### NOTABLES

- Liberty's 5-0 victory at VMI on Tuesday began a three-game road swing, the longest of 2018 for the Flames. The swing also includes matches at UCF and ETSU.
- Liberty and VMI have met each of the last 16 seasons. The Flames have won the last four meetings between the two teams and hold a 22-2-2 mark all-time vs. the Keydets.
- Liberty recorded its first shutout of 2018, Tuesday. Last season, the Flames posted seven shutouts.
- Liberty will be playing in the state of Florida for the first time since 1999 on Friday and has never played in the state during head coach Jeff Alder's 18-year tenure. This season, the Flames will visit the Sunshine State for three matches.
- With three goals and an assist on Tuesday at VMI, Tresor Mbuyu currently leads the ASUN Conference in goals (3), points (8) and shots taken (10).
- Liberty is in its first season as a member of the ASUN Conference. The Flames will play their first ASUN match at Stetson on Sept. 13
- Liberty was picked to finish in sixth place in the 2018 ASUN Preseason Men's Soccer Poll. Kevin Mendoza and Mbuyu were named to the ASUN Preseason All-Conference team.

### LAST TIME OUT

- Forward Tresor Mbuyu scored the first three goals of the contest, as the Flames overwhelmed the VMI Keydets 5-0 Tuesday afternoon at Patchin Field. All three goals came in the first half, as the senior posted his first career hat trick.
- The Flames recorded their first shutout and road win of 2018 with the victory.

## LIBERTY NOTES

### NEW ERA OF LIBERTY SOCCER

On July 1, 2018, 17 of Liberty's 20 athletics program joined the ASUN Conference and will start competition in the conference starting with the 2018-19 athletics season. The ASUN Conference, headquartered in Macon, Ga., includes Florida Gulf Coast, Jacksonville, Kennesaw State, Lipscomb, NJIT, North Alabama, North Florida, and Stetson.

The Flames will play their first ASUN contest on Sept. 13 at Stetson. ASUN men's soccer has seven programs competing, with the Flames joining Florida Gulf Coast, Jacksonville, Lipscomb, NJIT, North Florida and Stetson.

### THE LONGEST ROAD SWING OF 2018

Tuesday afternoon, the Flames began a three-game road swing, their longest of 2018, with a 5-0 win at VMI. Liberty will travel to UCF in Orlando, Fla. for a match on Friday and one at ETSU on Tuesday. The Flames will play eight of their regular season contests on the road this season.

### IT'S BEEN AWHILE

Liberty will play a match in the state of Florida for the first time since 1999 and for the first time during head coach Jeff Alder's 18-year tenure on Friday, when it takes the field at the UCF Soccer Complex. The last time the Flames visited the Sunshine State for a contest, they defeated Jacksonville 2-0 and host FIU 1-0 in overtime during the FIU Golden Panther Classic in Miami, Fla., Oct. 22-23, 1999.

After not playing a match in Florida over the past 18 years, the Flames will venture to the Sunshine State for three matches in 2018. Not only will the Flames visit UCF for a non-conference contest, but they will also play at Florida Gulf Coast and Stetson during ASUN Conference play. The Flames will face Stetson in DeLand, Fla. in their first ASUN match on Sept. 13.

### MBUYU NOTCHES FIRST

Senior forward Tresor Mbuyu netted his first career hat trick and also added an assist for seven points in Liberty's 5-0 win over VMI on Tuesday. Both were career highs for the senior. Previously, the forward's career game highs were two goals twice (at USC Upstate, 9/2/17 & UNC Asheville 10/7/17) and five points (UNC Asheville 10/7/17).

Mbuyu netted all of his three goals during the first half on six shots, becoming the first Liberty player to score three goals and have seven points in a game since Aug. 30, 2016. Jovanni Chavez accomplished the feat at Patchin Field in a 5-2 victory over VMI.

With the three-goal game, Mbuyu enters the weekend as the ASUN leader in goals (3), points (8) and shots taken (10).

### RECORDING THE SHUTOUT

On Tuesday, the Flames posted their first shutout of the 2018 in their victory at VMI. Last season, Liberty recorded seven clean sheets, finishing second in the Big South Conference in the category.

- Brogan Engbers has started both Liberty contests in goal for the Flames. Tuesday, he recorded his first shut-out as a collegian.

- Freshman Shane Geisler netted his first career goal at VMI on Tuesday. Freshman Jack Worth picked up his first collegiate point, assisting on Geisler's goal.

### EXPERIENCE RETURNS

Liberty returns eight of its 11 starters from last season's squad. Of the eight, five have been in the Flames' starting 11 each of the past two seasons. Goalkeeper James Knoebel, defenders Nico Bellarde and Geovanny Murillo, midfielder Kevin Mendoza and forward Tresor Mbuyu have been starters in 2016 and 2017.

The Liberty men's soccer program has achieved new heights during Jeff Alder's tenure at his alma mater. In 2001, Alder took over a program which had been a consistent winner and built it into a perennial contender for the conference title. During his tenure, the Flames have won the program's only two conference championships (2007 & 2011), earning Liberty's inclusion in the NCAA Tournament field. This year, Alder will take his program into new territory as the Flames join the ASUN Conference.

Alder's Flames have posted 10 or more wins in eight of their last 11 seasons, including five consecutive 10-plus win seasons (2007-2011) for the first time in program history. The run of double-digit wins began with a 13-5-2 record, the most victories in a season during his tenure, as the Flames captured their first ever Big South title in 2007.

The Liberty alum captured his 100th coaching win on Sept. 13, 2011, with a 2-0 victory over No. 10 Virginia in Charlottesville, Va.

Alder has seen 23 of his players move on to the professional ranks, with Sachem Wilson becoming the first Liberty player to ever play in the Europa League. Wilson made his debut in the June 2016 as a member of ND Gorcia. In addition, Alder has seen midfielder Joshua Boateng taken in the 2009 Major League Soccer (MLS) Super Draft and seven others picked in the MLS Supplemental Draft.

Alder has seen several of his players earn prestigious honors during his tenure. In 2008, Boateng was listed on the Hermann Trophy watch list throughout the season and became the program's first Division I All-American. In 2002, Darryl Roberts, the program's all-time point leader, became Liberty's first Freshman All-American.

Roberts and defender Osei Telesford went on to play for their country's national team, Trinidad and Tobago in 2006.

In addition, junior forward Tresor Mbuyu became the first Liberty player to be named the Big South Attacking Player of the Year in 2016 and the second Flame in program history to be selected as a Big South Player of the Year. Mbuyu led the Big South with 29 points and tied for the conference lead with 10 goals. He finished the year second in the conference with nine assists.

Off the field, Alder's program continues to make its mark in the classroom as well. The men's soccer team was recognized by the NCAA with a Public Recognition Award in 2012 and 2013. The award honors teams for their most recent multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) scores, and are given each year to teams with

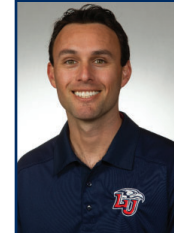
APRs in the top 10 percent of their sport. Also, Alder has had two of his players named CoSIDA Academic All-Americans in midfielder Phillip Aseweh in 2011 and defender Michael Gelatt in 2007 and 2008. The Flames also were honored with a NSCAA Team Academic Award for the 2013-14 academic year.

Alder spent nine years as an assistant and four seasons as a player for 21-year head coach Bill Bell, before taking over as the program's third head coach. Alder also spent six years as the Director of Academics for Athletics, giving him more than 25 years on Liberty Mountain.

During Alder's previous 17 years at the helm of the men's soccer program, the Flames have not only captured their first two Big South Conference titles in school history (2007 & 2011), but have recorded a top-three finish in the conference's regular-season standings nine times. Liberty has finished first (2001) in the Big South regular-season standings once, placed second (2003, 2004, 2007) three times and completed conference play third (2002, 2005, 2009, 2010, 2012) five times during his tenure. The Flames have also played in the Big South Championship title game five times under Alder, reaching the title contest in 2001, 2007, 2009, 2011 and 2013.

Student-athletes under Alder have combined to earn one All-American honor, two Freshman All-American awards, three Capital One Academic All-America accolades, 18 all-region recognitions, one Big South Player of the Year honor, three Big South Freshman of the Year awards and 61 all-conference selections, including 32 first-team
