Presbyterian Series Notes:

- Liberty leads the overall series, 5-4
- Liberty is a perfect 3-0 against PC in Big South games (since 2009)
- The Flames have won the last three meetings between the two teams
- Liberty is 2-2 overall when facing PC in Clinton, S.C.
- The first two meetings in Clinton took place in the early 1980s with the two teams splitting the contests
- Liberty and PC played each other for four straight years in the 1980s (1982-85), with PC winning three out of the four matchups
- The series was renewed in 2007 when PC joined the Big South
- During the first two meetings of the renewed series, PC was in its NCAA Division I transitional phase and was not part of the official BSC standings
- Liberty is 4-1 against PC since the series was restarted in 2007
- The lone loss was a 31-28 setback at Bailey Memorial Stadium in 2008 (Nov. 1)

- The victory was head coach Turner Gill's first as Liberty's head football coach
- The win extended Liberty's home Big South winning streak to a conference record 16 straight games (last home BSC loss was to Gardner-Webb in 2006)
- The game started Liberty's 11th season of Big South football

Presbyterian College Preview:

- The Flames will be looking for their first road victory under head coach Turner Gill
- Liberty will be looking to snap a three-game road losing streak
- The game will pit Liberty's No. 34 ranked offense (405.8 yards per game) against PC's No. 109 ranked defense (463.67 yards allowed per game)

Noting the Attendance:

- The Homecoming game was played in front of 18,239 fans
- The attendance figure marked the fifth largest crowd in Williams Stadium history
- Liberty currently ranks No. 10 in the country in total home attendance (51,204), No. 12 in average home attendance (17,068) and No. 22 in filling stadium capacity (88.90 percent)

Gardner-Webb Recap:

- The Flames scored 32 of the game's final 39 points to rally for a 42-35 victory

Homecoming Recap:

- Liberty upped its overall record to 28-11 in Homecoming contests
- Liberty has now won six consecutive Homecoming games
- Prior to Saturday's game, Liberty had won its last five Homecoming games by an average margin of 36.2 points per game
- Prior to Saturday's game, Liberty had been outscoring opponents by 23.15 points per game in its 27 previous Homecoming victories

Offensive Highlights from the Gardner-Webb Game:

- The Flames finished the game with a season-high 42 points
- Liberty scored 32 of its 42 points during the second half of the game
- Liberty scored 32 of the game's last 39 points to rally for the victory
- Liberty finished the game with a season-high 508 total offensive yards
- Following the game, Liberty is now averaging 405.8 total offensive yards per game and ranks No. 34 in the country in total offense
- The last time the Flames racked up 500 or more total offensive yards was in their 63-27 Homecoming victory over No. 20 Coastal Carolina, last year (518 yards)
- 68.5 percent of Liberty's total offensive yards came during the second half (160 – first half; 348 – second half)
- Liberty finished the game with a season-high 25 first downs
- Liberty has now finished the last three games with 20 or more first downs
- The Flames are now averaging 20.2 first downs per game and rank No. 48 in the country in first down offense
- 17 of Liberty's 25 first downs against Gardner-Webb came via the passing game
- On the season, 62 of Liberty's 101 first downs have come via the passing game (61.3 percent)
- Liberty has finished four out of five games in 2012 with 10 or more passing first downs
- Liberty currently ranks No. 21 in the country with 62 passing first downs
- The Flames surpassed the 100-yard rushing mark for the third time this season, finishing the game with 120 team rushing yards
- 79.1 percent of Liberty's rushing yards came during the second half (95 second half rushing yards)
- The Flames picked up their fourth rushing touchdown of the season against Gardner-Webb
- The Flames finished the Gardner-Webb game with a season-high 388 passing yards
- Following the game, Liberty currently ranks No. 11 in the country in passing offense (277.20 passing yards per game)
- Liberty has now passed for 300 yards twice this season (also against Montana – 321 yards)
- Liberty also ranks No. 15 in the country in passing efficiency (149.66)
- Liberty finished the game with four passing touchdowns against Gardner-Webb
- Liberty has scored 15 touchdowns in 2012, with 10 coming via the passing game (four rushing, 1 punt return)
- The Flames had four different players catch a TD pass in the game
- On the season, seven different players have now recorded TD receptions
- Liberty finished the game with a season-low four penalties, resulting in 40 penalty yards
- Coming into the game, Liberty was averaging 8.3 penalties per game and 57.3 penalty yards per game
- Three of Liberty's four penalties were called on the Flames' offensive unit (holding twice and one delay of game)
- The Flames won the turnover battle for the first time this year, finishing with one giveaway to Gardner-Webb's two turnovers
- Liberty finished with a time of possession advantage for the second game in a row (34:17 to 25:43)
- Liberty had possession of the football for more than 10 minutes during both the first (10:18) and third quarters (10:37)
- Following the game, Liberty now ranks No. 8 in the country in average time of possession (33:38)
- Liberty finished the Gardner-Webb game with a season-low four third-down conversions (4-of-11)
- Liberty now ranks No. 33 in the country in third-down conversion percentage (41.33/31-of-75)

- Liberty was successful on its lone fourth-down play, helping sustain its first scoring drive of the day
- Liberty has now converted on 2-of-7 fourth-down plays in 2012
- Liberty's offensive line allowed three sacks during the game
- Liberty now ranks No. 109 (out of 121 FCS teams) in sacks allowed per game (3.20)
- Liberty successfully put points on the scoreboard each time it crossed into the Runnin' Bulldogs red zone
- Liberty finished the game with three touchdowns and two field goals when penetrating Gardner-Webb's 20-yard line
- Liberty currently ranks No. 9 in the country in red zone offense (scoring on 92.0 percent of drives crossing the opponent's 20-yard line)
- Liberty has scored on 12-of-13 red zone drives (3 rushing TDs, 5 passing TDs, 4 FGs)

Defensive Highlights from the Gardner-Webb Game:

- The Flames allowed a season-high 35 points during the game
- Liberty has allowed 30 or more points in three of its five games in 2012
- The last time the Flames allowed an opponent to score 35 inside Williams Stadium was Lafayette in 2008 (L/ 31-35 on Oct. 18)
- The last time the Flames allowed 35 or more points in a game and won was against Coastal Carolina in 2008 (W/ 43-38 on Oct. 4)
- Gardner-Webb finished the game with an opponent season-high 481 total offensive yards
- 68.6 percent of Gardner-Webb's total offensive yards came during the first half (330 first-half total offensive yards; 151 second-half total offensive yards)
- Liberty held Gardner-Webb to 98 rushing yards, tying an opponent season low (Wake Forest also finished with only 98 rushing yards)
- Following the game, Liberty is now allowing 150.8 rushing yards per game (ranked No. 52 in the country in rushing defense)
- Liberty allowed Gardner-Webb to rush for an opponent season-high four rushing touchdowns
- The last time the Flames allowed an opponent to rush for four or more touchdowns was Stony Brook in the 2009 season-finale loss in Stony Brook, N.Y. (L/ 33-36 on Nov. 21)
- Liberty has allowed 16 offensive touchdowns this season, 13 of which have been rushing touchdowns
- 79.6 percent of Gardner-Webb's total offensive yards came via its passing game (383 passing yards; 481 total offensive yards)
- Gardner-Webb amassed 301 of its 383 passing yards during the first 30 minutes of play
- Gardner-Webb's 383 passing yards nearly doubled the previous high passing yards the Flames had allowed in 2012
- Prior to the Gardner-Webb game, Liberty had allowed both Wake Forest and Lehigh to pass for 195 yards
- Liberty is now allowing 192.0 passing yards per game, which ranks No. 43 in the country in passing defense
- The Flames allowed an opponent season-high 21 first downs (6 rush, 14 pass, 1 penalty)
- Liberty allowed Gardner-Webb to tally 14 first downs via its passing game
- During the first four games of the year, Liberty's opponents had tallied a total of 20 first downs via passing plays
- Following the game, Liberty ranks No. 4 in the country in first down defense (15.40 allowed per game)
- Gardner-Webb finished the game with five penalties resulting for a loss of 36 yards
- The five infractions by the Runnin' Bulldogs was the third highest opponent penalty total this year
- The Flames held Gardner-Webb to an opponent season-low two third-down conversions (2-of-7)
- On the year, Liberty ranks No. 29 in the country in third-down conversion defense (32.31 percent/21-of-65)
- Gardner-Webb failed to convert on its lone fourth-down conversion attempt against Liberty
- Liberty has now stopped opponents four out of seven times in 2012 on fourth-down conversion attempts

- Liberty ranks No. 41 nationally in fourth-down conversion defense (42.86 percent/3-of-7)
- The Flames had their second red zone defensive stop of the year against Gardner-Webb
- Liberty's opponents have managed to put points on the scoreboard 12 out of 14 times they have crossed the Flames' 20-yard line
- 11 of the 12 times Liberty's opponents have entered the red zone, they have scored a touchdown, including four out of five times against Gardner-Webb

Special Teams Highlights from the Gardner-Webb Game:

- The Flames finished the game with their second highest total return yardage of the season
- Liberty had one punt return for 15 yards and four kickoff returns for 134 yards (total return yards: 159)
- D.J. Abnar gave the Flames their longest kickoff return of the season with an 83-yard return early in the second quarter
- Following the Gardner-Webb game, Liberty currently ranks No. 35 in the country in kickoff returns (22.94 yards per return)
- Liberty held Gardner-Webb to an opponent season-low 35 total return yards
- The Runnin' Bulldogs finished the game without a punt return and two kickoff returns for 35 yards
- Following the game, Liberty currently ranks No. 22 in the country in kickoff return yardage defense (17.29 yards allowed per return)
- John Lunsford knocked down both of his field goal attempts during the game (22 and 33 yards) and now ranks No. 25 in the country in field goals per game (1.2)
- The Flames converted on their first two-point conversion of the season when Josh Woodrum found Pat Kelly for a two-point passing play during the third quarter

- Career Stats: 13 rec., 187 yards, 1 TD, 14.4 avg.
- Finished the game with three receptions for 43 yards
- Caught his first career TD pass, a 15-yard half-back option pass from running back Aldreakis Allen
- Third game this season he has caught three or more passes

- Finished the game with three punts for 122 yards
- Averaged 40.7 yards per punt
- Fourth time in five games he has averaged more than 40 yards per punt
- Ranks No. 2 in the BSC in punting (40.2)
- Ranks No. 4 in the BSC in punts (26) and total yards (1,046)

- Ranks No. 45 in the country in punting (40.23)
- Only three of his 26 punts in 2012 have pinned opponents inside the 20-yard line
- Has three 50+ yard punts

John Lunsford (Fr., K)

- Career Stats: 6-of-9 FG-FGA, 13-of-13 PAT, 31 points
- Had his first double-digit career game, scoring 10 points
- Finished the game 2-of-2 on field goal attempts (22 and 33 yards)
- Has now successfully hit his last four field goal attempts
- Remains perfect on the year on point-after attempts (13-of-13)
- Currently ranks No. 25 in the country in field goals (1.20 per game)
- Averaged 62.7 yards per kickoff
- Four of his seven kickoffs went into the end zone for a touchback
- Named Big South Special Teams Player of the Week on Monday
- Third time this season he has been honored by the BSC
- Named Big South Freshman of the Week on Sept. 3
