Quick Hits

- Liberty will look to continued its unbeaten start to Big South Conference play at Winthrop, this weekend. Last week, the Flames opened conference play with a three-game sweep of UNC Asheville at Liberty Baseball Stadium to start Big South play at 3-0.
- Despite having not meet the Flames during the regular season since 2013, Winthrop is the third most-common opponent in Liberty program history. The Flames have only played Coastal Carolina and Radford more. The Eagles and the Flames have not met during the league's regular season since 2013.
- The Flames enter the weekend with a 16-11 overall record. In its last outing, Liberty fell at Duke, 6-1, on Tuesday. With the setback, the Flames finished the month of March with an 11-8 record.
- 16 out Liberty's first 27 games have been decided by two runs or less and 11 by one run. The Flames have posted an 8-8 mark in games decided by two runs or less.
- Beginning with Friday's contest, Liberty will play 17 games during the month of April. 12 of the contests will be Big South Conference games. Last year, the Flames went 12-7 during the month, including a 10-2 record in conference play.

Player Quick Hits

- OF Will Shepherd drove in two runs in each game of Liberty's sweep of UNC Asheville, last weekend.
- Shepherd collected his fourth three-hit game of the year and drove in two runs in 6-5 win over Asheville, this past Friday night.
- Shepherd hit his third home run of the year and scored three times in 11-5 win over Asheville, last Sunday.
- The outfielder leads the Flames and is second in the Big South in runs scored.
- OF D.J. Artis reached base in each of his four plate appearances in an 11-5 win over Asheville, Saturday. He went 3-for-3 with a walk, a RBI and two runs scored. He also stole his team-leading ninth base.
- Artis had two hits and drove in the go-ahead run in the eighth of a 7-6 win over Asheville, March 24.
- Artis leads the Flames and the Big South Conference with a .531 on base percentage. He is among the top three in the conference and leads Liberty in batting average (.398), hits (39) and walks (25).
- RHP Shane Quarterley leads the Flames in appearances with 13. Quarterley picked up his fourth win of the year with 3 2/3 scoreless innings of relief in a 6-5 win over Asheville, March 24.
- The following evening, Quarterley recorded the final out of the contest to earn his fourth save.
- Quarterley also leads the Big South in appearances, is second in saves (4) and third in wins (4).
- RHP Zach Helsel did not allow a run over a four-inning relief stint to record his first collegiate win, this past Saturday. Helsel scattered three hits, striking out a batter and not walking one.
- 1B/OF Andrew Yacyk collected three hits and a RBI in 6-5 win over Asheville, last Friday.
- Yacyk went 5-for-6 in his return to his home state of Maryland, March 22 against the Maryland Terrapins. The Hagerstown, Md., native drove in three runs, setting a new career-high for hits.
- Yacyk leads the Flames with 27 RBI and is among the Big South leaders.
- 3B Eric Grabowski had a RBI triple at Duke, Tuesday.
- Freshman CF Jack Morris and 3B Josh Barrick each hit the first home run of their careers, March 22 at Maryland.
- Morris collected two hits, three RBI and scored twice in the contest. Morris' home run in the fourth plated three runs, his first RBI as a Flame.
- Barrick's first career home run was also a three-run shot. The 3B had two hits, three RBI and scored twice in the game.
- Barrick had two hits and scored the go-ahead run in the eighth in Liberty's 7-6 win over UNC Asheville in the series opener on March 24.
- 2B Andrew Kowalo reached base in all five of his plate appearances at Maryland, March 22. Kowalo had two hits, was hit by a pitch twice and walked in the contest.
- LHP Victor Cole won his second straight start with 5 1/3 innings of work, striking out 10 in a 6-5 win over Asheville, this past Friday.
- Cole was named the Big South Conference Pitcher of the Week for games played March 14-20. The senior went the distance for the first time this season in a 4-2 win over Kent State in game one of a doubleheader, March 19. Cole struck out a career-high 11 batters and retired the last 13 of 14 and the last seven Golden Flashes to face him.
- SS Dalton Britt started his 200th consecutive game in the first game of Liberty's doubleheader against Kent State on March 19. Britt has now started 207 straight games. The senior has started every Liberty contest since joining the Flames in 2012.
- Britt hit his second home run of the season in Liberty's 7-6 victory over Asheville, March 24.
- C Payton Scarbrough had two doubles and two RBI during the Flames' win over Asheville, Saturday.

- The Flames started their 2016 Big South schedule with a three-game sweep of UNC Asheville, last weekend.
- Liberty has posted a 311-227 (.578) in Big South games.
- Last season, Liberty posted a 16-9 mark in Big South Conference play, tying Winthrop for third place in the league's standings.
- The Flames have claimed the conference's regular season title three times in program history (1998, 2000 and 2014).
- Liberty has also captured four Big South tournament baseball titles, including the 2013 crown (1993, 1998, 2000 & 2013).

Liberty Baseball Stadium - Ranked as One of the Best Stadium Experiences

- The Flames have posted a 11-4 record at Liberty Baseball Stadium, this season.
- Liberty went 21-9 at Liberty Baseball Stadium in 2015.
- Last season, Liberty set a new single-game stadium attendance record, drawing 3,983 for its contest with Campbell on April 10, 2015.
- The Liberty Baseball Stadium was ranked as one of the Top 100 stadium experiences of 2015 by Stadium Journey. The home of the Liberty baseball program was listed No. 53. Oriole Park at Camden Yards, home of the Baltimore Orioles, topped the list.
- Stadium Journey also ranked the Liberty Baseball Stadium No. 4 among collegiate baseball stadiums in their 2015 Collegiate Baseball Stadium Experiences.
- Stadium Journey's ratings take into account the food and beverage served in the stadium, the overall atmosphere, the neighborhood where the stadium is located, the fans, access (which includes traffic, parking, ability to move around and rest rooms), the overall return on investment and one final "extras" category.
- After 34 years of playing at Worthington Stadium, the Flames christened the new facility, with a three-game sweep of Penn State, Feb. 23-24, 2013.
- The Flames have averaged 1,281 fans per game during its four seasons at Liberty Baseball Stadium.

Liberty Among Top 50 in Attendance in 2015

- Liberty averaged 1,440 fans per home date at Liberty Baseball Stadium in 2015. The Flames finished the season ranked 46th in the nation in average attendance according to the NCAA .
- Liberty drew 34,569 fans over 24 home dates at Liberty Baseball Stadium in 2015. The Flames ranked 50th in overall attendance according to NCAA.
- Through 14 home dates this season, the Flames have drawn 16,794 fans.

Flames on the Road

- With Tuesday's loss at Duke, Liberty falls to 5-7 overall away from Lynchburg.
- The Flames played eight of their first nine games of 2016 away from Lynchburg - four road games and four neutral site games. March 1st's game at Old Dominion was the final away contest of the span.

- The Eagles began a four-game homestand with a 7-0 win over N.C. A&T, Wednesday.
- Liberty and Winthrop will be meeting for the first time during the Big South Conference regular season for the first time since 2013. The Flames took two of the three games at Liberty Baseball Stadium, April 19-21.

- During Head Coach Jim Toman's previous eight seasons, Liberty has gone 85-60 (.586) during April.

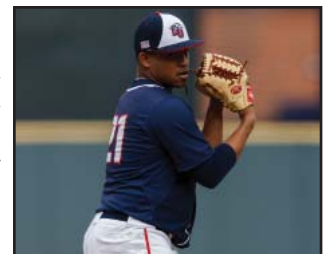
Artis Sets the Table

- Freshman outfielder D.J. Artis has had quite a start to collegiate career. The Greensboro, N.C. has been quite a catalyst for the Flames' lineup, as its leadoff hitter.
- Artis enters the weekend, leading the Big South Conference and 15th in NCAA Division I with a .531 on base percentage. The outfielder leads the Flames, is third in the conference and is 60th nationally with a .398 batting average. He is second in the Big South and ranks seventh nationally in walks with 26.
- The outfielder has scored 25 runs and driven in 15 runs. He leads the Liberty and is tied for fourth in the Big South with nine steals.
- Artis also leads the Flames with 14 multi-hit games, including three with three or more hits. He begins the weekend having reached base in 21 consecutive contests.



Cole Named Big South Pitcher of the Week

- Senior left-hander Victor Cole was named the Big South Pitcher of the Week for games played March 14-20.
- Cole went the distance for the first time this season in a 4-2 win over Kent State in game one of a doubleheader, on March 19. The Memphis, Tenn., native was in control for most of the contest, allowing two runs on four hits, pitching a complete game for the second time in his career.
- Cole, who evened his record at 1-1 at the time, struck out a career-high 11 batters and walked two in the contest.
- He retired the last 13 of 14 and the last seven Golden Flashes to face him to finished the game.
- It is the first time this season and the third time in Cole's Liberty career that he has been named the Big South Pitcher of the Week.



Britt Starts 200 Straight

- Flames shortstop Dalton Britt started his 200th straight contest, this past Saturday.
- The Greenville, N.C., native made the milestone start in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader against Kent State.
- Britt has started every game since joining the Flames in 2013, playing mostly at shortstop. In 2014, he played several games at third base early in the season, before moving back to shortstop.
- He is on pace to break Trey Wimmer's record of 235 games played from 2009-14.
- He enters the weekend with a .253 batting average, seven runs scored and 20 RBI. For his career, Britt has hit .271 with 107 RBI and 90 runs scored.

The 2014 Big South Coach of the Year, Jim Toman has overseen the rise of the Liberty Flames baseball program to national prominence during his tenure.

Toman enters his ninth year at Liberty, having posted the highest NCAA Division I winning percentage (.625) and compiled the best Big South Conference winning percentage (.668) during his first eight years in Lynchburg of any head baseball coach in program history. On Feb. 26 of this year, Toman collected his 300th career victory, a 9-8 win over Marshall, to become the second coach in Liberty history to reach 300 wins.

In 2014, he became the first coach in school history to lead the Flames to back-to-back NCAA berths. After claiming an automatic bid by winning the 2013 Big South Championship, Toman's 2014 team received the program's first at-large selection to an NCAA Regional.

During his tenure, Liberty has posted the school's three top single-season win totals in program history. The 2010 Flames set the school record with 43 wins, while Liberty posted 41-win seasons in 2012 and 2014. In addition, three of the four teams with 40-plus victory seasons all-time have been under Toman's leadership.

The Flames have won 35 or more games in six of his eight seasons at Liberty and have averaged 37 wins per season, the most of any head coach in program history. The Flames have notched a 297-178-1 overall record during his eight seasons at Liberty and have posted a 135-67 Big South mark over the span.

During his coaching career, Toman has been a part of 16 NCAA Regional teams, seven NCAA Super Regional teams and three College World Series teams.

This past season, Toman's squad posted a 33-23 overall mark and ranked as high as 24th nationally by Baseball America (Feb. 24).

For the second consecutive year, a Liberty pitcher was named the Big South Pitcher of the Year as Jared Lyons was selected the conference's top pitcher. Meanwhile, Alex Close became the first Liberty player to be named twice to the Capital One CoSIDA Academic All-America first team.

Toman's 2014 Liberty squad garnered the program's first ever at-large selection to a NCAA Regional. In addition, the Flames, who finished the year at 41-18, were ranked among one of the four major baseball polls during the regular season for the first time in program history, reaching as high as No. 21 in the Baseball America weekly poll on March 21.

Liberty captured the Big South regular season title with 23 Big South victories, also the most in school history and at year's end, became the first team in league history to sweep the major conference awards. Toman was an unanimous selection as the conference's Coach of the Year, while Ryan Seiz was named the Player of the Year. Trey Lambert was selected the Pitcher of the Year and also the Scholar-Athlete of the Year, while Parker Bean was voted Freshman of the Year.

Nationally, Seiz became the first player in Liberty history to be named to three postseason All-American teams. Meanwhile, Bean was named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American. In addition, Close and Lambert became the first two players to be named to the CoSIDA Academic All-America team.

Liberty led the Big South with a 2.62 ERA, the lowest in program history, and finished 2014 ranked 14th nationally in the category. The Flames also topped the

conference with nine shutouts. The relief corps recorded 16 saves, tying for the second most in program history with Toman's 2010 team.

Toman led his team to the first NCAA Regional final appearance in program history in 2013. The Flames captured the Big South Championship and then defeated Clemson twice to make their first appearance in a regional final in the program history.

In 2012, the Flames posted their second 40-plus win season in a three-year span under Toman and set school records for team ERA, shutouts and fielding percentage. Liberty pitchers recorded a 3.04 ERA, ranking 15th nationally, and set a Big South and school record with 11 shutouts. In addition, Toman saw first baseman Alex Close named to two Freshman All-America teams.

The year before, Toman saw seven players from his Flames squad selected during the 2011 Major League Baseball Draft, the most players chosen in a single draft in the history of the program.

Liberty posted a school record for wins in a single season with a 43-18 record in 2010 and in 2009, the Liberty pitching staff set a new season strikeout record, fanning 508 opposing batters. The Flames' strikeout total led the Big South Conference. Their 8.2 strikeouts per nine innings ranked 22nd nationally at season's end.

In addition, third baseman Tyler Bream was named a 2009 Freshman All-American by the Collegiate Baseball News.

After 11 seasons as the senior member of Ray Tanner's coaching staff at South Carolina, Toman was named the sixth head coach in the history of the Liberty Baseball program in June 2007. Toman worked a total of 18 years alongside Tanner, dating back to the 1990 season at N.C. State.

During his time at South Carolina, Toman served as recruiting coordinator and coached the team's catchers. Known as one of the top recruiters in college baseball, the 27-year college coaching veteran was named the 2002 Baseball America/American Baseball Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year.

Toman and the Gamecocks made nine NCAA Regional trips, including eight straight appearances between 2000 and 2007, and three consecutive visits to the College World Series (2002-04). N.C. State made seven NCAA appearances during his time there. During his 11 seasons at South Carolina, he helped the Gamecocks to a combined 500-220 record (.694).

A catcher, Toman was a four-year letterwinner at N.C. State from 1981-84, and served as team captain of the Wolfpack his junior and senior seasons.

Toman earned a Bachelor of Science degree in vocational industrial education from N.C. State in 1985 and graduated as the top student in the vocational industrial education curriculum. He received a Master of Science degree in sport management from N.C. State in 1995.

Toman began his collegiate coaching career in 1989 as an assistant at Florida International for one year.

A native of Monroeville, Pa., Toman lives in Forest, Va. He has three children - Caroline (18), Charlie Mac (15), and Tucker (12). He is a member of the Thomas Road Baptist Church.
