Coastal Carolina Series Notes:

- Liberty leads the overall series, 5-4
- The Flames have won four out of the last five meetings
- Liberty's lone setback during the last five meetings was a 45-31 loss during the team's last visit to Conway, S.C., on Nov. 13, 2010
- The Flames are 1-3 all-time when facing the Chanticleers at Brooks Stadium
- Liberty's only road win in the series came on Oct. 4, 2008 (43-38)
- The shootout saw the team teams combined for 1,065 yards of total offense (Liberty – 531, Coastal Carolina – 534)
- Former Flame standout and current Jacksonville Jaguar Rashad Jennings finished the game with 228 all-purpose yards (195 rush, 33 receiving) and scored three touchdowns
- Rashad Jennings could have scored one more TD in the game, but he elected to stop on a 32-yard run on the one-yard line to allow the Flames to run the clock out and secure the road victory
- Points have never been at a premium in the series with the two teams averaging a combined 64.3 points scored per game (579 points in nine game)
- The Flames have scored an average of 35.9 points per game in the series (323 points scored) with Coastal Carolina averaging 28.4 points per game (256 points scored)
- The last time the two teams met, Liberty jumped out to a 42-0 lead and never looked back, securing a 63-27 win over No. 20 Coastal Carolina on Oct. 15, 2011
- The 63-27 Homecoming victory marked the 11th time the Flames had knocked off a ranked FCS team in program history

Concord Highlights:

- The Flames pushed their win streak to three straight games
- Liberty held Concord to an opponent season low 177 yards of total offense
- During six of Concord's 10 total offensive drives, the Mountain Lions gained less than 10 yards

Attendance Facts and Figures from Concord:

- The game was played in front of 18,643 fans
- The figure marked the fourth largest crowd in Williams Stadium history
- Following the game, Liberty is now averaging 17,462 in home attendance
- Liberty currently ranks No. 11 in the country in average home attendance
- The Flames also rank No. 10 in total home attendance (69,847) and No. 22 in filling stadium capacity (90.95 percent)
- The game had the fourth highest FCS attendance in the country this weekend

Offensive Notes against Concord:

- The Flames surpassed the 400-yard mark in total offense for the fourth straight game
- Following the game, Liberty now ranks No. 15 in the country in total offense (446.71 average yards per game)
- The Flames finished the game with 78 total offensive plays, tying their single-game high for the season (also had 78 plays against Lehigh)
- The Flames finished with nearly twice as many offensive plays as Concord (Liberty: 78, Concord: 42)
- Liberty finished the game with 22 first downs
- The Flames have recorded 20 or more first downs in five straight games
- Following the game, the Flames currently rank No. 30 in the country in first down offense (21.71 average first downs per game)
- Liberty had 12 of its 22 first downs come via rushing plays
- The Flames have finished three out of their last four games with 10 or more rushing first downs
- For just the second time this season, Liberty finished with fewer than 10 passing first downs (9 vs. Concord and 8 vs. Norfolk State)
- Liberty finished the game with 233 rushing yards, the Flames' third 200-yard rushing performance of the season (241 vs. Lehigh, 429 vs. PC, 233 vs. Concord)
- Following the game, Liberty now ranks No. 33 in the country in rushing offense (186.43 average rushing yards per game)
- The Flames finished the game with a season-high 54 rushing attempts (previous high was 50 for 241 yards against Lehigh)
- For just the second time this season, Liberty finished a game with less than 200 passing yards (173 vs. Concord, 158 vs. Norfolk State)
- Following the game, Liberty ranks No. 25 in the country in passing offense (260.29 passing yards per game)
- Liberty ranks No. 1 in the Big South in passing offense ahead of No. 2 Coastal Carolina, who is averaging 249.9 passing yards per game
- Liberty completed 16-of-24 passing attempts, its second fewest completions in a game this season (fewest was 15 vs. Norfolk State)
- Liberty has now finished two games this year with less than 20 completions (15 vs. Norfolk State, 16 vs. Concord)
- The Flames had their sixth pass intercepted on the season against Concord
- Following the game, Liberty ranks No. 14 in the country in passing efficiency (150.11)
- Liberty completed 16-of-24 passing attempts against Concord, marking the first time in five games the Flames' completion percentage was below 70 percent (66.7 percent)
- The Flames allowed Concord to record three sacks
- Liberty has now allowed five out of seven opponents in 2012 to record three or more sacks in a game
- Liberty currently ranks No. 88 in the country in sacks allowed per game (2.71)
- The Flames finished the game with a season-high 10 third-down conversions (10-of-17)
- The last time the Flames recorded 10 or more third-down conversions in a game was a double-overtime game against Presbyterian College in 2011
- On the season, Liberty now ranks No. 17 in the country in third-down conversion efficiency (47.00 percent/47-of-100)
- For the second time this season, Liberty finished a game with 40-plus minutes of time of possession (40:38 to 19:22)
- Liberty also finished with 40-plus minutes of time of possession against Lehigh (42:25 to 17:35)

- Liberty has now won the time of possession battle in five straight games
- Following the game, Liberty ranks No. 2 in the country in average time of possession (34:45)
- The Flames were penalized seven times for 60 total yards against Concord
- The figure marked the fourth time in seven games in 2012 Liberty has finished with seven or more penalties in a game
- For the fifth time this season, Liberty lost the turnover battle, giving the ball away once (on an interception) while not forcing a turnover
- The Flames currently rank No. 100 (out of 121 FCS programs in the country) in turnover margin (-0.86/5 turnovers forced to 11 turnovers allowed)
- The Flames scored on 2-of-3 drives that entered the red zone against Concord
- Both of Liberty's scoring drives that crossed over into the red zone resulted in touchdowns
- On the year, Liberty ranks No. 11 in the country in red zone efficiency (91.0 percent)
- The Flames have entered their opponent's red zone 22 times in 2012, scoring 20 times
- Of the 20 red zone scoring drives, 16 have been touchdowns (10 rushing, 6 passing) and four field goals

Defensive Notes against Concord:

- The Flames had a season-low 15 total players record their 37 tackles
- Coming into the game against Concord, the Flames had been averaging 22.0 players per game registering at least one tackle (WFU – 24, NSU – 24, Montana – 23, Lehigh – 19, GWU – 19, PC – 23)
- The Flames top three defenders in the game were defensive backs (Brent Vinson: 10 tackles, Jacob Hagen: 5 tackles, Walt Aikens: 4 tackles)
- Liberty held Concord to an opponent season-low 177 total offensive yards
- Following the game, Liberty now ranks No. 14 in the country in total defense (305.86 yards allowed per game)
- The Flames now currently lead the Big South in total defense
- The Flames have now held four of seven opponents below 300 total offensive yards in a game in 2012
- The last time the Flames held an opponent below 200 total offensive yards in a game was against Kentucky Wesleyan in 2011 (74 yards)
- Concord finished the game with 42 offensive plays, marking a new opponent season low
- Previous opponent season low was 44 offensive plays for Lehigh
- After giving up an early touchdown to Gardner-Webb in the third quarter on Oct. 6, Liberty has surrender 27 points and 558 total offensive yards in the last 148:53 of play (nearly 10 full quarters of football)
- Concord finished the game with 10 total drives and the Mountain Lions were limited to less than 10 yards on six of their 10 drives
- Concord's longest drive of the day was a five-play, 61-yard drive that resulted in a missed field goal
- The one drive where Liberty gave up an offensive touchdown was a one-play, one-yard drive following a 49-yard INT return
- The Flames held their second straight opponent below 20 points
- Liberty held Concord to 47 rushing yards and an opponent season-low 17 rushing attempts
- Liberty has now held its last three opponents to less than 100 rushing yards in a game (98 vs. Gardner-Webb, 56 vs. Presbyterian College and 47 vs. Concord)
- On the year, Liberty has held four of seven opponents to less than 100 rushing yards (Wake Forest rushed for 98 yards in the season opener)
- Following the game, Liberty now ranks No. 24 in the country in rushing defense (122.43 rushing yards allowed per game)
- Liberty currently leads the Big South in rushing defense by allowing 31 less average rushing yards per game than anyone else in the league (Avg. rushing yards allowed – Liberty: 122.4, Stony Brook: 153.4)
- Liberty limited Concord to 130 passing yards, as the Mountain Lions completed only 10-of-24 passing attempts
- The contest marked the fifth time this year Liberty has held an opponent to less than 200 passing yards in a game (195 vs. Wake Forest, 92 vs. Norfolk State, 95 vs. Montana, 195 vs. Lehigh and 130 vs. Concord)

- Concord finished the game with an opponent season-low 10 completions (previous low was 14 by Lehigh)
- Following the game, Liberty leads the Big South in fewest passing TDs allowed in 2012 (Liberty has allowed 4 passing TDs, No. 2 is Stony Brook who has allowed 6 passing TDs)
- Liberty ranks No. 2 in the country in fewest passing touchdowns allowed in 2012 (Wofford leads all FCS programs with 3)
- Joining the Flames who have only allowed four passing touchdowns in 2012 are: Brown, Georgia Southern, Indiana State and South Dakota State.
- Limited Concord to converting on only 4-of-13 third-down plays (30.8 percent)
- Liberty has now held its last five opponents to four or fewer third-down conversions in a game (4-of-17 vs. Montana, 3-of-9 vs. Lehigh, 2-of-7 vs. Gardner-Webb, 1-of-13 vs. Presbyterian College and 4-of-13 vs. Concord)
- Following the game, Liberty ranks No. 7 in the country in third-down conversion defense (28.57 percent/26-of-91)
- Liberty held Concord to six total first downs in the game
- The Flames have held two opponents in 2012 to less than 10 first downs (9 vs. Lehigh, 6 vs. Concord)
- Following the game, Liberty ranks No. 2 in the country in first downs allowed per game (14.00)
- Concord did manage to score on its lone drive that crossed over into the red zone
- Liberty has now allowed opponents to score on 13-of-15 red zone drives in 2012 (86.7 percent)
- Of the 13 red zone scoring drives, opponents have managed to find the end zone 13 out of 13 times (12 rushing touchdowns and one passing touchdown)
- Liberty currently ranks No. 101 (out of 121 FCS programs) in the country in red zone defense
- For the second time this year, Liberty's opponent did not attempt a four-down conversion (also against Wake Forest)
- On the year, Liberty ranks No. 20 in the country in fourth-down conversion defense (4-of-11/36.36 percent)

Special Teams Notes against Concord:

- The Flames gave up more than half of their points allowed to Concord on special teams
- Aaron Sassaman had his first career field goal attempt blocked (47-yard attempt) and returned 58 yards for a touchdown for the game's first score at 12:57 of the second quarter
- Liberty also finished the game with two blocked kicks
- Demetrius Ward blocked a 47-yard field goal attempt in the second quarter
- Francis Bah blocked an extra point attempt later in the second quarter
- Liberty now has four blocked kicks on the season
- Liberty finished the game with a season-low 35.0 yards per punt average (five punts/175 yards)
- The Flames had their second-longest punt return of the season on a 22-yard return by Walt Aikens
- Liberty is one of three Big South programs who are perfect on point-after attempts in 2012 (Liberty: 24-24, Coastal Carolina: 22-22, Presbyterian College: 16-16)
- Liberty ranks No. 2 in the Big South in average yards per punt at 31.5 (Gardner-Webb leads the league – 36.1)
- Liberty leads the Big South in total punt returns (18) and total punt return yards (151)
- Liberty and Coastal Carolina are the only teams in the Big South to have returned a punt for a touchdown in 2012
- The Flames rank No. 2 in the Big South in average yards per kickoff return – 22.4 (Coastal Carolina: 24.8)

Aldreakis Allen (RB, Jr.)

- Career Stats: 333 rushing attempts, 1,797 yards, 22 TDs, 5.4 avg.
- Finished the game with 17 carries for 94 yards
- Missed posting his fourth 100-yard game in six games played this season by six yards
- Averaged 5.5 yards per rushing attempt

- Previous career high was four receptions for 64 yards and a touchdown against Wake Forest

- Did not have a career reception coming into the year, as he was mostly used as a fullback prior to the season

Ryan Ferguson (WR, Sr.)

- Career Stats: 31 receptions, 482 yards, 3 TD, 15.5 avg.
- Suffered a season-ending knee injury on the opening kickoff of the game against Concord
- Came into the game as Liberty's No. 2 receiver with 22 receptions for 334 yards
- Is one of only three players on the roster with more than one touchdown reception on the year
- Had started the first six games of the year at wide receiver
