Dear Prospective Student-Athlete,

On behalf of the Athletics Department at Liberty University, we appreciate so much your interest in our great university. We are committed to providing our student-athletes the opportunity to compete in a competitive Division I Conference with all the tools necessary to win championships.

A host student-athlete will accompany you on your visit. He or she will be held responsible for full compliance with the policies, for representing the institution in accordance with the Liberty Way, upholding the Department of Athletics' stated philosophy for recruiting visits, and for avoiding even the perception of impropriety during all recruiting visit activities. You, the prospect, are also responsible to comply with these regulations.

All recruiting visit activities will be in full compliance with NCAA, Big South Conference and Liberty University regulations. Prohibited activities during a visit include but are not limited to the use of tobacco, alcohol, illegal drugs and/or gambling. In addition, immorality of any persuasion will not be used as a recruiting device and sexual harassment will not be tolerated.

Curfew during a recruiting visit will be based on whether the prospective student-athlete is housed on or off the institution's campus. If a prospective student-athlete is housed on-campus during a recruiting visit, the hosting student-athlete is responsible for adhering to the curfew regulations found in the Liberty Way (e.g., Sunday, Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday – 12:00 am (midnight); Tuesday – 10:00 pm; and Friday and Saturday – 12:30 am). If the prospective student-athlete is housed off-campus during a recruiting visit, curfew regulations are to be established by the head coach of the participating athletic program.

The goal of Liberty University is to make every prospective student-athlete's visit a reflection of our institution. Additionally, the mission of the Liberty University Athletics Compliance Office is to uphold the rules and regulations set forth by the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA), the Big South Conference, and Liberty University. As a vital component to the success of LU Athletics, the compliance office is committed to the education of the athletics family on the complexities of NCAA rules in order to ensure a continued tradition of athletic excellence at Liberty University.
