Lehigh Recap:

- Liberty dropped its third-straight game to a Top 25 program in their 28-26 loss to No. 16/13 Lehigh on Sept. 22
- The Flames had a chance to tie the game and send the contest into overtime with less than one minute remaining, but Josh Woodrum's two-point conversion pass attempt to Ryan Ferguson was broken up to secure the two-point victory for Lehigh
- For the first time since the 1982 season, Liberty is 0-4 following its first four games of the year
- Liberty has started 0-4 twice previously in program history (1981 and 1982)
- In 1982, Liberty picked up its first victory during the fifth game of the season against Central State (Ohio), which started a seven-game winning streak to cap off a 7-4 year
- In 1981, the Flames lost their first nine games of the season before preventing a winless season with a 42-23 victory over Evangel in the season finale to finish the year 1-9
- The last time that Liberty lost four games in a row in the same season was in 2006 during Danny Rocco's first year as Liberty's head coach

Gardner-Webb Series Notes:

- Liberty leads the all-time series, 9-8-1
- Liberty holds a 6-4 series edge over Gardner-Webb in Big South Conference match-ups
- Liberty has won the last five meetings in the series between the two programs
- During Liberty's current five-game win streak against Gardner-Webb, the Flames have won by an average margin of 26.4 points per game
- The game will mark the 11th season of Big South competition for both programs
- Liberty has faced Gardner-Webb in its Big South opener four times (2002, 2004, 2006 and 2011)
- Liberty's all-time record in Big South opening games is 7-3, winning its last five league openers

Homecoming Notes:

- Liberty's all-time record in Homecoming games is 27-11
- Liberty has won its last five Homecoming games by an average of 36.2 points per game
- In its 27 overall Homecoming victories, Liberty's average margin of victory has been 23.15 points per game

Attendance Facts and Figures:

- The Lehigh game was played in front of 17,139 fans, marking the sixth largest home attendance figure in Williams Stadium history
- Both of Liberty's home attendance figures in 2012 rank in the Top 10 in Williams Stadium history (Norfolk State ranks No. 9 with 15,826)
- The Liberty vs. Lehigh game was the ninth highest attended FCS game in the country on Sept. 22
- Entering this weekend's game against Gardner-Webb, Liberty now ranks No. 17 in the country in total attendance (32,965), No. 15 in average attendance (16,483) and No. 25 in filling stadium capacity (85.85 percent)

Offensive Highlights from the Lehigh Game:

- The Flames scored a season-high 26 points against Lehigh
- The Flames won almost all offensive statistical categories against Lehigh on Sept. 22, including first downs, rushing, passing, total offensive yards, time of possession and third-down conversion
- Liberty finished the game with 23 first downs to Lehigh's nine first downs
- For the first time this season, Liberty finished a game with more rushing first downs (13) than passing first downs (10)
- The Flames rushed for a season-high 241 yards and two touchdowns against Lehigh
- Liberty nearly doubled its team rushing total in one game, as the Flames had rushed for a combined 282 yards and one touchdown during the first three games of the year
- The rushing total marked Liberty's highest in a single game since rushing for 259 yards and six touchdowns against Coastal Carolina on Oct. 15, 2011
- Aldreakis Allen (18 carries, 125 yards) and Sirchauncey Holloway (20 carries, 107 yards) both surpassed the 100-yard rushing marking against Lehigh
- The last time the Flames had a pair of players finish a game with 100 rushing yards each was Sept. 29, 2007, when Rashad Jennings (16 carries, 101 yards) and Zach Terrell (five carries, 115 yards) surpassed the 100-yard threshold against St. Francis (Pa.)

- The Flames outgained Lehigh, 247 to 195, in passing yardage
- The 247 passing yards were the Flames' third highest of the season
- Entering the Gardner-Webb game, Liberty currently ranks No. 26 in the country in passing offense (249.5 yards per game)
- Liberty tied its second-highest completion total of the year with 21 completions
- Six different players caught passes against Lehigh, tying a season low for wide receivers used during a game (Wake Forest: 7; Norfolk State: 6; Montana: 9; Lehigh: 6)
- For the second-straight game, Liberty's quarterbacks completed passes at a 75 percent or higher mark (Montana (35-of-45/77.7 percent; Lehigh 21-of-28/75.0 percent)
- The Flames finished the game with two interceptions, its first multiple-interception game of the year
- Liberty outgained Lehigh in the game 488 total offensive yards to 301 total offensive yards
- The 488 total offensive yards marks the first time the Flames have surpassed the 400-yard mark under head coach Turner Gill
- The Flames finished the game with a season-high 78 offensive plays
- Liberty finished the game with a 24:50 time of possession advantage (42:25 to 17:35)
- Liberty finished the first (11:31), third (10:16) and fourth quarters (12:36) with at least 10 minutes of possession during each 15-minute period
- Entering the Gardner-Webb game, Liberty currently ranks No. 10 in the country in average time of possession (33:29)
- The last time the Flames had a double-digit time of possession advantage was against Stony Brook to close out the 2010 season with a victory at home and a 13:34 TOP edge (36:47 to 23:13)
- The last time the Flames had a 20-plus minute time of possession advantage was against South Florida in 2001 when Liberty held on to the ball for 42:17 minutes to USF's 17:43 (24:34 TOP edge)
- For the third time this season, Liberty finished a game with at least six third-down conversions, as Liberty picked up a new set of downs on 7-of-15 third-down plays

- Liberty has had seven third-down conversions in three of its four games
- The Flames currently rank No. 30 in the country in third-down conversion percentage (42.19)
- Liberty's offensive line allowed Lehigh to record three sacks, giving opponents 13 sacks during the first four games of the year
- Liberty currently ranks No. 112 out of 121 FCS programs in the country in sacks allowed per game (3.25)
- The Flames scored each time they crossed over into the red zone against Lehigh, recording a touchdown and a field goal
- Liberty has scored on seven of eight drives that have penetrated the opponent's 20-yard line in 2012, including five touchdowns and two field goals
- The Flames committed two turnovers that directly resulted in 14 points for Lehigh
- On the year, Liberty has committed eight turnovers, which opponents have used to score six touchdowns
- Entering the Gardner-Webb game, Liberty currently ranks No. 108 out of 121 FCS programs in the country in turnover margin (-1.25, 8 lost, 3 gained)

Defensive Highlights from the Lehigh Game:

- Liberty finished the game with a total of 40 tackles, as compared to 102 tackles by Lehigh
- The 40-tackle effort was Liberty's lowest team tackle total since 2009 when Liberty record 37 stops in a road victory at Lafayette (Sept. 19/ Liberty won 19-13)
- Liberty's leading tackler in the game was linebacker Scott Hyland, who finished the game with six stops
- In comparison, Lehigh had seven players with six or more stops, including three in double figures (Billy Boyko: 14; Billy O'Brien: 13; Sam Loughery: 11)
- Liberty limited Lehigh to nine first downs during the game (three rush, five pass, one penalty)
- The last time the Flames held an opponent to less than 10 first downs in a game was against Kentucky Wesleyan in 2011
- The last time the Flames held a Division I opponent to less than 10 first downs in a game was during a 58-13 victory over Coastal Carolina in 2009
- Entering the Gardner-Webb game, Liberty currently ranks No. 4 nationally in first down defense (14.00 allowed per game)
- The Flames nearly held their second opponent of the season below the 100-yard rushing threshold, as Lehigh rushed for 106 yards during the game
- More than 64 percent of Lehigh's rushing yards came on one play, when quarterback Michael Colvin called a quarterback draw and rushed 68 yards downfield for a touchdown
- The Flames did surrender a season-high three rushing touchdowns to Lehigh, as the Mountain Hawks matched Norfolk State's three-rushing touchdown performance
- Liberty limited Lehigh to an opponent season-low 44 total offensive plays
- Prior to the Lehigh game, Liberty's next lowest opponent total was 64 plays (for 343 yards) by Norfolk State
- The Flames nearly kept their third opponent out of four in 2012 below the 300-yard mark, as Lehigh finished the game with 301 total offensive yards
- Entering the Gardner-Webb game, Liberty currently ranks No. 17 in the country in total defense (308.5 yards allowed per game)
- Lehigh finished the game with an opponent season-low three third down conversions on nine plays where the Mountain Hawks faced a third-down play
- Entering the Gardner-Webb game, Liberty ranks No. 31 in the country in third down conversion defense (32.76/19-of-58)
- For the first time this year, Liberty's defense failed to create at least one turnover, keeping the Flames at just three turnovers caused in 2012
- Lehigh crossed over Liberty's 20-yard line twice during the game, scoring a touchdown on both drives
- On the year, Liberty's opponents have penetrated the 20-yard line nine times and scored on eight of those drives
- Each of the scoring drives that crossed over the 20-yard line have resulted in touchdowns this year for Liberty's opponents

Special Teams Highlights from the Lehigh Game:

- Grant Bowden finished the game with a season-best 40.8 yards per punt average (four punts for 163 yards)
- Two of Grant Bowden's four punts pinned Lehigh inside its own 20-yard line
- Liberty has now averaged 40 or more yards per punt in three out of four games this year
- Lehigh only had one punt return for a total of nine yards, the fewest total punt returns yards and total punt returns for an opponent this season
- John Lunsford finished the game with five kickoffs, with all five sailing into the end zone and resulting in a touchback
- Entering the Gardner-Webb game, Liberty ranks No. 22 in the country in kickoff return yardage defense with opponents averaging 17.20 yards per kickoff return
- John Lunsford had his first career game with multiple field goals, as the rookie knocked down both of his attempts (32 and 40 yards)
- John Lunsford gave Liberty its first lead of the night with a 32-yard field goal with 1:36 left to play in the third quarter, marking his shortest field goal try of the year
- With his two field goals and three extra points, John Lunsford finished the game with a career-high eight points
- Ryan Ayers tried to return three of Lehigh's punts, resulting in a total of eight total yards

Individual Player Points from Lehigh game:

Josh Woodrum (R-Fr./QB)

- Career Stats: 58-of-79, 3 INTs, 581 yards, 3 TDs
- Second career start
- Had his second-straight 200-yard passing game, completing 20-of-27 pass attempts for 236 yards
- Became the 11th quarterback in program history to have consecutive 200-yard passing games, finishing the game with 236 passing yards
- Completed over 70 percent of his pass attempts (20-of-27 for 74.1 percent)
- Ranks No. 26 in the country in passing efficiency (140.13)
- Second game in a row where he completed 70 percent or more of his pass attempts

- Had his first career rushing touchdown, scoring from three yards out to pull the Flames within two points with 59 seconds left
- Had his first career two-point pass conversion attempt fail when his pass attempt to Ryan Ferguson was broke up to allow Lehigh to secure the victory and avoid overtime
- Carried the ball 11 times for 20 yards, marking new career single-game highs in both categories
- Was named Big South Freshman of the Week following the Montana game where he threw for 322 yards and completed 34-of-44 pass attempts
- Ranks No. 6 in the Big South in total offense (145.2 yards per game)

Brian Hudson (R-Fr./QB)

- Career Stats: 47-of-81, 1 INT, 563 yards, 5 TDs
- Came into the game for one play at quarterback, completing an 11-yard pass
- Replaced Josh Woodrum after a play where the redshirt freshman's helmet was knocked off (NCAA requirement to sit out the next play)
- Continued to serve as Liberty's starting holder on field goals and extra points

Aldreakis Allen (Jr./RB)

- Career Stats: 1,423 rushing yards, 286 carries, 5.0 avg., 17 TDs
- Finished the game with 18 rushing attempts for 125 yards
- Recorded his fifth career 100-yard game, rushing for a team-high 125 yards
- Marked his second 100-yard rushing game of the year (rushed for 127 yards against Norfolk State)
- Carried the ball 18 times, his second-highest single-game total of the season
- Averaged 6.9 yards per carry, his second-highest single-game average of his career
- Had a 36-yard carry, the second-longest rush of his career
- Also added five receptions for 45 yards
- Five receptions was the second-highest single-game total of his career
- 45 yards was the third-highest single-game total of his career
- Was Liberty's second leading receiver against Lehigh

- Had recorded six or more tackles in the last three games
- Needs 12 tackles on the season to become the fourth active player on Liberty's roster with 100 career tackles

Nick Sigmon (So./LB)
