Today's Game

Liberty will put its seven-game winning streak on the line this weekend when it takes to the road for the first time in 2008 in Cullowhee, N.C.

The Flames are coming off a 44-27 home victory over Glensville State, while Western Carolina suffered a 69-0 setback at the hands of Florida State last weekend in Tallahassee, Fla., to fall to 1-1 on the year.

Coach's Corner

In just two seasons at Liberty, head coach Danny Rocco has taken the Flames from 1-10 (in 2005) to Big South champions. The third-year skipper has posted a 16-8 record since taking over the program, helping him garner Big South Coach of the Year honors in back-to-back seasons. Last year, the Flames were 8-3 and a perfect 4-0 against Big South foes.

The Catamounts are under the direction of first-year head coach Dennis Wagner. The Utah graduate brought over 20 years of football coaching experience to Western Carolina, when he was named the 12th head coach in program history on Jan. 4, 2008. Prior to taking over the Catamounts reigns, Wagner served as an offensive line coach for four years at Nebraska.

What's Happened against WCU in the Past

Today's match-up with Western Carolina will mark the sixth meeting in the series between the two programs. Western Carolina leads the overall series, 3-2, despite a 21-0 blanking in Lynchburg on Nov. 4, 2006. The Flames are 1-1 when facing the Catamounts

in Cullowhee, N.C., picking up a 17-10 victory on Sept. 12, 1997, before falling 63-0 at E.J. Whitmire Stadium on Nov. 3, 2001.

Race to the Scoreboard

The past two meetings between Western Carolina and Liberty have proved to be shutouts for the victors. The Catamounts blanked Liberty, 63-0, in the Flames last trip to Cullowhee, N.C., accounting for one of 17 times in program history Liberty has failed to dent the scoreboard. The Flames returned the favor in 2006 with a 21-0 whitewash of Western Carolina, marking one of four shutouts under Rocco's tutelage.

Home Sweet Home

Last weekend, the Flames welcomed visitors Glensville State to Williams Stadium, a facility Liberty has called home for the past 20 seasons. Liberty rallied for a 37-19 victory over Towson State on Oct. 21, 1989, and has won 65 percent of its contests since, having posted a 68-37 record at the on-campus facility. Last year, the Flames went undefeated at home for the second time in program history, posting a school-record 6-0 record en route to their Big South title run.

Streaking Toward a Record

Liberty's current seven-game winning streak ranks as the third longest in program history. The only two runs ahead of the Flames' current winning ways was an eight-game streak that spanned the 1992-93 seasons and a program-best 10-game winning streak that ran over the 1988-89 seasons.

Wonderful Crowds

Despite remnants of Hurricane Hanna lingering in the area, Liberty played its Glenville State game on Sept. 6 in front of 13,917 fans, the seventh largest crowd in stadium history. Since Danny Rocco has arrived at Liberty, the Flames have filled Williams Stadium beyond capacity 10 out of 14 games. Liberty has posted a 12-2 during those contests, averaging 12,938 fans per home game.

Attending to the National Numbers

Following back-to-back sellout crowds at Williams Stadium, Liberty ranks as one of the nation's elite in terms of home attendance figures. The Flames rank third nationally among FCS programs in filling stadium capacity (121.78 percent), fourth in total home attendance (29,228) and No. 14 in average home attendance (14,614).

Magnificent Seven

The Flames 44-27 victory over Glenville State last weekend pushed the Flames winning streak to seven-straight games, dating back to the 2007 season. The run is currently tied for the second longest active winning streaks among FCS programs, ranking only behind Dayton's eight-game winning streak. The Flames are tied with Harvard, who has also won seven games in a row.

Natural Versus Artificial Surfaces

Under head coach Danny Rocco, the Flames are 12-6 on artificial turf and 3-2 on natural grass. Overall, Liberty is 95-107-4 on natural grass and 72-74 on artificial turf. The Flames play their home games at Williams Stadium, which has an artificial surface, as new state-of-the-art FieldTurf was installed prior to the start of the 2006 season. Liberty has posted a 12-2 record at home since the new surface was installed.

Overtime Update

The Flames enter today's game having posted a 3-5 record in overtime games. Liberty's last overtime game came on Sept. 15, 2007, when the Flames dropped a 48-41 decision to William & Mary in double overtime in Williamsburg, Va.

Liberty has only played two of its eight overtime games away from Williams Stadium. Liberty's first extra-period game was a 34-28 road loss to Morgan State on Sept. 21, 1996. Liberty's last victory in an overtime contest came on Nov. 22, 2003, when it closed out the 2003 campaign with a 49-42 win over Hofstra.

Raising Up No. 71

Prior to the start of the Flames' contest against Tusculum on Sept. 1, 2007, Liberty ceremonially honored founder Dr. Jerry Falwell, who passed away the previous May, by starting a new game day tradition. Members of the University Police force raised a No. 71 flag underneath the Liberty Flames flag above the South end zone, just prior to the team taking the field, bringing the 14,925 fans in attendance to their feet.

The new tradition has become a permanent part of the Flames' pregame ceremonies at all home football games. A different person/group will receive the honor of raising the flag at each game. Last week's honoree was Josh McDougal, Liberty's former cross country/track and field standout and the 2007 NCAA Cross Country National champion.

Back in the Big South

Liberty is in the midst of its seventh season of competition in Big South Conference action today. Since beginning league play in 2002, Liberty has posted a 13-10 Big South record, thanks to a perfect 4-0 championship record in 2007 and back-to-back 3-1 records in 2003 and 2004.

From "Good2Great"

Liberty captured its first-ever Big South championship last year, sweeping through the conference with an unblemished 4-0 league record. Liberty was the fifth program in league history to finish a conference campaign undefeated, winning its Big South games by more than 30 points per game (47.8 average points scored to 17.0 average points allowed).

Saturday Night Lights

Under head coach Danny Rocco, the Flames are 7-5 in games played during the day. Since 1976, Liberty is 111-112-1 in day games.

At the Top Again

For the second year in a row, the Flames were named the preseason favorites to hoist the Big South trophy at the end of the season. Liberty garnered 12 out of 13 first-place votes in the annual Big South coaches and media preseason poll and finished 19 points ahead of second-place Coastal Carolina in total votes.

Been There Before

For the third-straight season, the Flames have started a year with a 2-0 record. Under head coach Danny Rocco, the Flames have failed to open a season with three-straight victories. Liberty dropped a defensive struggle, 10-3, at Towson on Sept. 16, 2006, while falling, 48-41, in a heartbreaking double overtime loss to Williams & Mary last year on Sept. 15.

Both third-game losses came on the road, following a pair of home victories. Liberty has started a season 3-0 five times in program history, the last coming in 1997 when the Flames opened the campaign with four-straight victories.

Rocco's Road Record

Head coach Danny Rocco put a strong emphasis during the offseason on road wins. During his first two years at Liberty, the Flames have posted a 4-6 road record, with a trio of those victories coming at the hands of Big South opponents. Liberty's lone non-conference road victory was a 28-0 shutout over Savannah State on Sept. 23, 2006, in Savannah, Ga.

Road-Opening Woes

In the 35 year history of the Flames football program, Liberty has posted a 9-25-1 in its first road game of the season, including a setback in its last 10-straight road-opening contest. Liberty's last road-opening victory was the Flames' lone road win in the series against Western Carolina, as Liberty defeated the Catamounts, 17-10, in its first road game of 1997 (Sept. 12). Since jumping to the Division I level, Liberty is 5-15 in road-opening contests.

The SoCon Series

Liberty has square off on the gridiron with eight of the nine current football-playing Southern Conference opponents. The only current football-playing member of the SoCon Liberty has not previously met is The Citadel. The Flames have posted a combined 13-29 overall record in previous match-ups with SoCon programs, highlighted by a trio of victories over Wofford (3-2) and former Big South foe Elon (3-8).

Joining the Nation's Elite

Last Monday, Liberty's football program received its first national ranking in over 10 years when the Sports Network dubbed the Flames their No. 25-ranked program. Liberty's last national ranking came on Aug. 31, 1998, when the Flames opened the 1998 season tied for No. 24 on the ESPN/USA Today Division I-AA Top 25.

Since making the move to the Division I level in 1988, the Flames have been ranked 25 total weeks (including preseason and postseason rankings) in the respected polls of those eras. Liberty's highest national ranking was No. 8 after the 1990 squad opened the year 4-0. The Flames were also nationally ranked twice at the NAIA level, garnering recognition in 1979 (No. 18) and 1982 (No. 19) in the final NAIA poll.

Big Time Gainers

Five out of Liberty's six touchdowns scored last Saturday against Glennville State game came on plays greater than 20 yards. The only non 20-plus yards scoring play as a one-yard rushing touchdown by Zach Terrell in the first quarter. Liberty currently ranks No. 4 in scoring offense (46.5 points per game), despite ranking No. 85 in average time of possession (26:41). Last year Liberty posted similar numbers, ranking No. 106 in average time of possession (27:59) and No. 3 in scoring offense (42.6 points per game).

Scoring at Will

For the second-straight game, Liberty rolled past the 40-point mark on the scoreboard during its 44-27 victory over Glenville State last weekend. The Flames currently rank No. 4 nationally in scoring offense, averaging 46.5 points scored per game. Dating back to last year, Liberty has scored 40 or more points five times during its seven-game winning streak. Liberty set a program record by scoring 42.6 points per game last year to finish the season ranked No. 3 nationally in scoring average.

Holding Them Back

Despite surrendering 27 points to Glenville State in last Saturday game, the second highest allowed by the Flames defense over the last seven games, Liberty's tacklers held the Pioneers in check during the first 45 minutes. Glenville State did not record its first third-down conversion until the 3:41 mark of the third quarter. In total, the Pioneers finished the game 3-of-13 on third-down tries, leaving Liberty ranked No. 22 nationally in third-down conversion defense (26.7 percent/8-of-30).

Moving Up the Charts

Zach Terrell moved inside the Big South's career Top 5 in two different categories last weekend when the senior rushed for 110 yards and a touchdown against Glenville State. The yardage figure gave Terrell 2,284 career rushing yards, which ranks No. 4 ahead of teammate Rashad Jennings (2,233 yards). Terrell also ranks No. 2 on the league's all-time rushing touchdown list with 28, also ahead of Jennings' 27 career rushing touchdowns.

Hitting the Century Mark

Zach Terrell led the Flames rushing attack, running for 110 yards on 24 carries against Glenville State last weekend. The figure marked the eighth time the senior has surpassed the century mark in a game, which ties him with Eugene Goodman for sixth place on Liberty's 100-yard rushing performance list.

Brown Burst onto the Scene

Redshirt freshman Mike Brown called his own number on his second play under center against Glenville State, rushing 45 yards for a touchdown to account for the rookie's first career score. The 45-yard scoring burst was the fourth longest rushing touchdown by a quarterback in Big South history.

Seeing Double

Dominic Bolden posted a pair of 72-yard plays in Liberty's 17-point victory over Glenville State last Saturday. He opened the scoring barrage for the Flames with a 72-yard touchdown reception from Brock Smith, marking the longest catch of Bolden's career and the second longest touchdown pass of Smith's days in a Liberty uniform.

Bolden also returned a punt 72 yards for a touchdown midway through the second quarter for the second of three total touchdowns on the day. The return marked Bolden's fourth career special teams return for a touchdown, as he came into the game with three kickoff returns for touchdowns to his credit.

Bolden, following the sixth longest punt return for a touchdown in Big South history, is now one of three players in league history to have returned both a kickoff and punt for a touchdown. He joins Wynton Jackson and Jonathan Crawford in the elite group.

On the Verge

Dominic Bolden led the Flames with three kickoff returns for 87 yards against Glenville State last weekend. The 80-yard figure pushed the senior to third place on the Big South's career kickoff return yardage list. Bolden has tallied 1,177 yards on 39 kickoff returns, which leaves him 42 yards shy of former Flames' standout Adrian Hall's Big South record 1,219 career kickoff return yards.

Bad Day for Brock

Brock Smith misfired on two pass attempts against Glenville State, finishing the contest with two interceptions. The pair of picks marked only the fourth time in Smith's 30-game career he has thrown multiple interceptions in a game. The program's record holder with a 145.5 passing efficiency rating, currently ranks No. 13 among active FCS quarterbacks in the nation in terms of fewest interceptions thrown (17 total for his career).

Better Number for Brock

Brock Smith finished the Glenville State game with three touchdown passes, completing 7-of-11 pass attempts for 202 yards. The trio of touchdown passes marked the sixth time in Smith's career the quarterback has passed for three touchdowns in a game and the third time in the last four games. With the three scores, Smith moved into No. 4 on Liberty's career touchdown pass list (36), moving past Ben Anderson's 35 career touchdown passes.

Leader of the Pack

Dominic Bolden's 72-yard punt return is one of four punt returns on the year for the senior. The wide receiver/return specialist currently leads the nation in punt returns, averaging 30.8 yards per return. He is also one of one six FCS players to have returned a punt for a touchdown this season.

Tallying TFLs

The Flames finished the Glenville State game with 11 tackles for a loss of 35 total yards. The figure was the most negative-yardage stops by a Liberty defense since the Flames opened up the 2007 slate with 11 tackles for a loss against Tusculum on Sept. 1. Liberty has recorded 17 tackles for a loss this year, ranking the Flames No. 13 nationally in tackles for a loss per game (8.5).

Sensational Sacks

Of the Flames 11 tackles for a loss last week against Glenville State, four of them were takedowns of Pioneer quarterback James McCants, resulting in a loss of 26 combined yards. The four-sack figure was the second most by the Flames in a game over the last three seasons. The only time Liberty's defense has fared better under Danny Rocco in terms of quarterback sacks was a five-sack game against Coastal Carolina last year. The Flames currently rank No. 23 nationally in sacks, averaging 2.5 per contest.

Too Many Turnovers

One of the things the Flames have done under head coach Danny Rocco is to value possession of the football. Liberty finished the 2006 season ranked No. 20 among FCS programs in terms of turnover margin (+0.55 per game), while bettering the figure to rank No. 7 in the nation last year (+1.27 per game). However, the Flames have struggled to hang onto the football in 2008, committing six turnovers during the first two games (four fumbles and two interceptions). The half-a-dozen miscues have the Flames ranked No. 74 nationally in turnover margin in 2008.

The Big South's Best

Jonathan Crawford was named Big South Special Teams Player of the Week on Sept. 1, after the senior returned a kickoff 76 yards for a touchdown against North Greenville. Crawford helped carry on a recent Liberty tradition, as the Flames won six out of 12 Big South weekly special teams awards in 2007, including the first three weeks of the campaign.

Coaches on the Field

At halftime of the Flames' annual Spring Football Game on April 19, head coach Danny Rocco tabbed six players for leadership roles in 2008, when the skipper named his team captains. Quarterback Brock Smith, running back Rashad Jennings and center Mike Godsil were named offensive team captains. Defensively, nose guard Colin Dugan, linebacker Nick Hursky and defensive back Ryan Greiser were recognized as this year's defensive team captains.

The League's Elite

Rashad Jennings was tabbed the Big South Preseason Offensive Player of the Year at the conference's annual media day on July 25. Jennings, last year's Big South Offensive Player of the Year, set new Big South records in rushing touchdowns (15), all-purpose yards (154.3 per game), total touchdowns scored (17) and points scored (104). Jennings, along with seven other Flames, was named to the Big South's preseason all-conference team, giving Liberty more preseason selects than any other program in the conference this year.

Duo Grabs All-America Honors

Rashad Jennings and Dominic Bolden were named to the Sports Network's Preseason All-America teams on Aug. 22. Jennings grabbed first-team honors as the nation's premium FCS running back, while Bolden was recognized for his stellar return abilities as a third-team honoree at kickoff return specialist. Both Jennings and Bolden were named to the Sports Network's honorable-mention All-America squad at their respective positions at the end of the 2007 campaign.

Running With the Flames

Liberty has developed a rushing tradition of late, finishing among the nation's elite rushing programs in the country. Since 2002, Liberty has finished the year ranked among the Top 30 programs in terms of team rushing average five out of six years. Last year, Liberty ranked No. 16 by averaging 215.9 yards per game. Following the two weekends of competition this year, the Flames rank No. 10 in the country, as Liberty has rushed for 240.0 yards per game.

Walter Payton Award Watch

What this year's candidates are doing in 2008

A plethora of preseason distinctions for Liberty's Rashad Jennings culminated with one of the nation's top FCS honors, as the running back was named to the preseason Walter Payton Award watch list on Aug. 29, 2008.

The preseason list of the 16 best FCS offensive players in the nation was announced by the Sports Network, the organization which will conduct the voting for the prestigious honor. The selections included seven running backs, six quarterbacks and three wide receivers.

The Walter Payton Award watch list will be updated three times throughout the season, before voting takes place after the conclusion of the regular season. The list will be updated early in October and November before being finalized on Nov. 24.

The top three finalists will be announced by the Sports Network on Dec. 1, while the winner will be announced at the Sports Network FCS Awards Dinner, held on the eve of the NCAA Division I Football Championship game (Dec. 18). Jennings is Liberty's first-ever football player to land a spot on the Walter Payton Award watch list.
