The Game

The Liberty men's basketball team kicks off the 2012-13 season at Richmond, Friday. The Flames will look to even the series between the two squads, as the Spiders currently hold a 2-1 advantage. Last season, Richmond hosted Liberty on Dec. 28, 2011, pulling away in the second half to win 77-61. Game time for the rematch inside the Robins Center is slated for 7 p.m.

What to Watch for

- After two years of playing alongside his older brother Jesse, John Caleb Sanders will take the court this season without Liberty's all-time assist leader. On Friday, the younger Sanders needs just four points to reach 500 for his Liberty career. If he continues his scoring trend, John Caleb could one day join his brother in the program's 1,000-point club. Coincidentally, Jesse became the 22nd member of the 1,000-point club in the Flames' meeting with the Spiders, last season.

- The Flames are looking to overcome history in Friday's matchup, holding a 3-17 record in season openers away from home. A win over the Spiders would mark Liberty's first-ever season-opening victory over a Division I opponent on the road. The Flames have also not won a lid lifter away from Lynchburg since defeating Brooklyn, 80-65, on Nov. 29, 1988, Liberty's first season as a Division I institution.

- After finishing last in the Big South in three-pointers made (125) during the 2011-12 season, the Flames hope to improve their stroke from long distance. Newcomers like Davon Marshall and Chad Donley could solve the problem. Last season at Monroe, Marshall shot 45.7 percent (102-of-223) from three-point range.

- A question mark surrounding the Flames is how they replace the loss of four-year starting point guard Jesse Sanders. At the No. 1 spot, Davon Marshall is expected to step in as the team's floor general. Meanwhile, Antwan Burrus gives the Flames senior leadership and a strong rebounding presence. Jesse's younger brother John Caleb showed his maturity as a scorer, last season, and looks to build on a solid 2011-12 campaign.

Notes and Anecdotes

- The history between the two coaches goes back further than Liberty's meeting with the Spiders, last season. During Dale Layer's tenure at Colorado State, the Rams squared off with fellow Mountain West Conference member Air Force, who was then coached by Chris Mooney. In Mooney's one year as head coach at Air Force the Falcons swept the Rams, winning 58-53 on Jan. 8, 2005 and 59-47 on Feb. 7, 2005.

- Liberty is 1-4 all-time against current members of the A-10. The Flames are 0-1 against Duquesne, 1-1 versus Richmond, 0-1 against Saint Louis and 0-1 against St. Joseph's (Pa.).

- Friday's contest marks the fourth meeting all-time between the two squads since the series began Nov. 21, 1998. Prior to last season's matchup, the previous two meetings were each decided by three points, with neither team winning on its home floor.

- Liberty is 20-20 all-time in season openers, but is 3-17 when beginning the year away from its home turf.

- The matchup marks the second straight year and third time in four seasons the Flames have opened the year on the road.

Last time out versus Richmond

- Senior point guard Jesse Sanders inked his name in the Liberty annals for the second straight contest, becoming the 22nd member of the program's 1,000 point club. The Sugar Land, Texas native led the Flames with 14 tallies on the night, giving him 1,012 by night's end. Sanders' momentous basket came with 13:11 remaining in the half, sinking a layup to enter into Liberty's 1,000 point club. Sanders concluded his collegiate career with 1,235 tallies.

- With five assists on the night, Jesse Sanders also surpassed Matt Hildebrand (583, 1991-94) for second all-time on Liberty's career assist listing. Sanders concluded the season as the program's all-time leader in assists with 727.

- The Flames jumped out to an 8-0 run during the early moments of the game, receiving buckets from David Minaya, John Caleb Sanders and Antwan Burrus.

- Despite the Flames leading for the majority of the opening half, a 12-2 Richmond run allowed the Spiders to take a four-point lead at halftime.

- Liberty shot 57.1 percent (12-of-21) in the second half, finishing with a season-high 54.3 percent (25-of-46). The Spiders ended the night on 52.9 percent shooting (27-of-51). The Flames won the rebounding battle on the night, 28-23.

- Along with Jesse Sanders' 14 points, Antwan Burrus ended the night with 13 tallies and eight rebounds.

Notes from Blue-White Scrimmage (Oct. 25, 2012)

- John Caleb Sanders led all scorers on the night with 20 points and 10 rebounds. Sanders shot 7-of-13 from the field, including 2-of-4 from three-point range, while sinking 4-of-6 foul shots.

- With each 20-minute half representing a single game, senior forward Antwan Burrus led the white-clad Flames to a 30-24 victory over the blue team in Game 1, posting a game-high 15 points.

- In Game 2, John Caleb Sanders led the blue squad with 14 points and eight rebounds, followed by forwards Tomasz Gielo and Sommy Ogukwe, who each had 10 tallies during the final 20 minutes. Davon Marshall paced the white squad with 12 points, all coming from behind the three-point arc.

- With the scores of each game combined, the night coincidentally ended in a 65-65 tie.

Fast Break

- Injury Report: Center Joel Vander Pol is coming off back surgery and is expected to miss the early part of the year.

- Antwan Burrus is on pace this year to become Liberty's 23rd member of its 1,000-point club, needing 234 tallies to accomplish the feat.

- Sitting in fourth all-time in program history with 104 blocks, Burrus needs nine more to become No. 2 on the listing.

- Liberty lost two of its starters from the 2011-12 season to graduation – David Minaya and Jesse Sanders. Together, the duo combined for 35 percent of the team's offense.

- Sommy Ogukwe returns to the Flames' lineup after missing last season due to injury.

- Liberty will play five of its first six contests on the road, which includes a meeting with Georgetown at the Verizon Center (Nov. 14) to begin the Legends Classic. The Flames will also compete in Texas for the third straight season as they wrap up the Legends Classic in Huntsville, Texas.

- Tomasz Gielo competed in the 2012 U20 FIBA European Championships, averaging 13.1 ppg and 7.3 rpg for the Polish National Team.

- After showcasing his skills in the Portsmouth Invitational, Jesse Sanders signed with Italian squad Fileni BPA Jesi.
