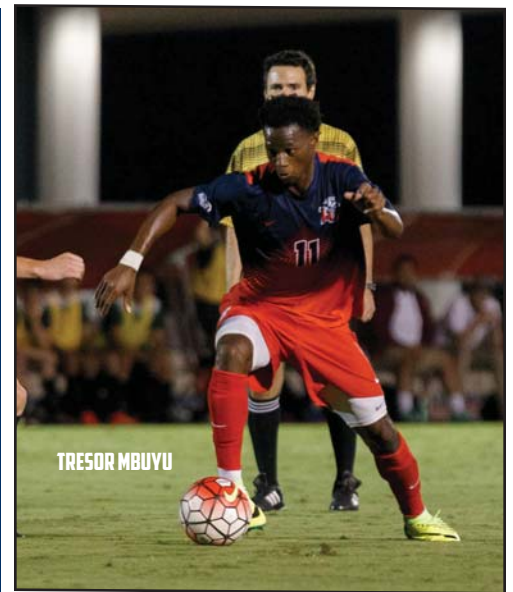
Liberty leads the Big South Conference with six shutouts.

Goalkeeper James Knoebel has recorded five of the shutouts and shared in the sixth.

Liberty's goals-against average of 0.75 ranks 19th nationally.

MBUYU AMONG NATIONAL LEADERS

Tresor Mbuyu begins the week 17th in the nation with a 1.77 points per game average and ranks 18th in the country with 23 total points.



Mbuyu is also 20th in the nation with nine goals.

He is tied for third in the Big South Conference with five assists.

The 2017 Big South Preseason Attacking Player of the Year has accumulated a point in nine of Liberty's 13 games this season.

KNOBEL LEADING BIG SOUTH

Liberty goalkeeper James Knoebel leads the Big South Conference leads the Big South in goals-against average (0.78) and save percentage (.815).

The redshirt sophomore also leads the conference with a 0.39 shutouts per games played mark.

In addition, Knoebel continues to move higher among the nation's save percentage leaders. He begins the week 19th.

ON THE MARK

Liberty enters the week 21st in the nation in shots on goal. The Flames have averaged 6.62 shots on net per game during their first 13 games of 2017.

DEFENDING HOME FIELD

The Flames have posted a 6-1 record at Osborne Stadium, so far this season. Liberty has outscored its opponents, 17-3, at home.

SCORING FIRST

The Flames have scored first in 10 of their 13 contests this season. Liberty holds a 8-1-1 record in those games.

In addition, the Flames are 6-0 when leading at half-time and 3-1-1 when they are tied.

DOMINGUEZ ASSISTS

Liberty senior Alex Dominguez enters Tuesday's contest among the Big South leaders in assists. The senior is tied for eighth with four helpers.

On Oct. 13, Dominguez scored the first goal of his career in Liberty's 2-1 win at Presbyterian.

The senior entered the year with only one assist during his first three seasons at Liberty.

LIBERTY'S JEFF ALDER

The Flames are in their 17th year under the guidance of Liberty alumnus head coach Jeff Alder. Alder has led the Flames to a 160-122-27 record during his tenure. He has led Liberty to its only Big South men's soccer titles in 2007 and 2011.

MENDOZA MVP

Midfielder Kevin Mendoza was named the MVP of the Dayton Tournament on Sept. 10. The junior scored his second goal of the season in a 1-1 tie with Fort Wayne on Sept. 8 and assisted on the Flames' goal in a 1-0 win over host Dayton, two days later.

Mendoza was joined on the all-tournament team by fellow midfielders Pepe Segarra and Shaun Stocker, as well as forward Tresor Mbuyu.

AN INTERNATIONAL FLAIR

This season, the Flames have members from seven different countries on their roster. Liberty players hail from Brazil, Canada, Costa Rica, England, Mexico, Spain and the United States. In addition, several Liberty players lived in Africa, before calling the U.S. home.

The Liberty men's soccer program has firmly entrenched itself among the elite of the Big South Conference and achieved new heights during Jeff Alder's tenure at his alma mater. In 2001, Alder took over a program which had been a consistent winner and built it into a perennial contender for the Big South Conference title. During his tenure, the Flames have won the program's only two Big South championships, earning Liberty's inclusion in the NCAA Tournament field.

Alder's Flames have posted 10 or more wins in seven of their last 10 seasons, including five consecutive 10-plus win seasons (2007-2011) for the first time in program history. The run of double-digit wins began with a 13-5-2 record, the most victories in a season during his tenure, as the Flames captured their first ever Big South title in 2007.

The Liberty alum captured his 100th coaching win in 2011 with a 2-0 victory over No. 10 Virginia in Charlottesville, Va., on Sept. 13.

Alder has seen 23 of his players move on to the professional ranks, with Sachim Wilson becoming the first Liberty player to ever play in the Europa League. Wilson made his debut in the June 2016 as a member of ND Gorcia. In addition, Alder has seen midfielder Joshua Boateng taken in the 2009 Major League Soccer (MLS) Super Draft and seven others picked in the MLS Supplemental Draft.

Alder has seen several of his players earn prestigious honors during his tenure. In 2008, Boateng was listed on the Hermann Trophy watch list throughout the season and became the program's first Division I All-American. In 2002, Darryl Roberts, the program's all-time point leader, became Liberty's first Freshman All-American.

Roberts and defender Osei Telesford went on to play for their country's national team, Trinidad and Tobago in 2006.

In addition, junior forward Tresor Mbuyu became the first Liberty player to be named the Big South Attacking Player of the Year in 2016 and the second Flame in program history to be selected as a Big South Player of the Year. Mbuyu led the Big South with 29 points and tied for the conference lead with 10 goals. He finished the year second in the conference with nine assists.

Off the field, Alder's program continues to make its mark in the classroom as well. The men's soccer team was recognized by the NCAA with a Public Recognition Award in 2012 and 2013. The award honors teams for their most recent multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) scores, and are given each year to teams with APRs in the top 10

percent of their sport. Also, Alder has had two of his players named CoSIDA Academic All-Americans in midfielder Phillip Aseweh in 2011 and defender Michael Gelatt in 2007 and 2008. The Flames also were honored with a NSCAA Team Academic Award for the 2013-14 academic year.

Alder spent nine years as an assistant and four seasons as a player for 21-year head coach Bill Bell, before taking over as the program's third head coach. Alder also spent six years as the Director of Academics for Athletics, giving him more than 25 years on Liberty Mountain.

During Alder's previous 16 years at the helm of the men's soccer program, the Flames have not only captured their first two Big South Conference titles in school history (2007 & 2011), but have recorded a top-three finish in the conference's regular-season standings nine times. Liberty has finished first (2001) in the Big South regular-season standings once, placed second (2003, 2004, 2007) three times and completed conference play third (2002, 2005, 2009, 2010, 2012) five times during his tenure. The Flames have also played in the Big South Championship title game five times under Alder, reaching the title contest in 2001, 2007, 2009, 2011 and 2013.

Student-athletes under Alder have combined to earn one All-American honor, two Freshman All-American awards, three Capital One Academic All-America accolades, 18 all-region recognitions, on Big South Player of the Year honor, three Big South Freshman of the Year awards and 57 all-conference selections, including 30 first-team members.
