Concord Series Notes:

- Liberty leads the series, 4-0
- Concord is one of 35 opponents that Liberty is undefeated against
- Liberty squared off against Concord first in 1992 and faced the Mountain Lions for three straight years (1992, 1993 and 1994)
- The last time the two teams met was in 2005 with Liberty winning on Sept. 3, 17-6
- Liberty has allowed Concord a total of 17 points in four games
- Liberty has outscored Concord 132-17 in its four previous matchups against the Mountain Lion
- This meeting will mark the first time in the series with Concord that the game has not taken place early in September

Attendance Figure Notes:

- The Homecoming game on Oct. 6 was played in front of 18,239 fans
- The attendance figure marked the fifth largest crowd in Williams Stadium history
- Three of Liberty's top five Williams Stadium attendance figures have now come from Homecoming games
- The Homecoming game against Gardner-Webb was the seventh highest attended FCS game in the country that weekend
- Liberty currently ranks No. 11 in the country in total home attendance (51,204), No. 13 in average home attendance (17,068) and No. 23 in filling stadium capacity (88.90 percent)

Significant Notes from Presbyterian College Matchup:

- The Flames move to 2-0 in Big South play
- Liberty has now won its first two Big South games of the year for the sixth year in a row
- Liberty finished the game with a program-record 692 total offensive yards

Offensive Highlights against Presbyterian College:

- The Flames scored a season-high 56 points against Presbyterian
- Following the game against PC, Liberty now ranks No. 37 in the country in scoring average (29.83 points per game)
- Liberty's 49-point victory over PC was tied for the fifth largest margin of victory in program history
- The Flames also defeated Glenville State by 49 points by the same score on Sept. 5, 1997
- Liberty's 56 points scored is the most by the Flames in a road game in program history
- Prior to the game against PC, Liberty's previous high for points scored in a road game was 53 points scored in a victory over Delaware State in 1998 (53-21 on Oct. 17)
- Liberty has now scored 50 or more points 24 times in program history
- Liberty has reached the 50-point mark only five times on the road
- Since giving up an early touchdown in the third quarter against Gardner-Webb on Oct. 6, the Flames have outscored their opponents 88-14 in the last 88:53 of play (nearly six full quarters)
- During the same span of time, Liberty has outgained its opponents in total offensive yards by 659 yards (1,040 to 381)
- Liberty finished the PC game with a program-record 692 total offensive yards
- The previous program record of 654 yards against Charleston Southern in 1996
- Following the PC game, Liberty now ranks No. 12 in the country in total offense (453.50 total offensive yards per game)
- Liberty finished with 428 of its 692 total offensive yards during the first half
- The Flames finished the PC game with a season-high 29 first downs
- Liberty has now recorded 20 or more first downs in its last four games
- Following the PC game, Liberty now ranks No. 29 nationally in first down offense (21.67 first downs per game)
- Liberty finished the PC game with an even 14 rushing first downs and 14 passing first downs (also one first down via penalty)
- Liberty's 14 first downs via rushing plays marked a new season high
- Liberty has now finished five out of six games in 2012 with 10 or more passing first downs
- Liberty rushed for a season-high 429 yards on 47 carries
- Liberty averaged 9.13 yards per rushing attempt against PC
- Liberty's rushing total against PC fell 30 yards short of the school record for rushing yards in a game (459 vs. Norfolk State in 2003)
- Following the PC game, Liberty now ranks No. 36 in the country in rushing offense (178.67 rushing yards per game)
- The Flames entered the game ranked No. 83 in the country in rushing offense (128.60 rushing yards per game)
- Seven of Liberty's eight touchdowns against PC came via its rushing attack
- Liberty's seven rushing touchdowns mark a new season high
- Liberty's seven rushing touchdowns fell one short of the program's team record
- Liberty's team record is eight rushing touchdowns against Norfolk State in 2003
- The Flames nearly tripled their rushing touchdown total against PC, as Liberty came into the game with four rushing touchdowns during its first five games
- Aldreakis Allen (13 carries, 183 yards) and Sirchauncey Holloway (12 carries, 128 yards) both surpassed the 100-yard rushing mark against PC
- The pair also surpassed the 100-yard mark in the same game earlier this year against No. 13 Lehigh
- The last time the Flames had a pair of running backs surpass the 100-yard rushing mark more than once in the same season was in 2004 (three times in 2004)
- The Flames finished the PC game with 263 passing yards
- Liberty has now passed for 200 or more yards in five out of six games this season
- Liberty is averaging 274.83 passing yards per game, which ranks No. 15 in the country in passing offense
- On the season, Liberty's quarterbacks are completing their pass attempts at 69.3 percent (138-of-199)
- Following the PC game, Liberty ranks No. 9 in the country in passing efficiency (152.12)
- Nine different players finished the game with receptions

- On the season, Liberty is averaging 7.5 players finishing a game with at least one reception
- Liberty managed to pick up a first down on 6-of-8 third-down plays (75.0 percent)
- Following the PC game, Liberty now ranks No. 23 in the country in third-down conversion efficiency (44.58 percent/37-of-83)
- For the first time during the 2012 season, Liberty did not attempt to pick up a first down on a fourth down play
- For the fourth game in a row, Liberty won the time of possession battle, winning by a margin of 8:54 (34:27 to 25:33)
- Liberty has finished with an eight-plus minute time of possession advantage in its last four games
- Liberty is averaging 33:47 time of possession in 2012, which has the Flames ranked No. 6 in the country in average time of possession
- For the fourth time in six games, Liberty lost the turnover battle, this time by one to PC
- Liberty currently ranks No. 94 in the country (out of 121 FCS programs) in turnover margin (-0.83/10 turnovers lost to five turnovers gained)
- The Flames were flagged for five penalties for a total of 38 penalty yards
- The five infractions were the second fewest by the Flames this season (fewest was four last week against Gardner-Webb)
- During the last two weeks, Liberty has averaged 4.5 penalties per game
- During the first four games of the season, Liberty averaged 8.25 penalties per game
- The 38 penalty yards were the second fewest by the Flames this season (fewest was 30 yards against Wake Forest)
- The Flames entered the red zone six times against PC and scored a touchdown on each of those drives
- Liberty has now scored 18-out-of-19 times it has found the red zone in 2012 (94.7 percent)
- The Flames have 14 touchdowns on the 19 red zone drives this season (8 rush, 6 pass/73.6 percent)
- For the first time this season, Liberty did not allow a quarterback sack
- Coming into the game, the Flames had allowed 16 sacks in the first five games (3.2 per game)

Defensive Highlights against Presbyterian College:

- The Flames allowed a season-low seven points to PC
- Dating back to its game with Gardner-Webb, the Flames have allowed a total of 14 points and 381 total offensive yards during the last 88:53 of play (nearly six quarters)
- The Flames allowed a season-low 257 total offensive yards to PC
- Liberty has held three of its six opponents this season below 300 total offensive yards in a game
- Following the PC game, Liberty ranks No. 29 in the country in total defense (328.50 yards allowed per game)
- The Flames limited PC to 15 total first downs during the game, the third fewest Liberty has surrendered in a game this season
- Following the PC game, Liberty now ranks No. 5 in the country in first down defense (15.33 allowed per game)
- The Flames allowed PC to pick up 13 of its 15 first downs via passing plays
- The Flames have surrendered a total of 27 first downs via passing plays the last two games
- During the first four games of the year, Liberty allowed a total of 20 first downs by passing plays
- The Flames allowed a season-low two first downs via rushing plays
- The Flames held PC to an opponent season-low 56 rushing yards
- Liberty has now held three of its six opponents in 2012 below 100 yards rushing
- Liberty ranks No. 38 in the country in rushing defense (135.00 yards allowed per game)
- Liberty allowed 201 passing yards to PC, the second most passing yards in a game this season by an opponent
- The one touchdown Liberty did allow against PC was a 32-yard pass play late in the second quarter
- On the season, the Flames have only allowed four total touchdown passes
- Only four FCS teams in the country have allowed fewer passing touchdowns in 2012 (Princeton: 1, South Dakota State: 2, Brown: 3, Wofford: 3)
- Liberty has allowed 584 passing yards in its last two games

- During the first four games of the year, the Flames allowed 577 passing yards total
- Following the PC game, Liberty ranks No. 40 in the country in passing defense (193.50 yards allowed per game)
- Finished the PC game with a season-high 9.0 tackles for a loss (27 yards)
- Came into the PC game averaging 5.8 tackles for a loss per game
- PC finished the game picking up one first down on 13 third down plays (7.69 percent)
- Following the PC game, Liberty ranks No. 10 in the country in third-down defense efficiency (28.21 percent/22-of-78)
- During the last three games, Liberty has allowed a total of six third-down conversions
- During the last three games, Liberty opponents have picked up a first down on 6-of-29 third-down plays (20.69 percent)
- The Flames allowed their fourth fourth-down conversion against PC
- PC finished the game 1-of-4 on fourth-down conversion attempts
- Following the PC game, Liberty now ranks No. 24 in the country in fourth-down conversion defense (36.36 percent/4-of-11)
- Liberty tied a season high with three sacks against PC
- The Flames came into the game with only seven sacks during their first five games
- The Flames finished the PC game with a season-high 49 solo stops
- For the fourth game in a row, Liberty finished a contest with multiple pass breakups
- Liberty had two pass breakups against PC
- The Flames finished the PC game with 65 special teams return yards
- Liberty had more chances to increase its total special teams return yards, as PC was forced to punt eight times during the game
- However, Liberty only returned one of the eight punts for a total of seven yards
- For just the second time this season, Liberty failed to average more than 40 yards per punt against an opponent
- Liberty finished the PC game averaging 39.5 yards per punt (two punts/79 yards)

- Career Stats: 52-of-87, 594 yards, 59.8 percent, 1 INT, 5 TDs, 66.0 yards per game
- Finished the PC game completing 5-of-6 pass attempts for 31 yards

- Finished the game with a career-high four rushing touchdowns
- Previous career high was three rushing touchdowns against Coastal Carolina in 2009
- Sixth time in his career with more than one rushing touchdown in a game
- In three career games against PC, he has rushed 60 times for 406 yards and eight touchdowns
- Has three 100-yard rushing games in 2012

- Had his most productive game as a Flame with 11 carries for 61 yards
- Scored his first collegiate rushing touchdown on a one-yard run in the fourth quarter
- Came into the game with two rushing attempts for 0 net rushing yards on the season

- Also handled both of Liberty's kickoff returns

- Ranks No. 6 in the BSC in all-purpose yards per game (86.2)

Justin Gunn (TE, Sr.)

- Career Stats: 15 receptions, 223 yards, 2 TDs, 14.9 avg.
