The Liberty softball team, off to a 5-0 start for the first time since 2006, makes its first trip to California since 2009, competing in the prestigious Mary Nutter Classic from Friday through Sunday. Liberty's schedule this weekend features six games, including matchups with No. 9/9 Oregon on Saturday, and No. 6/8 UCLA on Sunday.

Liberty has faced Loyola Marymount, UC Davis and UCLA in program history, going a combined 0-5 against those teams.

Lady Flames at a Glance

Liberty posted a dominant 5-0 record at the Dot Richardson Invitational in Clermont, Fla., to open the 2017 season. The Lady Flames outscored opponents, 47-6, hitting .460 as a team, while also posting a 0.97 ERA.

Freshman shortstop Amber Bishop was named Big South Player of the Week on Monday, after batting .625 with nine RBI in Florida. Bishop's twin sister, Autumn, hit .500 with 10 runs scored last weekend. Jasmeen Click and Emily Sweat both batted .500, while Sarah Robertson (.444) scored six runs and drove in seven. 2015 Big South Freshman of the Year Alexia Taylor has hit 4-for-7 (.571) so far.

In the circle, freshman Elizabeth Engler was named Big South Pitcher of the Week after going 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA on the weekend. Opening-game starter Kenzie Friesen also sports a 0.00 ERA, while Chase Cassady (0.84 ERA) is 2-0 with one shutout.

Top 25 Challenge

The Liberty softball team has competed against top 25 teams 53 times in program history, posting a 6-47 record versus nationally-ranked opponents.

Liberty went 0-4 against ranked opponents last year, falling to then No. 17/17 UCF (Feb. 11), No. 5/5 Alabama (Feb. 14), No. 21/21 Baylor (Feb. 19) and No. 5/6 LSU (March 5).

Liberty has six games on its 2017 schedule against teams that are ranked in the top 15 of both national preseason polls (NFCA and USA Softball).

In 2007, Liberty knocked off No. 23 Hawai'i, No. 10 Baylor and No. 6 Michigan. The Lady Flames' 2-0 win over No. 6 Michigan, March 24, 2007, marks the highest-ranked team that Liberty has beaten in softball, and the team's most recent victory over a nationally-ranked team.

UCLA Connections

Fourth-year Head Coach Dot Richardson was a legendary shortstop for UCLA from 1981-83, helping the Bruins win their first NCAA softball title in 1982. She was named the NCAA Softball Player of the 1980's, before later winning two Olympic Gold Medals in 1996 and 2000.

Richardson was a teammate of current UCLA assistant coach Lisa Fernandez on Team USA for both the 1996 and 2000 Olympics. Richardson and Fernandez have both been inducted into the UCLA Athletics and ASA/USA Softball National Halls of Fame.

The Lady Flames made their first-ever NCAA Regional Appearance in 2002, meeting then-No. 1 UCLA in the first round. The top-seeded Bruins broke a scoreless tie in the fifth inning, on the way to a 3-0 win, a game played in Columbia., S.C.

Lady Flames in California

This will be the third trip to California all-time for the Liberty softball team, and first since 2009, when the Lady Flames opened the season at the Cathedral City Kick-Off. Five out of Liberty's 12 games played in California have been against ranked opponents.

Liberty has two all-time wins over California schools, defeating Pacific March 9-10, 2007 in Honolulu, Hawai'i.

A program-record seven Lady Flames hail from California this season. This also marks the first time in program history that California has been the most-represented state on the roster.

Current Lady Flames Jaclyn Amader (Rocklin HS), Deidra See (El Diamante HS) and Elizabeth Engler will all see former high school teammates on at least one opposing squad at the Mary Nutter Classic.

Liberty Softball Stadium Named No. 6 College Softball Stadium

Through a fan vote conducted by FloSoftball.com, Liberty Softball Stadium was voted the sixth best college softball stadium in the nation in 2017. Louisiana Lafayette's Lamson Park was voted No. 1. Last year, Liberty Softball Stadium appeared second on the list, trailing only LSU's Tiger Park.

Stadium Dedication

Liberty officially dedicated its new facility prior to the Lady Flames' doubleheader against Presbyterian on April 3, 2015. A pregame ceremony took place, as former Liberty head coach Paul Wetmore provided the invocation. Liberty President Jerry Falwell, along with current head coach Dot Richardson, threw out the ceremonial first pitches. Becki Falwell and Liberty Director of Athletics Jeff Barber were also a part of the ceremony.

Dwayne Kamphuis, a financial supporter of Liberty University and the softball program, is a legendary fast pitch softball pitcher. Kamphuis traveled the world playing in exhibition softball games as part of the renowned "King and His Court" team, headed up by Eddie "The King" Feigner.

Opening Games

Liberty posted a 3-2 record at the Liberty Softball Classic, March 19-21, 2015. The Lady Flames opened their new Liberty Softball Stadium with a 9-2 win over Rider on March 19, and picked up wins over Princeton and Quinnipiac as well.

Firsts for All

During the first game in Liberty Softball Stadium history, March 19, 2015 against Rider, Megan Robinson recorded the first hit, Madison Kotchey the first double and RBI, Mickey Loveridge the first triple, Tori Zavodny the first stolen base and home run and Chandler Ball the first pitch, strikeout and first victory.

One feat that has not been obtained during the history of Liberty Softball Stadium is a grand slam.

Extra, Extra

Liberty downed Coastal Carolina, 5-4 in 10 innings on April 18, 2015 the first extra-inning game in Liberty Softball Stadium history. At three and a half hours, it was also the longest game in stadium history. The Lady Flames are 3-2 in extra-inning contests at Liberty Softball Stadium.

Lights, Camera, Action

The new stadium is equipped with the latest technology, making it ready for television broadcasts. A majority of Liberty's home games are scheduled to air either as full TV broadcasts and/or as live video webstreams. With home and visiting radio booth available, most home games will air on 90.9 FM The Light as well.

Bishop, Engler Earn Big South Weekly Honors

Freshman Amber Bishop was named Big South Player of the Week on Monday, while freshman Elizabeth Engler was named Big South Pitcher of the Week. It marked the first time since May 10, 2010, that Liberty earned both awards in the same week. Bishop also appeared on the NFCA's national list of notable performances.

Bishop had a monster weekend in Florida, batting .625 with a .938 slugging percentage, two doubles, one homer and nine RBI. She hit her first career homer against Morgan State on Sunday, while also posting a pair of three-RBI games on the week.

Engler went 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA, striking out seven batters in 10 innings. She won in each of her first two collegiate appearances, including a complete-game victory over Morgan State. She is the first Lady Flame since Katie Phillips (1996) to win in each of her first two career appearances.

Triple the Fun

Liberty tied a program record with three triples against Morgan State, Sunday, as Autumn Bishop roped two triples and Jaclyn Amader also tripled. Bishop tied a program single-game record, set by Ashley Bensinger against Charleston Southern, April 9, 2011.

Start it Up

Kenzie Friesen pitched five shutout innings last Friday against Chattanooga, helping Liberty win its season opener for the first time since 2007.

Also in that game, Amber Bishop hit a double in her first collegiate at bat, while fellow freshman Kayla Harris singled in her first at bat. They are the first Lady Flames since Kelby Allen in 2012 to record a hit in their first collegiate at bat.

Round and Round We Go

The Lady Flames have averaged nearly 10 runs per game, and the Bishop twins, Amber and Autumn, have been key catalysts to the offensive explosion. Autumn Bishop has averaged a nation-leading two runs scored per game, while Amber Bishop averages 1.8 RBI per contest.

Sarah Robertson (seven RBI), Emily Sweat (six), Autumn Bishop (five) and Alexia Taylor (three) all average at least one RBI per game played.

Shutting the Door

Julia DiMartino, a 2016 Big South All-Conference first team selection as a freshman, earned her first career save with two innings in the season opener against Chattanooga.

The pitching staff has posted a 0.97 ERA, led by matching 0.00 ERA's from Elizabeth Engler (2-0) and Kenzie Friesen (1-0) and a 0.84 from Chase Cassady (2-0).

Cassady pitched her second career shutout on Friday against Fairleigh Dickinson, and she averages 7.8 strikeouts per seven innings.

No Mercy

Liberty has defeated each of its last four opponents via run-rule margins, the first time that has happened in program history. On Sunday, with a 9-1 win over Morgan State, the Lady Flames came up one run shy of scoring double-figures in four straight games.

Blazing the Basepaths

In their first three years under the direction of Head Coach Dot Richardson, the Lady Flames have averaged 85 stolen bases per year. So far this year, Liberty has averaged 3.6 steals per game, good for fifth in NCAA Division I.

Jasmeen Click leads the way with four stolen bases, as 11 Lady Flames have stolen at least one base. Interestingly, junior Tori Zavodny has not stolen a base yet this year.

Zavodny, a two-time all-conference selection led the team in stolen bases each of the last two years. Her 53 career steals rank sixth in program history, one shy of fifth place. Zavodny has started each of the last three season openers, once in each outfield position.

Nation's Best

After one weekend, Liberty led NCAA Division I with a .548 on-base percentage, while also ranking third in runs per game (9.40), fourth in batting average (.460), and seventh in slugging percentage (.643).

Four Lady Flames have recorded a three-hit game so far this season, in Amber Bishop, Autumn Bishop, Sarah Robertson and Alexia Taylor.

Eight current Lady Flames have posted at least one career three-hit contest, led by six from junior Tori Zavodny. Jaclyn Amader has recorded five three-hit games, followed by Taylor (4), Rylee Reynolds (2), Robertson (2), Amber Bishop (1), Autumn Bishop (1) and Deidra See (1).

Preseason Postings

Liberty has been predicted to finish second in the Big South Preseason Coaches' Poll, after placing third at 16-8 last season. The Lady Flames have tied their highest preseason projection, as Liberty was previously picked second in the preseason coaches' poll in 2000, 2001, 2011 and 2012.

Two-time defending Big South champion Longwood was voted first in the preseason coaches' poll.

(DiMarti) No-Nos

Julia DiMartino tossed a five-inning no-hitter against Stetson at the 2016 Dot Richardson Invitational. She added a no-hitter in a 1-0 victory over Gardner-Webb, April 29, tying the program record for no-hitters in a single season.

DiMartino ended the 2016 season with a 17-12 record, 2.45 ERA, 187 strikeouts and seven shutouts, setting Liberty freshman records in wins, strikeouts, shutouts and no-hitters

K Zone

The Lady Flames set a program single-season record with 377 strikeouts in 2016.

Chase Cassady averaged 8.05 strikeouts per seven innings, good for 34th in the nation. She struck out a career-high 11 batters in five innings pitched versus La Salle, March 12. Julia DiMartino struck out 7.76 batters per game, good for 45th among NCAA Division I pitchers. DiMartino set a career high with 13 K's against Sacred Heart, March 12.

100

Alexia Taylor registered 119 hits in her first two seasons as a Lady Flame. She became the first Lady Flame since Ashley Williams in 2006 to reach 100 career hits as a sophomore. Taylor was the fourth Liberty sophomore all-time to register 100 career hits, joining Williams, Cheryl Wyrick (2000-01) and Stacy Radulovich (1996-97).

Blankings

Liberty led the Big South with 12 shutouts last season, including seven against Big South teams. Julia DiMartino tossed seven shutouts and Chase Cassady registered one.

One-Run Success

Liberty went 10-5 in one-run games last year, including 6-1 in Big South games decided by one run. The Lady Flames have won eight out of their last 10 one-run games.

Family Matters

Freshmen Amber and Autumn Bishop are twin sisters. They are the first sisters to play for Liberty softball team during the same season since Claire and Michelle Fridey in 2007.

Sophomore pitcher Chase Cassady, last season's opening-day starter in the circle, is the younger sister of current Liberty assistant coach Paige Cassady. Their father, John Cassady, is on staff as a volunteer assistant coach.

Sophomore pitcher Julia DiMartino was named to the Big South All-Conference first team last year. Her older sister, Alyssa DiMartino, pitched for the Lady Flames from 2011-14, serving as Liberty's opening-game starter in both 2012 and 2014.

Junior outfielder Tori Zavodny, a two-time all-conference outfielder, is the younger sister of Katie Zavodny, who was a 2013 NFCA All-Region outfielder and holds Liberty's records for career and single-season stolen bases.

Junior Madi Clarke's father, David Clarke, played baseball at Liberty from 1986-1989. In fact, David Clarke played his home games at Worthington Stadium, the same site where Liberty Softball Stadium now sits.
